**LAST KENNEL CAPERS FOR 2008**

Welcome to the final Kennel Capers for 2008. As Christmas Day falls on Thursday next week and we have no race meeting, we won't be publishing again until Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> January. That will see the kick-off of the big races, with the heats of the West End Draught Distance Championship and the New Year Sprint.

So on behalf of all at GRSA, we take this opportunity to wish everyone a Merry Christmas and a prosperous 2009.

**GRSA OFFICE CLOSURE ON MONDAY**

Please take note that due to staff training, the GRSA office will be closed on Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> December between 11am and 12 noon. The phone will be on recorded service during this time.

**CHRISTMAS OFFICE CLOSURE**

Could you also please note that the GRSA office will close at 3pm on Christmas Eve (Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> December). It will reopen on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> December at normal time. Fields for Gawler on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> December should be available on Wednesday shortly after noon.

The only other day that the office will be closed over Christmas/New Year is Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> January (New Years Day). As we are racing that night, the racenight office will be open from the start of kennelling.

**HOBART THOUSAND PREVIEW**

The big race coming through tonight will be The Hobart Thousand. The race is a Group One event with prizemoney to the winner of \$75,000. We will have a full coverage tonight at Angle Park on the tote and coverage through Sky Channel.

Look to the end of Kennel Capers for Neil Brown's comprehensive preview of the race.

**GAWLER SUNDAY THIS WEEK**

Gawler will race on Sunday (21<sup>st</sup> December) as a twilight Sky Channel fixture. It is being run at normal Tuesday prizemoney levels. We have a ten event program, with the first race at 5.34pm and a slightly later finish of 8.49pm.

This meeting replaces the normal Tuesday afternoon fixture and will feature the \$2,250 Ryles Family Christmas Cup to be run over the 643m distance. It looks like a pretty interesting race, including Brian Johnstone Memorial winner, Uncle Remus.

**PORT PIRIE TWILIGHT SUNDAY WEEK**

Also a reminder that Port Pirie races on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> December as a twilight Sky Channel meeting, with the first race of ten at 5.18pm. Nominations close on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> December at 9.00am with GRSA.

**GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH NOVEMBER**

Judges came down to two clear choices for the November Greyhound of the Month, with both White Admiral and Risk It attracting first preferences. White Admiral on the strength of his Gawler Cup efforts and Risk It for his interstate performances over the long distance. In the end it was White Admiral that pulled the most votes, receiving 5 first votes to 2 for Risk It.

An illness to part owner Jan Jones earlier in the year saw White Admiral transferred to Ken Gill's care. After recovering Jan has gone back to training most of her team, however she left "the Admiral" with Ken and it has proved a winning move for the combination.

White Admiral heralded the Gawler win with a strong performance in his heat of the SA Sprint Championship last month. While he was well back in the final, it was a sign of things to come and at Gawler he won both heat and final, recording 30.70 and 30.77.

At the end of the month his record was 36 starts for 16 wins and 6 placings and earnings of over \$33,000. He adds another interesting name to the contenders for a finalist spot in the Greyhound of the Year title in what looks one of the most open awards for a few years.

The 2008 Greyhound of the Year will be announced at the dinner on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> January. Also to be announced on the night will be the 2008 Distance Greyhound of the Year and the 2008 SA Greyhound of the Year, which is sponsored by Inductomag.

#### **WEST END DISTANCE TRIAL**

The greyhound Awesimus Maximus, which is trained by Phillis Brown from Loch in Victoria will solo trial tonight as a lead up to the West End Distance Championship Heats on 1<sup>st</sup> January.

The greyhound is going to trial over the 731m between races 2 & 3.

#### **2009 SKY CHANNEL ADELAIDE CUP**

As advised last week the conditions for the 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup are available and we are looking forward to a great month of racing. The main change this year is that we are closing nominations for the Adelaide Cup at the normal time of Monday morning. We hope that this will make it easier for trainers and will make the selection for the Advertiser Interstate Challenge much simpler.

The other change to the carnival is that the Group Three West End Distance Championship will run a week later due to Christmas Day falling on a Thursday.

### **GRADING REVIEW PANEL**

Following is a summary from the most recent Grading Review Panel meeting:

#### **- Veterans Races**

The report of the Veterans' races was included with the agenda. It showed that there were no Veterans' races run since the last Grading Review Panel meeting.

It was suggested to trial a Veterans race once a month on a Thursday and replace the Non Penalty and leave the Grade 5 on the Wednesday calendar. The first of these has been programmed for January 29<sup>th</sup>; it will be a \$1,000 non/penalty Veterans event.

#### **- Semi Final Selection**

The previously published semi-final selection policy was supported by the meeting. This has been approved as a policy by the GRSA Board and is now in use.

#### **- Consecutive Racing Rule**

CHoS advised that he had looked at the rule and that it would be hard to change the current rule other than to stop it outright with regard to greyhounds running in Finals.

It was agreed to set the policy that once a greyhound makes a Final field it cannot nominate for another race on the day prior or the day after. It was agreed to include this in the conditions of Feature Races. The GRSA Board has approved this policy.

#### **- Nominations for Feature Heats**

The Grader spoke on an issue he had in recent times with Trainers not nominating for Feature Heats, however, he has been placing them into the Heats to ensure the races have enough numbers. He commented that when there were Grade 5 Heats on a Thursday that 24 might nominate for a Grade 5 and only 10 might nominate for Heats. He currently puts all the greyhounds into the Heats regardless and had not had any problems with Trainers to this point. However, this could leave us open to having to allow Trainers to scratch without penalty. He also commented how it appears that people just weren't looking at the calendar program instead of being published.

The meeting agreed that the Grader should continue with this current process and that the OM would write something in Kennel Capers advising Trainers that unless they put "No Heats" then greyhounds will be put into Heats. The GRSA Board has approved this policy.

The Racing Officer commented on the availability of putting the programmed races on the on-line system. This will be something that we would move to in the near future.

#### **- Distance Racing Review**

It was suggested that the break-up of prizemoney be looked at to encourage nominations. Possibly paying less to the winner and more to the placegetters; also increasing total prizemoney for distance events.

We will look closer at the programming and will report back on distance races run.

#### **-Maidens Wins After Close Of Nominations**

It was recommended that if a maiden greyhound wins after nominations close, that then if the trainer contacts the Grader prior to fields being drawn, then the grader can transfer it to another grade. This is particularly in the case of a Maiden win, that it can be transferred to a Graduation. This policy has been approved by the GRSA Board.

This will only apply if the greyhound has been nominated for the meeting.

The next Grading Review Panel meeting will be on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2009. I would encourage anyone that has thoughts for a submission to send them to me to include in the Agenda. They should reach me by Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January.

### **CHRISTMAS RACING**

Christmas falls on a Thursday night this year, so we will miss a Thursday meeting on the 25<sup>th</sup>. As a result there are some changes to the "normal" racing schedule during the Christmas week. Angle Park will race on Monday (night), Tuesday (day) and Wednesday (day - Christmas Eve) in the lead-up to Christmas Day. The Monday night and Tuesday afternoon meetings will both be APK meetings with Monday Night prizemoney levels. The Wednesday meeting will be the normal APD fixture.

## FUTURITY PAYMENTS DUE TOMORROW

**The next batch of payments are due tomorrow (Friday 19<sup>th</sup> December)** and there are three series for which payments will need to be made.

The payments due are:

**Breeders 2009 – Final Payment - Pups Born Nov 06 To Apr 07**

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. **The Final Payment is \$110 per greyhound.**

**Classic 2009 – Second Payment - Pups Born May 07 To Oct 07**

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments or a Final payment was made last June. **The Second Sustaining Payment is \$44 per pup or a Final Payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

**Breeders 2010 – First Payment - Pups Born Nov 07 To Apr. 08**

Finally the First Payment is due for Breeders 2010. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. **The First Payment is \$22 per pup or a “one-off” Final payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**
