

**OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT**

**BRIAN JOHNSTONE MEMORIAL FINAL**

We are down to the big one tonight with the running of the inaugural Group Three Brian Johnstone Memorial Final. This race is the climax of the SA Bred Classic 2008 series for greyhounds that were whelped between May 07 and October 07. It follows on from the Breeders 2008 series run in the first half of the year.

GRSA believes that this race will be a fitting tribute to Brian, who put in so much time and effort for greyhound racing in South Australia. The first two series can be considered a success and with the numbers strong for the two series in 2009, it is hoped that both can be expanded in the future and the finals grow over the coming years.

Congratulations must go to the Kelly camp on qualifying five greyhounds from their Collide – Fair Dancer litter. Between them the five have won over 50 races and \$71,000 in prizemoney, with a good portion of that coming from the Classic 2009 series. Uncle Remus will be looking to take out his second futurity race for the year, after winning the Gawler Produce back in July.

The Final tonight carries total prizemoney of \$27,590, with the winner receiving \$18,740, which includes \$1,000 to breeder. The runner-up picks up \$4,910, while third receives \$2,510. Unplaced runners pick-up \$280 each.

There will be a presentation to the winning connections on track after the event.

**2009 SKY CHANNEL ADELAIDE CUP**

As advised last week the conditions for the 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup are available and we are looking forward to a great month of racing. The main change this year is that we are closing nominations for the Adelaide Cup at the normal time of Monday morning. We hope that this will make it easier for trainers and will make the selection for the Advertiser Interstate Challenge much simpler.

The other change to the carnival is that the Group Three West End Distance Championship will run a week later due to Christmas Day falling on a Thursday.

#### **WEST END DRAUGHT DISTANCE PRELUDE**

Owners and trainers should please note that we are running the West End Draught Distance Prelude tonight as a Prelude to the final next week. It was decided to keep faith with those trainers that nominated for the heats and run the single "heat" tonight, rather than call for fresh nominations for the Final next week. This means that all greyhounds that run tonight will go into next week's \$3,500 final.

The other important issue was to ensure that we gave the greyhounds a 731m run this week, as this series is designed to be a lead-up to next month's West End Draught Distance Championship.

Another reminder of the varying start times for the Angle Park Wednesday meetings over the next few weeks.

Bookmaker Peter Damarell has agreed to operate at the Christmas Eve and New Years Eve meetings.

#### **ANGLE PARK TRACK TURNOVER**

Owners & trainers are advised that the next scheduled track turnover for Angle Park will be tomorrow (Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December). Once again we will be adding some higher clay material to keep up the clay content. There will be no trials on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> December as a result of this.

#### **INDUSTRY CONSULTATIVE GROUP**

The Industry Consultative Group met last month and to keep all greyhound participants informed, following is a summary of items discussed. I have already advised you of the separate grading recommendation for Angle Park, which the GRSA Board has approved. We are hoping to instigate that by February 1<sup>st</sup>, depending on upgrading of the database.

Other items discussed were:

- **Angle Park Emptying Out Area**

A quote had been received for a second option for the Angle Park emptying out area. This involved a ramp up to the mound area and using some of the current grassed area. The quote had come in at approximately \$40,000. This has been included in the Capital Budget to commence in this financial year.

- **Angle Park Track**

There was discussion on injuries in trials and asked whether there was an injury book available to report them. The meeting was advised that there was an injury form which the Animal Welfare Officer follows up.

There was discussion on the track not being graded as often. The Chairman of Stewards advised that the track should be graded after every 10 trials. This has since been actioned.

The OM spoke on the CalcClear device which was currently being tested at Angle Park and also the salt content which is being constantly monitored.

- **Starting Boxes –**

The meeting recommended the Board go back to AGRA and suggest a 500mm grille.

In July 2007 AGRA agreed upon a recommended grille height of between 370mm & 400mm.

This was to affect all new starting boxes built from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2009. This followed on from feedback from all states which include a survey that was completed by trainers in SA.

The Board has discussed the issue further and has approved that the Gawler & Angle Park grilles be changed to the 400mm standard. We will be actioning that in the new year.

- **Straight Track Racing**

There was general discussion on the future of straight track racing in SA. The discussion included Murray Bridge, 400m racing, a "horsehoe track" for SA, finish on lure, numbers of greyhounds that can only run shorter distances and others. The result of the discussions were for Industry Rep, Dr. John Katakasi and Chairman of Stewards, Paul Marks to form a sub-committee to look at a "racing plan" for SA.

- **Kennel Facilities for Saturday Trials**

It was agreed that we would open some kennels on Saturday mornings and that the idea of opening the underneath area if required was also discussed. This has now been actioned.

- **Kennels Behind Catching Pen**

I advised the meeting that this had been put on the maintenance list.

- **Disease Plan Update**

The Chairman of Stewards spoke on the disease plan and how this had been upgraded.

- **Microchipping**

The Chairman of Stewards spoke on the current position regarding microchipping. The meeting discussed some of the aspects of this.

- **New requirements for Trainers and Breeders**

The Chairman of Stewards spoke on new requirements for Trainers and Breeders. He advised that all new Trainers would require police checks in the future. He also spoke on moves that Breeders would be registered in the future for a \$25 fee and that new Breeders would be required to go through the normal checks and police checks as per a registered person.

- **Handling of Greyhounds at the Boxes**

There was comment that when dogs were at the boxes a number of times the lead of the No. 7 handler had been thrown in front of the No. 8 which can sometimes get in the way of that greyhound. The Chairman of Stewards commented that he had had one complaint about this in the past and this has been looked at.

- **First Split Timer**

There was comment that the first split timer at Angle Park for hand slips did appear to be inaccurate at times. The Chairman of Stewards advised this will be looked at. He also advised that in early December there would be an upgrade of the timing system that would enable individual splits for all greyhounds for both the first split and the back split for all races to be registered having individual dogs.

The next meeting of the Industry Consultative Group is listed for Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2009. All participants are encouraged to make submissions to the Group for discussion. This can either be done through an ICG delegate, or you can send them to me at the GRSA office.

## **CHRISTMAS RACING**

Christmas falls on a Thursday night this year, so we will miss a Thursday meeting on the 25<sup>th</sup>. As a result there are some changes to the "normal" racing schedule during the Christmas week. Angle Park will race on Monday (night), Tuesday (day) and Wednesday (day - Christmas Eve) in the lead-up to Christmas Day. The Monday night and Tuesday afternoon meetings will both be APK meetings with Monday Night prizemoney levels. The Wednesday meeting will be the normal APD fixture.

Gawler will race on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> December as a twilight Sky Channel fixture. This will be run at normal Tuesday prizemoney levels. We have been allotted a ten race program, with the first race at 5.34pm. Then Port Pirie races on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> December as a twilight Sky Channel meeting, with the first race of ten at 5.18pm.

**FUTURITY PAYMENTS DUE NEXT FRIDAY**

**The next batch of payments are due next Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December** and there will be three series for which payments will need to be made.

The payments due are:

***Breeders 2009 – Final Payment - Pups Born Nov 06 To Apr 07***

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. **The Final Payment is \$110 per greyhound.**

***Classic 2009 – Second Payment - Pups Born May 07 To Oct 07***

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments or a Final payment was made last June. **The Second Sustaining Payment is \$44 per pup or a Final Payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

***Breeders 2010 – First Payment - Pups Born Nov 07 To Apr. 08***

Finally the First Payment is due for Breeders 2010. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. **The First Payment is \$22 per pup or a “one-off” Final payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

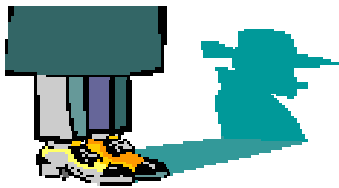

### 2008 BRIAN JOHNSTONE MEMORIAL FINAL

The 2008 Brian Johnstone Memorial final will be run in Race 8 on tonight's card. This series has seen one kennel shine with 5 runners making it through with the chance to capture the \$17,770 winner's purse. All (8) runners are SA bred and over half of the field are from the one litter, Collide/Fair Dancer trained by Todd Kelly.

Todd's runners tonight have amassed 51 wins and 76 placing's from 232 starts, with nearly \$72,000 in prize money together. Uncle Remus coming from box 2 looks the stand out performer here, his usually slow box manners shouldn't be too much of a worry tonight. His past two wins in 30.16 and 30.23 make him the favourite for the final prize. Dancing Dash drawn in the squeeze box (5) and Stellar Flare (7) seem to be the main dangers.

With the Group 3 status placed on this race and an overall prize money of \$27,590 this is certainly shaping up to be a classy event on the GRSA racing calendar. This is also one of the few events carrying this level of prize money that is purely for SA bred greyhounds which provides an excellent showcase for SA talent. With a breeders bonus of \$1000 this is a series that will only gain momentum in the years to come.
