AMENDMENTS TO NATIONAL RACING RULES

A review of the National Racing Rules (NRR) occurs each year, with any subsequent recommendations, where deemed appropriate, adopted by the GA board.

The application of NRR provides for greater uniformity throughout Australia and minimises the need for jurisdictional based local rules. In this regard, the integrity of greyhound racing is critically dependent on NRR to ensure consistency for trainers and jurisdictional controlling bodies.

Accordingly, Greyhounds Australasia (GA) today announced amendments to the National Racing Rules (NRR) effective from 1 January 2009.

The NRR amendments were adopted after extensive consultation with the National Chief Stewards, the Australian Greyhound Racing Association, the Australian Greyhound Veterinary Association and the GA Rules Sub Committee.

The most significant amendments to the National Racing Rules are:

- The word "drug" is to be replaced by the phrase "prohibited substance", to be consistent with other codes of racing.
- Deletion of "GAR58" given that hurdle racing no longer occurs in any Australian jurisdiction.
- Amendment to "GAR71 Unsatisfactory Performance", to now allow a right of appeal.
- Inclusion of "GAR86(ah)", making it an offence if a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified person.
(Note, this rule is generally already in operation by most controlling bodies as a local rule. Also, it will still be at the discretion of the controlling body if they offer any exceptions under this rule.)
- Inclusion of "GAR105(A) Reportable Disease", allowing a controlling body to declare an infectious or contagious animal disease to be reportable.
(For example - this rule would have been enacted by thoroughbred jurisdictions when Equine Influenza first broke out).

Greyhounds Australasia Chief Executive Officer, Craig Taberner said today, "The process to amend the National Racing Rules is an exhaustive one, involving many key personnel and I would like to express my gratitude for their involvement."

It must be recognised that respective State legislation pertaining to individual jurisdictions may prevent the total adoption of all of the NRR. In these cases, individual jurisdictions will adopt Local Rules (LR) to provide for such legislative requirements which shall take precedence over the National Rules.

Participants are reminded of their obligation to keep abreast with amendments to the rules of racing and for more information are advised to contact their respective jurisdictional controlling body.

I also would like to report that I am very excited about the marketing plan for the upcoming Summer Chasing carnival. I think this year GRSA has really got it right! This will be the best promotion I have seen of our sport in this state by far.

2009 SKY CHANNEL ADELAIDE CUP

The 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup carnival is just around the corner and conditions for this year's event are now available. There aren't many major changes to this year's race, with all greyhounds competing having to run on all weeks to run in the Final. The Heats will be run on the 8th January and greyhounds will either run in these or be selected to run in the Interstate Challenge.

The runners that compete in the Challenge will gain automatic starts in the Cup Semi-Finals on the 15th January. The Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Final will be run on Thursday 22nd January and will carry total prizemoney of \$80,000.

You will find a copy of the Adelaide Cup conditions included with Kennel Capers this week.

The other notable date will be the Greyhound of the Year Dinner, which will again be part of the carnival next year. The dinner will be held on Saturday 17th January. Full details will be available shortly.

BRIAN JOHNSTONE MEMORIAL SEMI-FINALS

Tonight we have two Semi-Finals of the Brian Johnstone Memorial. This series is the culmination of the Classic 2008 SA Bred Futurity. It follows the three heats that were run last Wednesday. It is a great opportunity for owners to pick up good prizemoney after paying up for these greyhounds since they were pups. Prizemoney breakdowns for the remaining races are:

Semis: \$3,700 - First \$2,700 (inc \$500 to breeder); Second \$625; Third \$315; Fourth \$60

Final: \$27,590 - First \$18,740 (inc \$1,000 to breeder); Second \$4,910; Third \$2,510; Unplaced \$280

The Final will be run next Thursday 11th December. We will be conducting the box draw for the Final on track tonight at Angle Park, following race 7.

ANGLE PARK SEPARATE GRADING

The ICG met last month and I will provide a summary from that meeting for next week's Kennel Capers. However one item that was discussed was Separate Grading for Angle Park Monday & Thursdays. This has been discussed a number of times over recent years and on this occasion there was a strong consensus to trial it at Angle Park.

Following the meeting the GRSA Board has now approved the change. We are therefore now working towards introducing this. I will bring you further updates in the coming weeks as we finalise details. We are tentively aiming for a February 1st introduction, but this will depend on the GRV IT Department and how long they will need. At this stage it will be introduced on a 6 month trial basis.

Effectively the change will mean that there will be three grades in operation at Angle Park. They will be AP Thursday, AP Monday and the current AP Provincial (APD), which will continue to cover Wednesday's & some Tuesday's.

WEST END DISTANCE RACES

Trainers of stayers are reminded that the feature distance races begin next week with the running of the West End Draught Distance Prelude. This series is an important lead-up to next months Group Three West End Draught Distance Championship.

Next week will see the heats of the Distance Prelude over the 731 metres. That is followed by the \$3,500 Final on Thursday 18th December. Nominations for this race close next Monday 8th December with GRSA at 9.00am.

This year's Distance Championship has been moved back a week due to Christmas Day being on the Thursday. The heats of the Group Three feature will be on Thursday 1st January 2009. While the \$25,000 Final is to be run on Adelaide Cup Heat night, which is Thursday 8th January. Nominations for the Championship close on Monday

ANGLE PARK TRACK TURNOVER

Owners & trainers are advised that the next scheduled track turnover for Angle Park will be on Friday 12th December. Once again we will be adding some higher clay material to keep up the clay content. There will be no trials on Saturday 13th December as a result of this.

FUTURITY PAYMENTS DUE THIS MONTH

The next batch of payments are due on Friday 19th December and there will be three series for which payments will need to be made.

The payments due are:

Breeders 2009 – Final Payment - Pups Born Nov 06 To Apr 07

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. **The Final Payment is \$110 per greyhound.**

Classic 2009 – Second Payment - Pups Born May 07 To Oct 07

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments or a Final payment was made last June. **The Second Sustaining Payment is \$44 per pup or a Final Payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

Breeders 2010 – First Payment - Pups Born Nov 07 To Apr. 08

Finally the First Payment is due for Breeders 2010. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. **The First Payment is \$22 per pup or a “one-off” Final payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

Race 7 tonight the Mixed 3/4 will carry an extra bonus for punters, it will include an Exacta Jackpot of \$1,837.23.

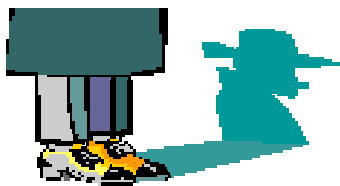
FIRST 4 JACKPOT AT ALBION PARK

DISEASE PLAN INFORMATION**EMERGENCY DISEASE PLAN INFORMATION 3**

Our recent articles have touched on the first two stages of the disease plan this final one will touch on the diseases in Category 3 Although the majority of these diseases are covered by current inoculations licensed persons should be aware of them and their symptoms.

DISTEMPER

Canine distemper is a multi-systemic viral disease, which is highly contagious. The virus spreads through contact with respiratory secretion within the air. In addition to body secretion such as urine.

Distemper attacks a wide range of organs including the skin, brain, eyes, intestinal and respiratory tracts. The most common sign of distemper are nasal and eye discharge, coughing, diarrhea, and vomiting, mildly effected dogs may only cough. At this time no antiviral drug exists, that affect the canine distemper virus. The distemper virus can be quickly killed by disinfectants, sunlight and heat.

CANNINE PARVO VIRUS

As the name implies Parvo is a virus. The main source of the virus is the faeces of infected dogs; susceptible animals become infected by ingesting the virus.

Parvo is resistant to the effects of heat, detergents and alcohol and has been recovered from dog faeces for as long as 3 months it has also been reported that the virus could live in the soil for up to 9 months. The virus is easily spread via the hair or feet of infected dogs, contaminated shoes, clothes, direct contact between dogs is not required to spread the virus. Symptoms of Parvo are severe vomiting and diarrhea, lack of appetite, depression and fever it is important to note that many dogs may not show every clinical sign but vomiting and diarrhea are the most common signs. Although very rare, cases have occurred where dogs that have previously been vaccinated and have come down with the virus.

HEPATITIS

Hepatitis is a serious contagious viral disease of dogs. Dogs acquire this disease by inhaling or ingesting the virus present in the urine, nasal and eye secretions of infected animal's. After entering the blood stream, the virus attacks the liver, eyes, kidneys and the inner linings of blood vessels in the body. Once infected no treatment will destroy the virus. It takes approximately five days for the infection to become apparent to owners with symptoms quite variable, the most common signs are lethargy, loss of appetite, and diarrhea. Pets often drink more as the disease progresses many cases develop a swollen abdomen and yellowish (jaundiced) gums, eyes and skin.

CORONA VIRUS

Canine Corona Virus is a highly contagious, and is normally transmitted when a dog ingests faeces from another infected dog and is the cause of severe diarrhea in puppies which lasts between two to seven days. Most puppies recover after a few days but in severe cases, puppies under the age of three months can die. The main sign of corona virus in puppies is watery diarrhea, with the possibility of dehydration. Preventing corona virus is as simple as maintaining good house keeping pens free of faeces and cleaning the area with appropriate disinfectants. No specific treatment combats the Canine Corona Virus

BABESIOSIS

This is a disease which is caused by tick borne parasites and is found in Australia and is commonly found in greyhounds in America. Symptoms of Babesiosis are loss of appetite, depressed, running a fever, with gums that are very pale. Failure to seek treatment for this condition could result in chronic kidney failure and liver failure the best prevention for babesiosis is to be tick conscious, use shampoos and dip products that kill and repel ticks.

The important message that has to come out of this exercise is that expert advice indicates the possibility of having to implement this plan is low. With trainers ensuring all inoculations are current, with good kennel hygiene, and vigilance by all licensed persons and liaison with your veterinarian we can combine to ensure our industry remains safe.

FROM THE GRADER**ON-LINE NOMINATIONS**

Since the on-line nominations have started we have had 110 trainers register for this service. This year around 49% of nominations are processed on-line. I expect this to grow to over 50% by the end of the year. Registration forms are available from GRSA.

This option previously has been available when the temperature was forecast to be over thirty degrees. This will be controlled by the GRSA staff and we request that trainers take directions given by them. When the kennels are used on a Saturday morning, it means that cleaning is required prior to Monday night, so we need to manage this. We would ask that trainers don't just use the kennels simply because "they can", but to help us with this.
