No doubt El Galo's draw of box two leaves him as a very warm favourite, but Scull Murphy's box seven also suits him.

Congratulations to Rob Harnas & Jason Thompson on both qualifying two runners each. To all those in the final I wish good luck and safe passage.

We have a comprehensive look at the race later in Kennel Capers, with both the Shadow and Neil Brown from AGRA's previews.

The Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Final is a Group One event on the AGRA Calendar. It carries total prizemoney of \$80,000 an increase of \$5,000 on last year. The winners share is \$60,000, second \$11,750, Third \$5,750 and unplaced \$500 each.

BREEDERS REGISTRATION

The GRSA Board has approved a recommendation from the Breeders Task Force to commence the Registration of Breeders. This is to begin from the licence renewal date of the 31st March and will include a \$25.00 fee.

The recommendation followed the National Responsible Breeding Task Force Recommendations and agreement by the members of the Task Force.

Anyone that has bred a litter in the past 3 years and currently holds a Public Trainer or Owner/Trainers Licence will be granted automatically a Breeders Licence on completion of application (a police report and kennel description is NOT required).

Any other person who has bred a litter within the 3 year time frame will be issued a licence at the discretion of the stewards. This is required to ensure that all litters are whelped in kennels that meet the current "Code of Practice".

New Applications or those that haven't bred for the previous 3 years will be required to meet a list of requirements and gain approval from the stewards. This criteria will be available shortly.

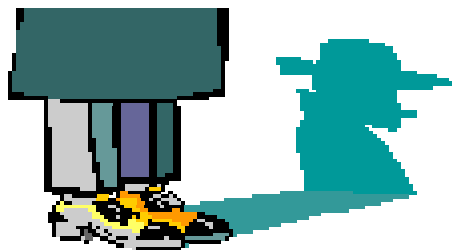

CUP NOT AS CLEAR AS IT LOOKS

South Australia's feature event of the calendar has turned out to be a two dog battle on paper 'BUT' on recent form Jason Thompson's second stringer has come right into calculations.

I'm talking about Proven Polly, who carved out a sensational 29.53 when leading throughout from box 8 to win her semi at headquarters last week. The Black Enforcer/Proven Tops sprinter beat Quinton Bale, who was just crowned SA's Greyhound Of The Year, by over 6.5L

Kennel mate and Australian Cup Favourite El Galo claimed BON honours when winning in 29.50 with sectionals of 4.41 & 16.70. The Where's Pedro/Roxy Reason chaser will only improve and with his blistering early pace is very hard to tip against. Local champ Scull Murphy didn't lose any admirers when running 2nd last week. The 'Scull' was down and out around the first turn when he missed the kick but performed his usual magic, tracked very wide and ran into more dead ends than you could imagine. Tonight in the final Scull Murphy has drawn his favourite box down in 7 where he has been unbeaten in 10 starts.

Down to the facts of a race like tonights and El Galo has the ability to open up a big break and coming from box 2 will start punters elect. All local money will be on the 'Scull' but you can't forget that there are 6 other contenders here, who showed enough class to make this final tonight. Special mention has to go to Rob Harnas who has qualified two runners in Drink Driver and Oval Avenue. David Kelly and the rest of Oval Avenue's connections are no strangers to winning big races. They tasted success a few years back with their terrific chaser in Thundering Two.

SKY CHANNEL ADELAIDE CUP FINAL
1 - DRINK DRIVER - 32 Starts - 12 wins - 9 placings: Total prizemoney - \$21650

A very talented sprinter who represented SA in last year's nationals. One of two runners in tonight's final trained by the legendary Rob Harnas at Lewiston. Has terrific box manners and has drawn his perfect box here.

2 - EL GALO - 55 Starts - 34 wins - 15 placings: Total prizemoney \$386605

Outstanding chaser who showed South Australian greyhound enthusiasts what he can do when winning in BON 29.50. Trained by the master of group races in Jason Thompson. El Galo looks the leader and will be the one for the others to catch.

3 - QUINTON BALE - 34 Starts - 18 wins - 8 placings: Total prizemoney \$48705

Just crowned Greyhound Of The Year and trained by our leading South Australian trainer in Shaun Matcott. Quinton Bale has been struggling to recapture his best form. He has been in the money in 19 from 23 starts at this venue but would need his best to salute.

4 - VERY COOL - 37 Starts - 13 wins - 14 placings: Total prizemoney \$24390

Big effort here last week when he rattled home to score over the top of Drink Driver. Tony Fergusson has done an outstanding job with this dog and his hard work has seen him claim a spot in the most prestigious race in South Australia. He will be in the mix for pick 4 punters.

5 - PROVEN POLLY - 28 Starts - 12 wins - 7 placings: Total prizemoney \$39875

On last weeks effort her price has definitely shortened. She carved out a blistering 29.53 win from box 8 and has the polish of Jason Thompson. With another look at the track she will have the two fav's looking over their shoulders. Draw is the biggest worry tonight.

6 - OVAL AVENUE - 48 Starts - 7 wins - 21 placings: Total prizemoney \$13590

Owned by a terrific bunch of blokes, this dog hasn't even won a grade 4 event but fronts up in the cup tonight. Rob Harnas has excelled himself to have two runners in the final. But if Oval Avenue even runs a place I'm sure there will be plenty of beer's downed after the event.

7 - SCULL MURPHY - 66 Starts - 37 wins - 17 placings: Total prizemoney \$104945

He was disappointing last week in the semi's when 2nd, starting a short priced favorite. But he lifted like the hulk to qualify. This weeks a different race, he is unbeaten from this draw and is nearly in career best form. His trainer doesn't leave a stone unturned and this could be the bygone. We are all cheering for you "Go the Scull"

8 - TASHY BOY - 94 Starts - 32 wins - 35 placings: Total prizemoney \$24240

Well suited by his wide draw but has a talented lot drawn on his inside. He can be hit and miss on box rise but nothing can be taken away from him in claiming his spot in the cup final.
