OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT

DISTANCE RACE PRIZEMONEY INCREASES

Following discussion at the Grading Review Panel we are going to make some changes to prizemoney paid for distance races (731m only) at Angle Park. We will be increasing Monday & Thursday night prizemoney until the end of the racing year, with the extra stake money to be paid to the placegetters, not the winner.

The breakdown will be:

Mondays (Grade 5's or Mixed 4/5's)

Current Level: \$1,200 (already \$150 above 515m Grade 5)

New Level: \$1,300

Breakdown: \$830 - \$290 - \$150 - \$30

Thursdays (Open Grade)

Current Level: \$2,575

New Level: \$2,775

Breakdown: \$1770 - \$615 - \$320 - \$70

We will trial this to see if trainers are more encouraged to place their greyhounds in the distance races. It will take effect immediately.

MACRO MEATS JUVENILE FEATURE

Unfortunately last week the heats of the Macro Meats Juvenile were cancelled because of the heat. A decision was made to run the race as a (Best 8) Final only, with runners selected from the greyhounds that were due to run in last week's heats.

The reason for this decision was twofold; the first was that if the heats were run this week or at a later date, a number of greyhounds nominated would no longer be eligible. Secondly a number of the greyhounds were eligible to run in the Breeders 2009 Prelude Heats next Wednesday.

Tonight's Macro Meats Juvenile Final, carries total prizemoney of \$5,000, including \$2,000 from Macro Meats. There will also be a trophy to the winning connections.

BOX DRAW AUDIT

As part of our partnership with Greyhound Racing Victoria's Database an Audit of the Box Draw System has recently been completed. The Audit was arranged by GRV with an independent source and was shared with both Victoria, Tasmania and us to help offset the costs for each body.

The Audit showed no problems with the Box Draw system but did make some suggestions on the process. GRSA has considered these recommendations and implemented the necessary changes to ensure the continued integrity of the box draws.

BREEDERS 2009 PRELUDE (1)

A reminder to owners & trainers regarding nominations for Breeders 2009 Prelude (1). The heats will be run next Wednesday 11th February, with the Final on Thursday 19th February. Nominations will close tomorrow (Friday 6th February) at 9.00am with GRSA.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the Breeders Plate in May. Prizemoney will be finalised after nominations close, but as a guide, should we run four heats, the Prelude Final will be worth \$3,500. Based on the series totalling 19 races, the total prizemoney for Breeders 2009 is estimated at \$60,600, which includes \$16,370 in Futurity Payments.

ABANDONED MEETINGS

As most of you know we cancelled three meetings last week due to the extreme heat conditions.

We are investigating possible replacement dates for those meetings. We have been in touch with Sky Channel regarding this and are waiting for a reply from them as to whether they have any options for us. Another option we are looking at is to run extra races on some programs. We will advise on these once Sky have been able to assess the racing calendar.

TEAM BUNDY FEATURE AT GAWLER

The next feature event at Gawler will be the Team Bundy Grade 5 series. The \$800 heats will be run next Tuesday 10th February Grade 5 greyhounds at Gawler over 531m. The \$1,500 Team Bundy Feature Final will be run the following Tuesday 17th February.

ANGLE PARK KENNELHOUSE FLOOR

Trainers please note that the Kennelhouse will not be available for use at the trials this Saturday 7th February. This is due to maintenance work on the floor that will be undertaken on the Friday and during the weekend.

We will organise to open the roller door near the race day office to allow access for the morning.

ANGLE PARK SATURDAY TRIALS

Trainers should please note that there will be no Angle Park morning trials on Saturday 21st February. This will be due to an upgrading of the main track power board, which will have power out for much of Saturday.

There will also be some interruptions to the website and possibly on-line nominations as a result. We will be trying to minimise the length of the interruptions.

BREEDERS REGISTRATION

The GRSA Board has approved a recommendation from the Breeders Task Force to commence the Registration of Breeders. This is to begin from the licence renewal date of the 31st March and will include a \$25.00 fee.

The recommendation followed the National Responsible Breeding Task Force Recommendations and agreement by the members of the Task Force.

Anyone that has bred a litter in the past 3 years and currently holds a Public Trainer or Owner/Trainers Licence will be granted automatically a Breeders Licence on completion of application (a police report and kennel description is NOT required).

Any other person who has bred a litter within the 3 year time frame will be issued a licence at the discretion of the stewards. This is required to ensure that all litters are whelped in kennels that meet the current "Code of Practice".

New Applications or those that haven't bred for the previous 3 years will be required to meet a list of requirements and gain approval from the stewards. This criteria will be available shortly.

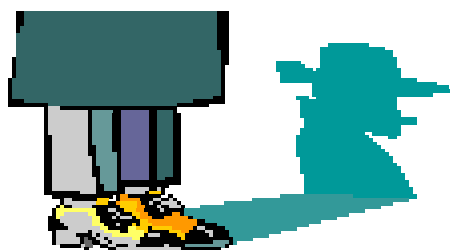
