DOUG PAYNE MEMORIAL

Tonight sees the running of the Doug Payne Memorial at Angle Park. The feature SA Bred event carries prizemoney this year of \$8,500. It features a strong field of locally produced greyhounds and should provide a very good betting race. Good luck to all runners in the event, but a special mention to Lauren Harris, who has Crusade engaged. Lauren has done a great job with this lightly raced greyhound and missed out narrowly on the Gawler Cup Final when second in his heat. Good to see one of our young trainers mixing it up with some of our best. There will be a trophy presentation on track tonight following the event.

MELBOURNE CUP HEATS TONIGHT

The Melbourne Carnival gets down to the nitty gritty tonight (Thursday), with the running of eight heats of the 2008 Melbourne Cup at Sandown. As always this is one of the highlights of the Australian greyhound racing calendar and the heats look like producing some outstanding racing. South Australia will have interest in the Petar Jovanovic trained Rick's Pride, which has done very well at Sandown over recent weeks. He is stepping up in grade, but with a best time of 29.72, looks to have some claims. The SA Bred greyhound Fedex, trained by Jason Thompson goes around in heat eight, but faces Shootout winner, Mantra Lad.

The 64 greyhounds drawn to compete in the heats of the Group One Melbourne Cup have combined for over \$4.3 million in career prizemoney and feature 10 individual Group One winners and 22 Group race winners combining for 33 Group race titles.

Only the winner of each Schweppes Melbourne Cup heat will progress to the final to be run at Sandown Park on Thursday 27 November. The 2008 Schweppes Melbourne Cup is the 53rd running of Australia's blue riband event and is the richest ever, with \$250,000 in prizemoney on offer.

The meeting also features the heats of the Bold Trease Carnival Cup and SA stayers, Risk It and Token Ned are engaged in heat 2 against Chinatown Lad. Patrons at Angle Park tonight will have a full TAB and Bookmakers service on the eleven event card.

GOTBA COURSING AWARDS

Tonight's Doug Payne Memorial meeting will also feature the GOTBA Feature. This race is for greyhounds which have coursed during 2008 and carries an additional \$250 in prizemoney, which has been donated by the GOTBA.

During the evening the GOTBA will also be presenting their 2008 Coursing Awards. The winners are:

As part of the night, Judi Hurley has also been able to secure R3 Shark Cartilage Products to be given away to the first three greyhounds for each of the races during the night. This will include 500gm and 2.5kg containers as well as ointment jars. Trainers will be able to collect their products from the racing office during the evening.

2008 THE BUNYIP GAWLER GOLD CUP

Congratulations to Ken Gill and Jan Jones on the win of White Admiral in The Bunyip Gawler Gold Cup Final on Sunday. After making the previous Group Three Final, the SA Sprint, it was no surprise to see him take out a big one. He made good use of box one to be well placed early and ran a smart 30.77 to take the \$17,500 winner's cheque. It was quite a pleasure to watch the obvious thrill that both Jan & Ken got from the victory. Speaking with Ken after the race, they may look at giving "the Admiral" a start in the Ballarat Cup which comes up next month. It was a very good night for SA greyhound racing as a whole, with the crowd up by around 200 on last year. Tote & Bookmakers turnover was well up on last year and TAB figures continue to be strong. The atmosphere created by the extra facilities and the country band all added to the night which GRSA with the support of the Gawler GRC will hope to grow further.

WEDNESDAY MORNING START TIMES

A reminder that from next Wednesday 26th November, we will be back to the morning start times each Wednesday at Angle Park. That means the first race will be around 10.30am. The only exception over the coming weeks will be December 31st, which will have a lunchtime start.

CLASSIC 2008 FUTURITY

Owners and trainers are reminded that nominations for the Brian Johnstone Memorial series close tomorrow (Friday 21st November) with GRSA at 9.00am. This race is for SA Bred greyhounds eligible for Classic 2009. The heats are to be run next Wednesday 26th November at Angle Park, with the semi-finals on Thursday 4th December and the final a week later.

SATURDAY MORNING TRIALS

Following consultation at the ICG it has been decided to make the kennelhouse available for trainers to use on Saturday mornings. This option previously has been available when the temperature was forecast to be over thirty degrees.

This will be controlled by the GRSA staff and we request that trainers take directions given by them. When the kennels are used on a Saturday morning, it means that cleaning is required prior to Monday night, so we need to manage this. We would ask that trainers don't just use the kennels simply because "they can", but to help us with this.

2008 PREMIERS CUP DATE

When we published the Feature Events Calendar a date for the Premiers Cup was still to be finalised. We can now confirm that the Premiers Cup will be held on Thursday 4th April 2009. This race is an Open Grade event over the 731 metre distance worth \$6,000.

FUTURITY PAYMENTS DUE NEXT MONTH

The next batch of payments are due on Friday 19th December and there will be three series for which payments will need to be made.

The payments due are:

Breeders 2009 – Final Payment - Pups Born Nov 06 To Apr 07

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. **The Final Payment is \$110 per greyhound.**

At this stage there are 130 pups still eligible of which 75 have already made the Final Payment. We are on track to have just over \$61,000 in total prizemoney (depending on number of races run), with the estimate for the Breeders Plate Final at \$28,000. I will publish an update of the estimates after Final Payments are confirmed.

Classic 2009 – Second Payment - Pups Born May 07 To Oct 07

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments or a Final payment was made last June. **The Second Sustaining Payment is \$44 per pup or a Final Payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

Currently there are 197 pups still eligible for Classic 2009, of which 18 have already made the Final Payment. The Estimates at this stage suggest a series worth around \$64,000 and for the Brian Johnstone Memorial Final to be worth around \$29,000. We will update the estimates once this payment is completed.

Dates for all races are still to be confirmed, but the Preludes will be on similar dates to this year. The Brian Johnstone Memorial Final has been listed for Thursday 10th December 2009.

Breeders 2010 – First Payment - Pups Born Nov 07 To Apr. 08

Finally the First Payment is due for Breeders 2010. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. **The First Payment is \$22 per pup or a "one-off" Final payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

There are a total of 461 SA Bred Pups from 73 litters that are eligible for Breeders 2010. A payment must be made at this stage for these pups to remain eligible.

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups we have sent out reminders this week. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it doesn't slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you may have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can either forward on the information or let Caralyn Fielden know at GRSA and she can follow it up. If you haven't received a reminder and you think you should have, again get in touch with Caralyn.

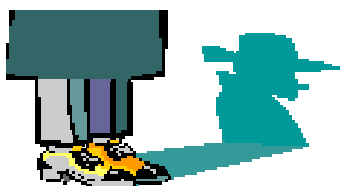

BIG NIGHT HAD AT GAWLER

Last Sunday's Gawler Cup meeting certainly looks a top programme on paper with two cup consolations and the Squiers Sales and Service Country Cup final and of course the running of the 2008 Bunyip Gawler Gold Cup.

As usual box draws can play a big part when it comes down to 8 quality performers and last Sunday it was no different. On the box rise the Karen Wittholz trained Classic Icon led the cup field to the first turn with White Admiral (box 1) in hot pursuit. As expected race favourite in Scull Murphy was in all sorts of trouble from his draw (box 4) on the first turn. Into the back the Kenny Gill trained sprinter White Admiral used his expertise at the circuit to push up and if you could have put your money on then it was all over bar the shouting.

The Where's Pedro/Hazza Future chaser went on to win by 1.5L with Senni Rob (Box 6) and Little Poodle filling the minors.

White Admiral has now won 5 of his 6 starts at the popular northern circuit and added the \$17,500 winner's prize to his owner's pockets. His career earnings to date have now topped the \$33,000 mark in just 34 starts. Past winners of the cup have been the talented Miss Spicy in 2005, Mini Debonair in 2006 and Olly Orca in 2007 in the slick time of 30.31. White Admiral will certainly make his presence felt in the features here in the coming months.

The two consolations held on Cup night went to the classy Quinton Bale for leading trainer Shaun Matcott with Senni Pie and Big Boss filling the placings. With the Mike Giniotis trained Kingdom King proving far too strong in the second consolation from box 6. The Victorian chaser who was a terrific 3rd behind Scull Murphy in his heat of the cup and carved out a 31.01 over the 531m. Kittyhawk and Diesel And Dust was the trifecta.

To cap off a terrific night of racing we saw the running of the Squiers Sales and Service Country Cup final. With the winners prize money of \$3620 on offer it is definitely a race worth winning. With representatives from 8 clubs around South Australia, it was Tickets Please, flying the flag for Mt Gambier, who won on his debut in the city. Classy Ace (Whyalla) and Silent Groover (Gawler) running the minors.

A big crowd was on hand for the twilight meeting and it continues to grow from year to year in popularity and it certainly continues to be a big draw card for interstate punters.

DISEASE PLAN INFORMATION

EXPLANATION OF THE G.R.S.A. DISEASE PLAN

As previously explained in Kennel Capers, Greyhound Racing SA has recently introduced an Emergency Disease Plan which will come into effect from 1st January 2009 and as part of the on going educational process we will be running a number of articles explaining the procedure that this plan will take. The plan has been instigated to protect all industry participants and attempt to limit any significant impact on the industry. As previously mentioned expert advice is, the chances of this plan having to be evoked are minimal. Ten diseases' have been listed as falling under the plan they are

Rabies
Rift Valley Fever
Leptospirosis
Brucellosis
Lyme Disease
Distemper
Parvo Virus
Hepatitis
Corona Virus
Babesiosis

In turn they have been divided into three categories

CATEGORY 1

Rabies
Rift Valley Fever

CATEGORY 2

Leptospirosis

**Brucellosis
Lyme disease**

**CATEGORY 3
Distemper
Parvo Virus
Hepatitis
Corona Virus
Badesiosis**

In future articles in Kennel Capers will break down the categories explaining each disease.

To help industry participants understand the procedure, today we will discuss

HOW WILL IT WORK?

If you suspect a dog in your kennel of having one of these diseases you should immediately have the dog examined by your veterinarian if in the worst case scenario it happens to be one of the 10 diseases you will be required to notify the C.E.O. of G.R.S.A. or the Chairman of Stewards immediately. They will then immediately notify the Emergency Disease Committee which comprises of the following

**C.E.O. Greyhound Racing SA
G.R.S.A. Chairman of Stewards
G.R.S.A. Deputy Chairman of Stewards
G.R.S.A. Veterinarian
Representative of Adelaide Plains Veterinary Clinic
G.R.S.A. Welfare Officer**

At this stage both committee Veterinarians' will liaise with your veterinarian to establish the seriousness of the situation, from this information a decision will be made to what action will be taken, it may be that the treatment and effective action within your kennel will be left to you and your vet, but if the veterinarians believe stronger action should be taken a member of the panel or their duly appointed representative could attend your property to take the appropriate action and could even impose a quarantine order against your property these type of decisions would not be taken lightly as we are aware of the ramifications it may have on a kennel, but the decision would be made in the best interest of the industry. Due to the seriousness of some of these diseases the industry would see major action taken by Government Departments with all decision making taken out of the hands of the industry this will be explained further over the next couple of months. To enforce the plan, new rules have been put in place to ensure that participants' abide by its requirements, failure to act as per the new rules will result in severe action being taken by stewards this line will be taken because of the serious consequences that could occur by someone trying to hide this information.
