**2008 WEST END SUMMER CHASING CARNIVAL**

**West End Draught Distance Championship**

What a great final we have tonight for the Group Three West End Draught Distance Championship. Last week we saw three competitive heats with all winners running around the 43.3 mark and a draw which has guaranteed a great betting race. On a windy night, last week I would suggest that times were probably affected, so one could expect that tonight's winner will need to be running somewhere around the 43 second mark or better. No doubt that the three winners Gunnadoo Magic, Risk It and Others Quoted all stake strong claims on the title. However Fast Bond, Fast Dream and Kulu Spirit all ran well and luck is going to play a big part tonight. Western Land made good ground late to qualify, while Ling Wah deserves special mention for his effort to qualify in close to a personal best. Not a bad effort for a five year old having his 159<sup>th</sup> Start.

The West End Draught Distance Championship carries total prizemoney of \$25,000, an increase of \$3,500 on last year. The winners share is \$17,500, along with a trophy and rug.

**The Advertiser Interstate Challenge**

The West End Summer Chasing Carnival starts to get into the serious side of the racing with the Sky Channel Adelaide Cup. An integral part of that series is the \$10,000

The Advertiser Interstate Challenge, with the runners that compete tonight going straight through to next week's semi-finals.

Australia's current star El Galo heads the interstate brigade, along with kennelmate Proven Polly, Spiral Glory and Kingdom King. The Michael Giniotis trained Kingdom King is considered an interstate greyhound under the domiciliary conditions.

Scull Murphy & Quinton Bale head the local runners, along with Jaykayell and Drink Driver, which are both resuming from short spells. The reserves are White Admiral (SA) and Tashy Boy (Interstate). White Admiral will go in should an SA greyhound be scratched and Tashy Boy will replace an interstate scratching. Both will get a start if there are two scratchings. Scull Murphy will be looking to go one better this year after finishing runner-up to Tasman Queen last year. That was after he gained a run by winning the New Year Sprint, as he has done this year.

Apart from the prizemoney, the winner will also receive a trophy and beautiful "Kay Versari" rug.

**Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Heats**

The other 24 spots for next week's Semi-Finals will be determined by the 6 Heats of the Sky Channel Adelaide Cup. The local greyhounds will get plenty of chances to get through to next week's Semi-Finals. The timing of both the Cranbourne Cup and Gosford Cup, along with injuries to a number of leading chances has seen a small number of interstate nominations this year.

There will be four Semi-Finals run next Thursday night. The eight runners in the Interstate Challenge go through, along with the first four in each of the heats. Prizemoney for the Semis is \$6,500 total and the first two in each will go through to the \$80,000 Final on the 22<sup>nd</sup> January.

**Pre-Post Market On Final**

Bookmaker Peter Damarell will be offering a pre-post market on the Adelaide Cup Final. He has offered this service in recent years. The market will be available from tonight on track and he will be offering odds on the Final throughout the carnival.

**John Gray Memorial**

Trainers please note that the nominations for the John Gray Memorial Grade 5 heats on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> January close at 9.00am on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> January. Prizemoney for the Final on Adelaide Cup night is \$6,000.

#### **GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH – DECEMBER**

After what was a tight month of voting, Scull Murphy has taken out his second monthly award of 2008 in winning the Greyhound of the Month in December. Judges were varied in their opinions and first votes were received by Quinton Bale and Uncle Remus as well as “the Scull”. However Scull Murphy scored the most total votes. He was also rewarded with a nomination as one of the Finalists for the Greyhound of the Year.

During December, the reigning Greyhound of the Year was perfect, having three starts at Angle Park for three wins. All the wins were in sub 30 second times and he was quite brilliant in the last win, running 29.81 and overcoming early trouble, before running away to an eight length win.

At the end of the month, Scull Murphy has taken his prizemoney earnings into the \$90,000 range and he is well poised to break the “ton” during the Sky Channel Adelaide Cup carnival. He is also approaching the 30 win mark at Angle Park.

2008 wasn't an easy year for trainer Bob Isaacson as Scull Murphy spent more time than he would have liked on the sidelines. Nevertheless he still put together a great year and will be a strong candidate to repeat his Greyhound of the Year Award.

#### **TWELVE RACES FOR CARNIVAL NIGHTS**

A further reminder to owners & trainers that we will have twelve race programs for the next three Thursday nights, This will be subject to nominations.

Racing will commence earlier for the meetings on January 8, 15 & 22<sup>nd</sup>, with the first race at around 6.25. The Adelaide Cup Final meeting on the 22<sup>nd</sup>, will finish later than normal, with the last race listed at 10.35pm. Kennelling times for the three nights will be between 5pm and 5.45pm, but check the race sheets, once fields are released.

#### **PORT PIRIE SKY ON SUNDAY**

January will see two Sky Channel twilight race meetings at Port Pirie. The first is this Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> January, where the Club has a strong ten event program. Racing commences at 5.28pm and the last will jump at 8.25pm. Those travelling to the track have the option of betting with bookmaker or tote.

The following meeting at Port Pirie will be on January 25<sup>th</sup>. This meeting has been upgraded to Sky Channel status as a twilight fixture.

#### **BREEDERS 2009 FINAL PRIZEMONEY POOL**

We have now confirmed the final pool for the Breeders 2009 Futurity Series. A total of 91 greyhounds have paid up to the Final Payment. This compares with 101 for Breeders 2008, when the starting pool was 509 pups to 431 pups for Breeders 2009.

This means that the Final prizemoney pool will be:

GRSA Industry Prize - \$25,630

Futurity Payments - \$16,370

Total - \$42,000

Added to this will be the normal race prizemonies of approx. \$18,600 (Wednesday \$600 or Thursday \$1800) This will be determined by the number of races run, but we are estimating a total of 19 races.

Final prizemoney levels will be determined for each series once nominations close. The estimates are that we will have the Preludes at \$1,100 for Heats and \$3,500 for the Finals. While the Breeders Plate is estimated at \$1,200 Heats, \$3,600 Semis and \$28,000 Final.
