OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT

ST PATRICK'S DAY MEETING

We can look forward to an excellent night of racing at Angle Park tonight with our St Patrick's Day race meeting. This has become a traditional night at Angle Park and highlighted by the SA St Leger Final and the Jardine Lloyd Thompson St Patrick's Day Sprint. Once again this week we have a twelve race program with racing commencing at 6.24pm and the final event at 10.15pm.

SA St Leger Final

It hasn't been an easy road through to the SA St Leger Final, with the quality of runners of a high order. A number of well fancied performers have missed out along the way, but we are left with a strong final tonight.

What is very interesting about the Final is that we have some fast early pace, but we also have a couple of smart late swoopers. Big Momma Choda and Manhattan Angel have both shown great early sections of late, While Moonlight Miss and Dot Com Diva also were in front in their semis. These runners have drawn from five and in, so it could get tight around the first turn. The two hard finishers are Cadman Bale and Savage Shaker and if there is early trouble, they could be set-up to finish over the top.

Manhattan Angel's great strength to date has been his great early pace and he is looking to make it nine wins in a row at Angle Park. Big Momma Choda has hit peak form in this series and has run mid 4.40's to the judge the first time in both the heat and semi. Victorian Dot Com Diva has been hard to fault in both her runs and has drawn pretty well in three.

Shaun Matcott has qualified two for the race in Deniro Bale and Burberry Bale, both have drawn wide.

Tonight's SA St Leger Final carries a total purse of \$12,000, along with a trophy and rug for the winner.

Jardine Lloyd Thompson St Patrick's Day Sprint

The other main highlight of racing tonight is the Jardine Lloyd Thompson St Patrick's Day Sprint. Cool Keepsake has always shown she has plenty of ability and has a great record. Now over the last couple of months she has really established herself amongst our open graders. She has great early speed she will be looking to jump quickly from box seven. Scull Murphy had no luck from box eight last week, but has a couple of greyhounds that like to get across early drawn inside him tonight and that could see him get a better early path. Romrod was a little unlucky to miss the St Leger Final (he is first reserve). Drawn nicely tonight in the cherry he is another that will look to hold a prominent spot early. There are a number of others racing very well in what should be a very good betting race.

The Jardine Lloyd Thompson St Patrick's Day Sprint is a \$6,000 event, which also carries a rug and trophy to the winner.

PERTH CUP AND GALAXY HEATS

Saturday night sees the running of the 2009 Perth Cup Heats and the Galaxy Heats at Cannington in WA. It looks a very strong meeting with eight heats of the Cup and four heats of the Galaxy, which is run over the 715m distance.

There is plenty of interstate flavour, which includes three runners from South Australia. Risk It, for Troy Murray will start in the Galaxy series, having drawn box one in the second heat (race 5). He warmed up in a trial on Monday night over 600m, when he ran 35.73 seconds. Also heading across is Rob Harnas with Red Demon, which has drawn box three in heat six (race 10) and Drink Driver, which has also drawn three, but in the last heat (race 12).

Recent Australian Cup winner, Velocette heads up the sprint cast, while the Super Stayers winner, Lilley Criminal heads the stayers list.

Sky Channel will be showing all races and the SA TAB will be betting on all races up to 11.30pm. This means local punters will be able to bet on all races except the last.

SUNDAY SKY THIS WEEKEND

We have another Sunday Twilight meeting from Port Pirie on Sky Channel coming up on the weekend. The meeting has drawn together a strong 10 event program, with racing commencing at 5.34pm and the last at 8.28pm.

Feature will be the \$950 Midway Tavern Summer Cup Final, as well as the Sportsman Tavern Maiden Final. There are also heats of the Silver Eagle Cool Champions series. There is one series over the 516m, which has two heats and the other over the 412m, which will have four heats.

If you can't get to the track, you can watch all races on Sky Channel and have a wager on the SA TAB.

GAWLER SATURDAY TWILIGHTS

We can now confirm two replacement dates at Gawler in May and June. The two meetings will be eight race Saturday twilight race meetings on May 30th and June 27th. Racing will commence at around 4.20pm and finish by 6.30pm.

Gawler Centrals Football Club has away games on both these dates, which means that the showgrounds are available for our use.

The meetings are in addition to the twelve race programs at Angle Park, which commence this week and will continue until the end of May.

Strathalbyn has agreed to move their non-TAB meeting on Sunday 28th June. This meeting will be held over and included in the 2009/2010 racing dates calendar, probably in July.

TWO COUNTRY CUPS COMING UP

We have heats of two Country Cups coming up at the end of this month. Both The Riverland Cup and the Mount Gambier Cup heats will be run on Saturday 28th March.

Mount Gambier

The Mount Gambier Cup heats will be run over 512m and to be eligible, greyhounds must have had at least two starts at Mount Gambier during the preceding 12 months. The Final will be held on Saturday 4th April and will carry prizemoney of \$3,000. The Club will also run consolations of the Cup and greyhounds will need to be renominated for these.

The Club will also run heats of a Maiden series (512m) on the 28th March. The Final will be worth \$1,000 and will also be run on Mount Gambier Cup Day. Also to feature on Final day will be the \$730 Barry's Door Services Super Sprint over the 277m. Should be a couple of great days of racing at the Mount. They have had strong nominations over recent months.

*** Nominations for the Heats on March 28th close with GRSA on Monday 23rd March at 9.00am. While nominations for the 4th April will close on Monday 30th March.**

Barmera

Heats of the Riverland Cup will feature at the first meeting for the Club after their summer break. The \$560 heats will also be run over the 512m distance. The Cup Final will be run over the Easter weekend on Saturday 11th April.

Prizemoney for the Final will be \$1,260, with the winner to receive \$1,000.

I know that the Club has had a busy “off season” and is looking forward to a bumper 2009. They are keen to kick it off in a big way, so mark both dates in the diary.

MACRO MEATS FEATURE

A reminder that the next lower grade feature race at Angle Park will be the Macro Meats Feature. This series will be a mixed 4/5 event for greyhounds over 600m with the \$1,850 heats run next Thursday 19th March. Ray Borda from Macro meats has added \$2,000 in sponsorship, which will be added to the Final of the series. This is the second of three events that Macro Meats are sponsoring.

The final will be run on Thursday the 26th March and with the additional sponsorship from Macro Meats will now be worth \$5,000 in total.

Coming from box 3 tonight she definitely looks the one to beat.

Laurie Cahalan puts the polish on Manhattan Angel and the home town advantage certainly can't be overlooked. He hasn't been beaten in his last 8 starts at headquarters and is another with a very impressive record of 11 wins and 3 placings from just 20 starts.

Troy Murray again has a runner in another feature event; Savage Shaker is bred in the purple, Bond/Miss Spicy, but unfortunately doesn't have the brilliant early pace of his mother. He has continued to improve and was an eye catching 2nd in last weeks semi's when rattling home behind Manhattan Angel.
