Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Semi-Finals

Congratulations to all those that have a runner in tonight's Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Semi-Finals. This is what owning a greyhound is all about, just to have a chance of making a big race. Some will have realistic expectations of making the final, some will be hoping that they go to the next level and some will be just happy to have got this far. Only eight will come through tonight, so there will be plenty of disappointment. However that is all part of the thrill of being involved in a greyhound.

No doubt that last week's Advertiser Interstate Challenge has really added some spice to the series. The win by Scull Murphy over El Galo has heightened local expectations. "The Scull" with his fastest ever first section of 4.44 has thrown down the gauntlet to El Galo. However I don't think El Galo let down his supporters at his first look at Angle Park. He still came out of the boxes pretty well and should be improved by that outing. I doubt there are too many greyhounds in the nation that could run down Scull Murphy on the Angle Park track.

Drink Driver for Rob Harnas ran a nice race in the Challenge when third at his first run from a short let-up and looms as a genuine threat for the title. Quinton Bale was fourth home in that race and can't be dismissed from calculations, with the box draw helping him for the semi. Kirin Corby's, Cool Keepsake turned in the fastest heat win, running 29.96 after leading from box six. Her early speed brings her right into consideration.

As we are running four semi-finals, it means that the first two in each will gain a start in the final. The fastest two third placegetters will be declared as the reserves.

Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Box Draw

The 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Final will be run next Thursday 22nd January. It is a Group One event and carries total prizemoney of \$80,000. The winners cheque will be \$60,000.

The box draw will take place at Saturday night's SA Greyhound of the Year Dinner. We are hoping that Sky Channel will be able to take some of the vision of the box draw as was the case last year.

John Gray Memorial

The other highlight of racing tonight will be the six heats of the John Gray Memorial. The feature grade 5 series always produces a strong line-up. This year looks no different, with a number of interesting runners engaged; with six heats, the competition for a final spot will be tough, with the six winners and fastest two seconds getting through.

The John Gray Memorial Final carries total prizemoney of \$6,000 and will be one of the many highlights of next weeks Adelaide Cup Final night.

Adelaide Cup Night Arrangements

Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Final night next Thursday 22nd January will feature a twelve event program. Racing will commence at 6.25pm and the last race will jump at 10.35pm. The Cup will be race nine and is timed to start at 9.30pm.

Bookmakers and tote facilities will be available under the downstairs auditorium as is usually the case for Adelaide Cup night. We will have extra Sky Channel screens and tote TV's available for punters. The TAB Van will be available in front of the grandstand area near the track and there will also be tote facilities available for patrons in Chasers restaurant on the night.

Additional food outlets will be available for those people not eating in Chasers. Entry fee for the meeting will be \$10.00 for adults and \$5.00 for concession.

GAWLER PRODUCE PAYMENT DUE FRIDAY

A reminder to all owners that made the first payment for the 2009 Gawler Produce Stake that the second payment is due this Friday 16th January. This payment is for a fee of \$49.50 inc gst (or \$44.00 if five or more registered in the same name).

Those people that elected to make the one-off payment back in October 2008 are not required to make this payment.

After the initial payment in October there are 172 greyhounds still eligible and the total prizemoney pool is estimated to be over \$30,000. Prizemoney for the 2009 Final has been guaranteed at \$16,000.

BREEDERS 2009 FINAL PRIZEMONEY POOL

We have now confirmed the final pool for the Breeders 2009 Futurity Series. A total 91 greyhounds have paid up to the Final Payment. This compares with 101 for Breeders 2008, when the starting pool was 509 pups to 431 pups for Breeders 2009. This means that the Final prizemoney pool will be:

GRSA Industry Prize -	\$25,630
Futurity Payments -	\$16,370
Total -	\$42,000

Added to this will be the normal race prizemonies of approx. \$18,600 (Wednesday \$600 or Thursday \$1800) This will be determined by the number of races run, but we are estimating a total of 19 races.

Final prizemoney levels will be determined for each series once nominations close. The estimates are that we will have the Preludes at \$1,100 for Heats and \$3,500 for the Finals. While the Breeders Plate is estimated at \$1,200 Heats, \$3,600 Semis and \$28,000 Final.

Also included later in Kennel Capers is the full list of greyhounds that have made all of the payments for Breeders 2009.

That stunning victory has taken his record to 37 wins from just 65 starts. He has had his fair share of injuries in the past but on recent form the Bob Isaacson owned and trained star is nearly back to career best. The Jason Thompson trained El Galo started the punters elect but failed to show his blistering early pace and ran 2nd behind the 'Scull'. Drink Driver for Rob Harnas filled the placings.

Tonight at Angle Park there is the running of the 4 semi's for the Sky Channel Adelaide Cup. Race 3 (Semi 1) is stacked full of quick box dogs so whoever leads should make their way to next weeks final. I lean towards Camden Wishes as she is the most consistent on box rise. Drink Driver will be hard to beat and Very Cool will be the one rattling home over the top of them.

El Galo will be the big improver in the semi's now he has had a look at the track and no doubt he will be unbackable odds to take out Race 5 (Semi 2). The Where's Pedro speedster only needs to step and it will be all over. Zimran for Ken Gill along with Spiral Glory look the main chances of filling the minors.

Scull Murphy has been a big shortener over the week in the cup betting and should take all before him in Race 7 (Semi 3). Tony Fergusson's Cool Chill is nicely drawn in box 1 along with Cool Keepsake the main dangers.

Race 9 (Semi 4) is another race with several chances. Quinton Bale who is a greyhound of the year finalist is perfectly drawn down in box 1. If he recaptures his best form he will be the one to catch. Miss Eva Mai has taken all before her with 3 wins on the trot and has a terrific record of 8 wins & 2 placings from 13 starts at headquarters. Direct Order and Proven Polly for pick 4 punters.
