### **STEWARDS REPORT by Paul Marks**

#### **FINISHING ON LURE**

Industry participants would be aware finishing on the lure has been widely discussed for sometime now. A Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) survey conducted in May 2008 indicated 70% of the 412 respondents supported finishing on the lure.

GRSA were aware Greyhound Queensland Limited (GQL) in conjunction with the Brisbane Greyhound Racing Club (BGRC) had been conducting trials with finishing on the lure since September 2008. Discussions with the GQL indicated the trials have proved very successful with a majority of their trainers requesting finishing on the lure be introduced for races.

CEO of GRSA Peter Ali requested I visit Albion Park with our Maintenance Supervisor John Taylor to inspect their lure/track system. While visiting Albion Park, John and I viewed a number of single and four greyhound field trials and were very impressed with their system. Feedback from trainers' trialling their greyhounds on that day were very positive and supportive. Since our visit, Albion Park has conducted numerous eight greyhound field trials and will introduce at Albion Park from 5 January 2009, finishing on the lure for races

At the December 2008 GRSA Board meeting, I recommended GRSA trial finishing on the lure at Angle Park from early February 2009.

I further recommended that subject to the success of the trials, GRSA commence finishing on the lure for races conducted at Angle Park in March 2009. At this time the introduction of finishing on the lure will be conducted at Angle Park only.

Whilst the introduction of finishing on the lure to other tracks will not be considered until later in 2009, Stewards in the meantime will work with Clubs and compile a list of requirements and conditions for those who wish to introduce this initiative at their track.

### **OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT by Peter Smith**

#### **WELCOME TO 2009**

Welcome to a new year of Kennel Capers and we wish all our readers a happy and successful 2009. Already the new year looks like one of change, with Angle Park separate grading and the finish on lure already approved. These initiatives should both be instigated in the early months of 2009.

#### **WEST END DRAUGHT DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIP HEATS**

Tonight will see the running of the 3 heats of the 2009 West End Draught Distance Championship. The Group Three event heralds the start of the West End Summer Chasing Carnival. The \$25,000 Final will be run next Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> January, with the winner's purse of \$17,500.

Half of the nominations come from interstate, with the Rob Britton pair of Gunnadoo Magic and Kulu Spirit heading them. The John Mooney trained Others Quoted, from NSW, is already a Group race winner and trialled well at Angle Park last week running 43.33. Western Land for Jason Thompson has been placed at Group level and Fast Dream was the recent winner of the West End Distance Prelude series at Angle Park.

Risk It will head up the local charge and perhaps has his best chance to open his Group race duck, on his home track. He has run some excellent races against top company of late for trainer Troy Murray. Uncle Remus (Todd Kelly) and C'mon Bella (Clinton Trengrove) both have performed well over the sprint and middle distances, but have also won over the longer trip. Awesome Ryles, trained by Geoff Ryles is an interesting runner, having his first distance start, following a hard finishing second in the recent Christmas Cup at Gawler.

The box draw for the West End Draught Distance Final will take place on track tonight following the presentation after race 8.

## **NEW YEAR SPRINT**

The other highlight of racing on this evening will be the running of the \$3,500 New Year Sprint. Scull Murphy will be looking to repeat his win in this race last year when he ran a slick 29.66 seconds. Rick's Pride which has been racing well for trainer Petar Jovanovic in Victoria of late makes a return to Angle Park in the race. The winner of the New Year Sprint gains automatic entry to next Week's Advertiser Interstate Challenge if nominated for the Sky Channel Adelaide Cup.

## **2009 SKY CHANNEL ADELAIDE CUP NOMINATIONS**

A final reminder to all trainers that the nominations for the 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup will close next Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January with GRSA at 9.00am. The Heats and the Interstate Challenge will be run next Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> January.

The Adelaide Cup Selection Panel will meet on Monday morning to determine the runners for the \$10,000 Advertiser Interstate Challenge. Four greyhounds from interstate will be selected to run against four locals and the eight greyhounds that compete in this race will be seeded into the Cup semi-finals. The winner of tonight's New Year Sprint will gain automatic entry. The other greyhounds nominated for the Adelaide Cup will; compete in the \$3,250 heats. The members of the Selection Panel are Greg Barber (Chairman), Shaun Mathieson, Vaun Gray, Craig Cook, Brenton Yates and myself.

### **STEWARDS REPORT** *by Paul Marks*

#### **INQUIRY RESULT MRS. R KELLY**

The inquiry with Mrs. R Kelly into the positive urine sample taken from the greyhound FLAME MCBAIN at the Port Augusta Greyhound Racing Club SA meeting held at Port Augusta on 11<sup>th</sup> October 2008 has been completed on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> December 2008.

Mrs. Kelly was charged with a breach of the GRSA Rules Of Greyhound Racing R83 which reads:

R83 Racing greyhound to be drug free

- (2) The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound-
  - (a) nominated to compete in an Event;
  - (b) presented for a satisfactory, weight or whelping trial or such other trial as provided for pursuant to these Rules; or
  - (c) presented for any test or examination for the purpose of a period of incapacitation or prohibition being varied or revoked shall present the greyhound free of any drug.
- (3) The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound presented contrary to sub-rule (2) shall be guilty of an offence.
- (4) A greyhound presented for an Event contrary to sub-rule (2) shall be disqualified from the Event or any benefit derived from a trial or test.

Mrs. Kelly pleaded guilty to the charge and was disqualified for a period of 7 months effective midnight 24<sup>th</sup> December 2008.

Stewards acting under rule R83(4) disqualified FLAME MCBAIN from the Event and amended the placing accordingly.

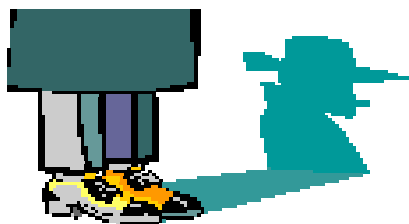

## ***FROM THE GRADER***

Another reminder of policies approved from the last Grading Review Panel meeting:

### **- Consecutive Racing Rule**

Chairman of Stewards advised that he had had a look at the rule and that it would be hard to change the current rule other than to stop it outright with regard to greyhounds running in Finals.

It was agreed to set the policy that once a greyhound makes a Final field it cannot nominate for another race on the day prior or the day after. It was agreed to include this in the conditions of Feature Races. The GRSA Board has approved this policy.

### **- Nominations for Feature Heats**

The Grader spoke on an issue he had in recent times with Trainers not nominating for Feature Heats, however, he has been placing them into the Heats to ensure the races have enough numbers. He commented that when there were Grade 5 Heats on a Thursday that 24 might nominate for a Grade 5 and only 10 might nominate for Heats. He currently puts all the greyhounds into the Heats regardless and had not had any problems with Trainers to this point. However, this could leave us open to having to allow Trainers to scratch without penalty. He also commented how it appears that people just weren't looking at the calendar program instead of being published.

The meeting agreed that the Grader should continue with this current process and that the OM would write something in Kennel Capers advising Trainers that unless they put "No Heats" then greyhounds will be put into Heats. The GRSA Board has approved this policy.

The Racing Officer commented on the availability of putting the programmed races on the on-line system. This will be something that we would move to in the near future.

### **-Maidens Wins After Close Of Nominations**

It was recommended that if a maiden greyhound wins after nominations close, that then if the trainer contacts the Grader prior to fields being drawn, then the grader can transfer it to another grade. This is particularly in the case of a Maiden win, that it can be transferred to a Graduation. This policy has been approved by the GRSA Board.

This will only apply if the greyhound has been nominated for the meeting.

The next Grading Review Panel meeting will be on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2009. I would encourage anyone that has thoughts for a submission to send them to me to include on the Agenda. They should reach me by Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> January.
