OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT

PERTH CUP AND GALAXY FINALS

It's not the top prize that our two greyhounds brought home from Perth, but it was great to see that both claimed placegetter cheques last Saturday night. Risk It was again a fast finishing second, this time behind Western Land in the Galaxy Final. He was near last in the early stages but powered home at the finish in the Group One Final.

Drink Driver ran third in the Perth Cup Final. He was a little unlucky, as after he boxed well he got tangled up with Trew Millions in vying for the lead. He did manage to balance up in third spot and held that position behind Miss Slick, which ran down Trew Millions. It proved to be a pretty successful trip for trainer Rob Harnas as Red Demon was also a winner at Saturday's meeting.

PREMIERS CUP NEXT WEEK

Next Thursday night's program at Angle Park sees the running of the 2009 Premiers Cup. This race has been added to the calendar in recent years, thanks to the support of the Premier. The race is for stayers over the 731 metres and carries total prizemoney of \$6,000, an increase on last year's event. With a couple of "new" distance race winners in recent weeks, hopefully it will provide a strong field, including Galaxy placegetter, Risk It. We are looking forward to a number of our State Members of Parliament being on track, including the Minister for Racing, Michael Wright.

EASTER TRIALING ARRANGEMENTS

Please note the following regarding trialing over Easter:

There will be no qualifying trials at Gawler on Wednesday 8th April, as the box draw for Tuesday 14th April will have already been completed. Normal trials will still be run.

There will be no morning trials at Gawler on Friday 10th April, due to the Good Friday holiday.

Normal Saturday morning trials at Angle Park will go ahead.

Strathalbyn will trial on Wednesday night 8th April, instead of the normal Friday trials on Good Friday.

NOMINATION CLOSING TIMES OVER EASTER

Trainers are reminded that with the Easter weekend coming up there will be some changes to nomination closing times. Please be aware of the following meetings with a changed closing day:

Strathalbyn – Sunday 12th April – Noms close **Tues 7th**.

Gawler – Tuesday 14th April – Noms close **Wed 8th**.

Angle Park – Wednesday 15th April – Noms close **Thur 9th**.

Angle Park – Thursday 16th April – Noms close **Thur 9th**.

Mount Gambier – Saturday 18th April – Noms close **Tues 14th**.

All nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am. Meetings not listed here will close on their normal days.

ANGLE PARK STARTING BOX GRILLES

Previously we have advised that the grilles on the Steriline starting boxes are to be increased in size. Steriline have advised that they are nearly ready to install the grilles on the boxes. It has been decided to add an additional grille above the current grille, rather than replace the entire front of the boxes. We have decided to install the grille on the 600m boxes at Angle Park first to allow for any comment on the new boxes. This will be done on Friday 3rd April. We will seek feedback on the installation before we then proceed to have each of the boxes adjusted at Angle Park and Gawler. The new grille will have a viewing height of just over 400mm, this compares to around 250mm currently.

NEW BREEDER REGISTRATIONS

We have begun introduction of Breeders Registration. The previously advertised fee of \$25.00 annually has been introduced and advertised. The handling of the applications has begun using the following procedure. Any person who has bred a litter within the last 3 years and currently holds a Public Trainer or Owner/Trainers licence will be granted automatically a "Breeders Licence" on application.

Any other person who has bred a litter within the 3 year time frame will be issued a licence at the discretion of stewards. This is required, to ensure that all litters are whelped in kennels that meet the current "Code of Practice".

Any other application will be treated as a "New Application". New applicants will be required to meet the following requirements, which are similar to anyone applying for a new trainers licence.

- 1 Application to be lodged on the prescribed form with the appropriate fee.
- 2 The application shall be accompanied with a current police clearance.
- 3 The application will be accompanied by three letters of reference, with two coming from industry participants

- 4 The applicant will undertake a Breeders Application Education package and Questionnaire
- 5 The applicant will undertake an interview before a selected panel of industry participants to ascertain the credentials and motives of the applicant. Breeders Task Force Members will assist with this process.

BREEDERS REGISTRATION FEES

A few people have asked what will the money raised from the new Breeders Registration Fee be used for. Well it has now been approved that fees raised from the new Breeders Registration be added to the Breeders & Classic Futurity annually, divided equally between the two series. This will commence with the two series' to be run in the 2009/2010 racing season.

MACRO MEATS FEATURE FINAL

We have a strong field for the Macro Meats Mixed Final at Angle Park tonight, following three strong heats last week. The heat winners were; Cadman Bale (35.39), Very Cool (35.42) and Aunty Vick (35.36); with very little between the winning times, the Final, looks like an even betting affair.

Adelaide Cup finalist, Very Cool has now had three starts over the 600m for two wins and has the best winning time of 35.14. With his strong sprinting form, may start the punters elect. Aunty Vick is yet to miss a place over this journey and will most likely be finishing strongly, while Cadman Bale made the step up in distance last week and will probably be the improver from the heats. There is good form amongst the other runners, with Fireside Jet, heading them.

The third of the Macro Meats Feature events comes up in April with a Grade Five (515m) series beginning with heats on Thursday 9th April. The \$5,000 Final on April 16th includes \$2,000 donated by Macro Meats. Nominations will close on Monday 6th April with GRSA at 9.00am.

RIVERLAND CUP HEATS

Racing for 2009 commences at Barmera this Saturday (28th March) and it includes the heats of the 2009 Riverland Cup. The Club was very pleased with its strong nominations and it has been decided to run a nine event program.

The highlight of the day's racing will be the running of three heats of the 2009 Riverland Cup. Racing commences at 1.00pm, with the final event at 4.20pm. The Club is looking forward to a strong year and Saturday will give them a great start.

The Riverland Cup Final will be run on Easter Saturday, 11th April.

MOUNT GAMBIER CUP HEATS

South Eastern racing at Mount Gambier will also be running their Cup Heats on Saturday (28th March). They have drawn together strong nominations and will run six heats of the South Aussie Hotel Mount Gambier Cup. Adelaide trainer, Paul Barry is taking a strong team to the meeting, including Token Ned and Rumford Reason.

The Club is also running four heats of The Produce Store Maiden on a bumper ten race program; this race has a \$1,000 Final on Cup day. Racing on Saturday commences at 12.45pm, with the last at 3.45pm.

The South Aussie Hotel Mount Gambier Cup Final will be run on Saturday week 4th April. It will carry a total purse of \$3,000.

BREEDERS 2009 PRELUDE (2) HEATS

A reminder to owners & trainers regarding nominations for Breeders 2009 Prelude (2). The heats will be run next Wednesday 1st April, with the Final on Thursday 9th April. Nominations will close tomorrow (Friday 27th March) at 9.00am with GRSA.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the Breeders Plate in May. Prizemoney will be finalised after nominations close, but as a guide, should we run four heats (as was the case for Prelude (1)), the Prelude Final will be worth \$3,500.

Based on the series totalling 19 races, the total prizemoney for Breeders 2009 is estimated at \$60,600, which includes \$16,370 in Futurity Payments.

ANGLE PARK – GAWLER DATES REVERT

Please note that the meetings listed for Monday 25th May and Tuesday 26th May will revert back to the normal schedule, ie Angle Park on Monday night and Gawler on Tuesday afternoon.

Originally Gawler was to race on the Monday night and Angle Park on Tuesday, but this will no longer be the case.

ANGLE PARK TRACK TURNOVER

We have booked the next track turnover for Angle Park for Friday 3rd April. This will be subject to the contractor's availability and the weather. Saturday morning trials will be cancelled on the 4th April as a result.

LAST MONDAY APK PENALTY FREE

As announced last week, next Monday night (30th March) will be the last APK meeting on a Monday night. As a bonus to trainers we have opened this meeting up and all races will be penalty free events. From the following Monday (6th April) the new grading for Angle Park meetings will commence, with the following grades

Angle Park Monday Night – will be APM. This grade will be considered a metropolitan grade for the purposes of the Order of Preference.

Angle Park Tuesday/ Wednesday – will be APD.

This grade will be considered a provincial grade for the purposes of the Order of Preference.

Angle Park Thursday Night will be APK. This grade will be considered a metropolitan grade for the purposes of the Order of Preference.

All greyhounds will retain their current APK grade as their APM grade when the new grading is initialised, eg Scull Murphy is a Grade 1 APK and will be a Grade 1 APM. The Graduation Guidelines have now changed to recognise APK, APM and APD as separate tracks; and downgrades are changed from three unplaced runs back to two unplaced runs

FINISH-ON LURE UPDATE

Trials:

All Saturday morning trials are now being run behind the finish-on lure. This will mean there will be no Specials or grab trials on Saturday mornings as all trials will be pulling up on the lure. At this stage the normal lure will remain on Tuesday nights.

We will be starting Finish-on Lure trials on Tuesday nights shortly. When they are introduced, we will continue to offer both finish-on trials and catching-pen trials. We will have more details on this shortly.
