### **MEDIA RELEASE**

#### **FURTHER MICROCHIP ANALYSIS TO BE UNDERTAKEN**

Greyhounds Australasia (GA) today announced it will direct the Microchip Sub Committee to further investigate specific matters pertaining to the microchipping of greyhounds in Australia and New Zealand.

The announcement follows an agreement reached at its Board meeting held in Adelaide on Thursday November 20, 2008.

The matters to be explored further include consideration of an extension of the proposed phase in period for existing racing stock, individual jurisdictional cost analyses and exploration of the jurisdictional legislative impact of microchipping.

The Microchip Sub Committee will table its findings and any revised recommendations for consideration by the full GA Board at their next meeting to be held in March 2009.

In addition, the GA board representative from The Greyhound Harness Racing Regulatory Authority (GHRRA) of NSW agreed to the authority conducting their own microchip trials in New South Wales.

As such GHRRA will determine parameters for these trials, which they believe will address issues possibly not explored in the original sub-committee reports findings. In this regard GHRRA agreed to provide a summary of their findings to the next GA Board meeting.

GA Chief Executive Officer, Mr Craig Taberner said today, "The GA Board acknowledged the comprehensive nature of the Microchip Sub Committees report and recommendations but felt it was appropriate to explore a few issues in more detail."

"The Microchip Sub-Committee determined that the introduction of microchipping would help the industry advance its animal welfare objectives, provide industry efficiencies and the integrity of the industry."

"However, this is a big step forward for the industry and it's important that we thoroughly explore all the issues and move forward together."

"Our aim is to, where possible, always bring about unanimous agreement between all jurisdictions to improve greyhound racing in Australia and New Zealand."

"We have made some real progress on microchipping and look forward to working with the Microchip Sub Committee to fine tune the report and to providing the information requested at the next board meeting."

The next GA board meeting will take place in Tasmania, March 2009.

**MELBOURNE CUP FINAL TONIGHT**

It is one of the biggest nights of the year for greyhound racing in Australia tonight, with the running of the Group One 2008 Melbourne Cup Final at Sandown. The \$250,000 event has drawn together a strong field following last weeks eight heats. Interesting to see that Kendale Bale and Velocette are in the Final. Both ran in Adelaide during the recent Derby series, with Kendale Bale finishing second in the Final.

Patrons on track at Angle Park tonight will have a full service available on the race, with Bookmakers and the Tote facilities, as well as the Sky Channel coverage.

**RISK IT IN GROUP FINAL**

As mentioned above, one of the other highlights in Melbourne tonight will be the running of the Bold Trease Carnival Cup Final. The Group Two feature is for distance greyhounds over the Sandown 715 metres. The great news for local followers was the performance in the heats by the Troy Murray trained, Risk It.

Risk It won his heat last week in very good style, to come into reckoning for a Group race win. He show good early pace last week, which is not his strength usually and once in front was never going to be run down. He went on for a 42.63, 14 length victory, which turned out to be the fastest of the three heat winners. The others were Fallen Zorro (42.65) and Oodles Rocks (42.73).

South Australia's other representative in the heats, Token Ned, finished third in his heat and is first reserve for the Final.

**GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH - OCTOBER**

We have our second Greyhound of the Month multiple winner in 2008 in October. Quinton Bale was July's monthly winner and has also been voted the winner for October. The judges had no doubts and he picked up all the first preferences for the month.

The main reason for the win was Quinton Bale's brilliant victory in the City Dismantlers SA Sprint Championship. In the Group Three Final, he was quite brilliant, leading throughout and recording a brilliant 29.53 seconds for the Angle Park 515 metres. Quinton Bale picked up the \$17,500 winners cheque after also winning his heat despite being slow early. During October all his races were spent chasing Group Race glory as his other starts were in the Coca Cola Derby Series. While he made the Final, poor box draws plagued him throughout and he was checked badly from a wide draw in the Derby Final.

Quinton Bale is prepared by SA's leading trainer Shaun Matcott and is by Elite State out of Mirada Belle. He was whelped in July 2006. At the end of October his record stood at 20 starts for 14 wins and 4 placings, with earnings of over \$38,000. Since beginning racing in April this year he has won the Sprint Championship and the Metro Holden Champion Puppy. If his form holds up, he is likely to be one of SA's best chances in the coming Sky Channel Adelaide Cup.

### **2009 SKY CHANNEL ADELAIDE CUP**

The 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup carnival is just around the corner and conditions for this year's event are now available. There aren't many major changes to this year's race, with all greyhounds competing having to run on all weeks to run in the Final. The Heats will be run on the 8<sup>th</sup> January and greyhounds will either run in these or be selected to run in the Interstate Challenge. The runners that compete in the Challenge will gain automatic starts in the Cup Semi-Finals on the 15<sup>th</sup> January. The Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Final will be run on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January and will carry total prizemoney of \$80,000.

We will include the full Adelaide Cup conditions in Kennel Capers next week.

The other notable date will be the Greyhound of the Year Dinner, which will again be part of the carnival next year. The dinner will be held on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> January. Full details will available shortly.

### **BRIAN JOHNSTONE MEMORIAL**

Yesterday (Wednesday) we saw three heats of the inaugural Brian Johnstone Memorial.

This series concludes the SA Bred Classic 2008 races, after the two Preludes, won by Stellar Flare and Uncle Remus. The semi-finals will be run next Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> December and the final on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> December. As we had three heats, we will be running two semi-finals.

#### **FUTURITY PAYMENTS DUE NEXT MONTH**

**The next batch of payments are due on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December** and there will be three series for which payments will need to be made.

The payments due are:

##### ***Breeders 2009 – Final Payment - Pups Born Nov 06 To Apr 07***

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. **The Final Payment is \$110 per greyhound.**

##### ***Classic 2009 – Second Payment - Pups Born May 07 To Oct 07***

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments or a Final payment was made last June. **The Second Sustaining Payment is \$44 per pup or a Final Payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

##### ***Breeders 2010 – First Payment - Pups Born Nov 07 To Apr. 08***

Finally the First Payment is due for Breeders 2010. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. **The First Payment is \$22 per pup or a “one-off” Final payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

To assist all owners of Futurity eligible pups we have sent out reminders. It is perhaps a good idea to make the payment as soon as you can, so it doesn't slip your mind and the closing date passes. If you may have sold a pup/s we would ask if you can either forward on the information or let Caralyn Fielden know at GRSA and she can follow it up. If you haven't received a reminder and you think you should have, contact us asap.

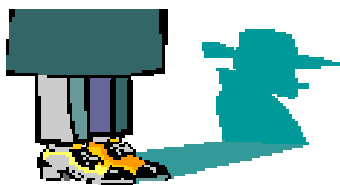

#### **DOUG PAYNE MEMORIAL**

Last Thursday night at Angle Park we saw the running of the Doug Payne Memorial feature. This event is an SA bred feature which carried \$8500 prize money this year.

It featured a strong field of locally produced greyhounds and provided a very good open betting race for punters.

Cool Keepsake for owner/trainer and breeder, Kirin Corby used box two to perfection when beginning midfield. He pushed up hard on the first 50m to make it a one act affair when crossing the line the second time in a slick 29.92

winning by 3.75L. The Big Daddy Cool/Corrumbene Lass sprinter has now won 13 of just 29 starts with 11 placings along side her name. The \$5850 winner's purse took connections earnings to the \$22,000 mark.

Race favourite Uncle Remus was last to leave the boxes and had to work hard over the 515m to eventually run an eye catching 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Collide chaser has been missing the kick of late which has proven costly in recent feature events. Another Big Daddy Cool sprinter in Very Cool for Tony Fergusson rounded out the trifecta when 3<sup>rd</sup>. Very Cool has been lightly raced and notched up 10 wins and 13 placings from just 29 outings.

Doug Payne (The Meadows Maestro) always encouraged people to become involved in the sport he loved so much and it was good to see many young trainers with runners engaged this year. This particular race has grown over the years and has been one local trainers love to win. It is with honour and respect that trainers accept their trophy bearing the late 'Meadows Maestro's' name and add it to their mantle piece.

Token Ned for Paul Barry is first reserve for the final tonight.

Troy is happy with box 3 in tonight's final and now the Most Awesome/Eureka Disco chaser has had a look at the track both trainer and connections are hoping for an ounce of luck early so they can get a good chance at claiming the \$25,000 winner's purse. Troy informed the Shadow that he and Risk It will be having a short spell from the travelling.

**POSITIVE SWAB – FLAME MCBAIN**

On 6<sup>th</sup> November 2008 Mrs. Raye Kelly was informed by registered letter that the greyhound FLAME MCBAIN had shown the presence of HYDROXYSTANOZOLOL from the urine sample taken at the Port Augusta Greyhound Racing Club SA meeting held at Port Augusta on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2008.

The reserve portion of the urine sample was tested and the presence of HYDROXYSTANOZOLOL was confirmed.

Mrs. Kelly has been advised that she is required to attend an inquiry at the offices of Greyhound Racing SA Limited, 55 Cardigan Street, Angle Park on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2008 at 11.00am, together with any witnesses that may assist for an inquiry by the Stewards into the circumstances relating to the obtaining of the positive urine sample.

**NOTIFICATION OF RETIRED GREYHOUNDS**

### **DISEASE PLAN INFORMATION**

## EMERGENCY DISEASE PLAN INFORMATION 2

In our previous article we discussed the procedure of 'How it will work', today's article will cover **diseases in category one and two** of the plan, remembering that ten diseases in the plan are divided into three categories'

### CATEGORY 1.

Two diseases fall into this group they are by far the most dangerous of any category and not only have the potential to impact on Greyhound racing but on the whole of the Australian economy, for this reason strict quarantine procedures have been put in place to keep these diseases out of Australia.

Industry participants who have recently travelled overseas will be aware of the strict quarantine procedures in place on returning to Australia.

### RABIES

Rabies is found in all countries in the world except Australia, British Isles and Antarctica. It is a viral infection transmitted from animal to animal by biting, or eating a contaminated carcass. Dogs are the most common domestic rabid animal worldwide. Dogs with the virus would show symptoms of confusion, aggression, elevated temperature, the virus is slow moving and attacks the nervous system of the dog until reaching the brain and salivary gland. When caged, dogs may attack their enclosure, becoming disoriented having seizures, and eventually dying. **As previously stated, this disease fortunately does not exist in Australia.**

### RIFT VALLEY FEVER

This disease originated in Africa it is acute viral infection although mainly restricted to farm animals it has the potential to effect domestic animals (dogs) although no cases have been reported in Australia at this stage it is a disease that Government departments are working hard to keep out. Symptoms of the disease are fever, nasal discharge, and vomiting and effects younger dogs. RVF biggest impact would be on the breeding industry as it results in major aborting by bitches. **As previously stated this disease fortunately does not exist in Australia**

In the event of an outbreak of any of these diseases, immediate action would be taken by the appropriate Government departments with the industry playing a supportive role. Because of the nature of these diseases automatic reporting by laboratories or veterinarians' is mandatory under law

### CATEGORY 2

The diseases listed in this category are what we call "notifiable diseases" this means that under law any laboratory or veterinarian detecting these diseases must notify the appropriate Government department this may not result in the same eradication action reaction as the reporting of a disease in category 1 Regardless under the new rules introduced by G.R.S.A. licensed person will be required to report these diseases to the CEO of G.R.S.A. or The Chairman of Stewards

### LEPTOSPOROSIS

Leptosporosis is an organism that comes in 8 different strains. The current canine vaccination protects against two strains which have shown a decreasing number of infections but unfortunately other strains have increased.

Transmission occurs through contact with effected urine; venereal and placental transfer; bite wounds, indirect transmission occurs through contaminated water, overcrowding or even bedding. Leptospira bacteria will enter the blood system and from there spread to the nervous system, kidneys, liver, spleen and eyes of the dog.

In acute infections, a fever of 103-104, shivering and muscle tenderness are the first sign, in less severe cases a dog can develop a fever, vomiting and rapid dehydration. It is important to discuss with your veterinarian the options you have in relation to vaccinations

### BRUCELLOSIS

Brucellosis is a bacteria organism with the Brucella canis strain effecting dogs primarily through the reproductive system. Brucellosis is transmitted by contact with infected fluids (vaginal, preputial) especially during breeding. Brucellosis may be transmitted from dogs to humans and can be difficult to diagnose. Symptoms of the disease are abortion, swollen lymph glands, weak or dying puppies, general weakness in some cases dogs show no sign of illness. Treatment can come in the form of a course of antibiotics unfortunately this is not always successful.

### LYME DISEASE

Lyme Disease is a Bacteria and is found in most parts of Australia U.S.A., Europe, China and Japan occupied by ticks, which is how the disease is spread. Symptoms of the disease are similar to arthritis, limping, sore feet or legs, with lymph node swelling in your dogs effected leg along with an elevated temperature. Treatment usually comes in the form of a course of antibiotics and even with treatment your dog could suffer permanent joint or nerve damage and possible damage to the heart muscle.

Preventing tick bites is therefore the obvious prevention to Lyme disease preventing ticks on dogs is similar to and can be achieved in conjunction with preventing fleas.

Although some of these diseases are not currently in Australia they have been included in the plan in the unlikely event of one getting into the country as the equine influenza recently did. Although some of these diseases are covered by inoculations they have been included as a precautionary procedure.
