**2009 WEST END SUMMER CHASING CARNIVAL**

**Sky Channel Adelaide Cup Final Wrap-up**

Most people that were present on Thursday night I'm sure would agree it was a great night. The weather was good and the crowd was very big, well up on last year's hot one. Our figures suggest that it was up there with the crowd present for the Collide win for Tony Lockett in 2005. The on-course tote was up around 30% on last year and easily beat the figure set in 2005. The off-course tote for SA was also up around 10% on last year. The gross figure for all of Unitab (incl. Qld & NT) was a record of around \$565,000, up \$35,000 on last year.

The race itself was a classic two dog war, with neither El Galo or Scull Murphy damaging their reputations. Both Quinton Bale in third spot and Drink Driver in fourth ran gallant races, with the first five runners home all breaking 30 seconds. El Galo's first split was 4.39, compared to "The Scull's" 4.47, a difference of .08 second. At the finish there was just .02 between them, so you could definitely say that El Galo won it at the start. There is a strong chance that the pair will clash again in the Temlee at The Meadows next month.

The John Gray Memorial provided another highlight of the night, with another impressive performance by Manhattan Angel for trainer Laurie Cahalan. The greyhound made good use of box one to lead throughout and stop the clock at 29.94. Manhattan Angel is certainly one of the most promising greyhounds around and is likely to be set for the Breeders 2009 series, due to commence next month.

The win was Laurie's second in the event, having won with Miss Bossy in 2002.

**PORT AUGUSTA TRANSFERS**

Due to the forecast temperatures for this week, the Port Augusta meeting set down for this Saturday (31<sup>st</sup> January) has been transferred. The meeting will now be run on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> February. It remains a twilight fixture. This meeting celebrates the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Club. See the Port Augusta News for more details. Nominations will close next Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> February at 9.00am with GRSA.

The Club has also requested to move its Saturday March 21<sup>st</sup> race meeting, due to a Cricket Final. This meeting will now be run on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> March as a twilight fixture. Nominations will remain as closing on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March.

**BREEDERS 2009 PRELUDE (1)**

We published the list of greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2009 in Kennel Capers a couple of weeks ago. Now a reminder to owners & trainers regarding nominations for Breeders 2009 Prelude (1). The heats will be run on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> February, with the Final on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> February. Nominations will close on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> February at 9.00am with GRSA.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the Breeders Plate in May. Prizemoney will be finalised after nominations close, but as a guide, should we run four heats, the Final will be worth \$3,500. Based on the series totalling 19 races, the total prizemoney for Breeders 2009 is estimated at \$60,600, which includes \$16,370 in Futurity Payments.

## **MY ANI-MALL PET FOODS FINAL TRANSFERRED**

With the cancellation of the meeting at Gawler this week, all races were abandoned, with the exception of the Golden Maiden Final.

That race will now be transferred to next Tuesday's (February 3<sup>rd</sup>) race meeting at Gawler.

The My Ani-Mall Pet Foods Gawler Golden Maiden carries prizemoney of \$1,400. As there were no scratchings prior to the cancellation of the meeting, the full field will remain intact, including the two reserves for next week's Final.

## **MACRO MEATS JUVENILE FEATURE**

We received 16 nominations for the Macro Meats Juvenile and we are running two heats tonight. Ray Borda from Macro Meats has agreed to sponsorships of \$2,000 for this and another 2 feature series, which will be added to the prizemoney for the final.

The \$5,000 Macro Meats Juvenile Final will be run on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> February.

## **GAWLER PRODUCE STAKE SECOND PAYMENT**

The second payment of the Gawler Produce Stake was completed this month and the numbers have been collated and checked. After the original payment, there were 172 eligible, with 59 making the "one-off" payment.

A total of 74 have made the second payment, which when added to those that made the "one-off" payment, leaves a total of 133 greyhounds still eligible. This is well above the original estimates. If around half of those that made the second payment make the third, the total prizemoney pool will be around \$35,000, with a Final of \$16,000.

The Final payment will be due on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2009. Reminder notices will be sent out prior to this payment.

## **ANGLE PARK KENNELHOUSE FLOOR**

Trainers please note that the Kennelhouse will not be available for use at the trials on Saturday 7<sup>th</sup> February. This is due to maintenance work on the floor that will be undertaken on the Friday and during the weekend. We will organise to open the roller door near the raceday office to allow access for the morning.

## **BREEDERS REGISTRATION**

The GRSA Board has approved a recommendation from the Breeders Task Force to commence the Registration of Breeders. This is to begin from the licence renewal date of the 31<sup>st</sup> March and will include a \$25.00 fee.

The recommendation followed the National Responsible Breeding Task Force Recommendations and agreement by the members of the Task Force.

Anyone that has bred a litter in the past 3 years and currently holds a Public Trainer or Owner/Trainers Licence will be granted automatically a Breeders Licence on completion of application (a police report and kennel description is NOT required).

Any other person who has bred a litter within the 3 year time frame will be issued a licence at the discretion of the stewards. This is required to ensure that all litters are whelped in kennels that meet the current "Code of Practice".

New Applications or those that haven't bred for the previous 3 years will be required to meet a list of requirements and gain approval from the stewards. This criteria will be available shortly.

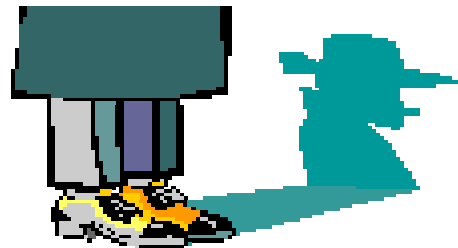

### **EL GALO REIGNS SUPREMO**

Billed as the biggest race on the South Australian Greyhound Racing calendar, the Sky Channel Adelaide Cup certainly didn't let greyhound enthusiasts and supporters down. This year's event gave GRSA a fantastic kick start to 2009.

It definitely looked to be a two dog war on paper and that is exactly how it turned out to be. Hot race favourite in El Galo was making his 3<sup>rd</sup> trip to South Australia in as many weeks but he didn't disappoint his legion of fans when on box rise he flew the lids from box 2. He quickly opened up a handy break into the back. Local champ Scull Murphy who had beaten El Galo only two weeks prior in the Interstate Challenge was in hot pursuit, as both speedsters entered the back straight. Rounding the home turn and the 'Scull' looked to have El Galo's measure but he drifted wide and the front running champ went on to win another Group 1 event by .50L in the sizzling 29.46.

By Where's Pedro/Roxy Reason the Jason Thompson trained sprinter collected a handy \$60,000 for the win added to his prior earnings has rocketed over the \$440,000 mark in prizemoney. Owned by Jason's partner Seona Hood, El Galo has now had 56 starts for 35 wins and 15 placings.

The blue dog continued to improve with every run around the tricky Angle Park circuit and with his sectionals of 4.37 – 16.65 and 29.46 he was always going to be the one to beat. Jason won the race last year with Whippy's Image and I'm sure that he will look at returning to Adelaide and have a crack at winning 3 cups on end. In winning the 2009 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup El Galo joins a prestigious list of previous winners, the likes of Brett Lee (2001), Collide (2005), Miss Spicy (2006) and Big Time Max (2007). So what does the future hold for El Galo, he will tackle the Australian Cup and if all goes to plan he will head to Sydney for The Golden Easter Egg. When his racing career is over there is no doubt that his stud services will be highly sought after.

Scull Murphy once again showed true guts and determination and the rising 4 year old certainly didn't lose any admirers when he chased his heart out. I'm sure that it will only be a matter of time before he cracks another big win prior to his retirement. Quinton Bale rounded out the placings some 6L off the winner with Drink Driver for Rob Harnas filling out the pick 4.

This year's cup attracted a lot of new faces at the track. Let's hope that the newcomers to the spectacle that is greyhound racing will return through the turnstiles in the near future.

### **CAHALAN WINS MEMORIAL**

The John Gray Memorial has certainly been a race to win for all local trainers in the past. It is programmed around the summer chasing carnival and designed for grade 5 dogs where it provides the greyhounds which are not quite ready to tackle the Adelaide Cup a crack at a quality event. With \$4080.00 on offer for the winner it is not to be sneezed at. This year the Laurie Cahalan trained Manhattan Angel went into the race with first class form and continued to shine when he led throughout in 29.94 from box 1.

By Kiowa Sweet/Cabernet Angel he has only had 16 starts for 7 wins and 3 placings.

Owned by the Murphy Roubos duo, Manhattan Angel made short work to win by 4L over Savage Shaker with the Matty Payne Super Conquest running a solid 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Well done to all connected with the programming of these types of races, to the sponsors who put their hard earned in and to connections for winning the 2009 John Gray Memorial.

Stewards today opened and completed an inquiry following a complaint lodged by Mrs L.Young into the circumstances of the sale, of the greyhound Jay O'Mac, at the same time stewards enquired into the information supplied by the previous owner Mr.Shane McMahon on the Authority to Transfer form.

After taking evidence Mr. McMahon was subsequently charged with a breach of G.R.S.A. Rules Of Greyhound Racing R86 which reads:

R86 A person (including a official) shall be guilty of an offence if the person

(d) being the owner, trainer attendant or a person having official duties in relation to greyhound racing makes a false or misleading statement in relation to an investigation, examination, test or inquiry, or makes or causes to be made a falsification in a document in connection with greyhound racing or the registration of a greyhound.

Mr.McMahon pleaded not guilty to the charge but after being found guilty of the charge by the stewards was disqualified for a period of 9 months effective midnight Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> January 2009

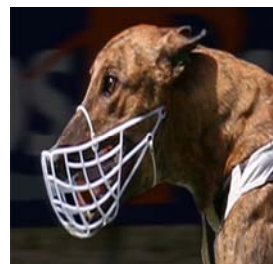
