## OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT

### WEST END DRAUGHT ANNIVERSARY CUP HEATS

Tonight we see the running of five heats of the 2009 West End Draught Anniversary Cup. A total of 37 greyhounds remained at box draw time, including nine from interstate, which has added extra depth to what should be excellent heats; plus a couple of newcomers to local trainers.

Coming from interstate will be greyhounds trained by Mark and Lisa Delbridge, Lisa Cockerell, Kody Charles and a well known name to us in Steven Collins. Mark trialled Flash Of Light (29.89) here last week as did Kody with Maffioso (30.48) and Daddy Rocks (30.50). Of the other runners, Finlandia for Lisa Cockerell is the only runner that has been a visitor to Angle Park previously. She was second in a heat of the 2008 Sky Channel Adelaide Cup behind Emerley Carlos, but missed a place in the semi-final.

The open grade ranks locally are looking pretty good at the moment, with Scull Murphy still "top of the tree", though he has drawn his least favoured box one in Heat four, and will clash

with Finlandia. That heat has drawn a number of greyhounds best known as strong finishers, with the likes of Oval Avenue, Uncle Remus and Cadman Bale.

Drink Driver looks the one to beat in the first heat, despite box eight, which he overcame to win last time. Gioves Thunder and White Noise, have sound form in Victoria, but this looks a step-up in class. Thoughtful Miss has her first start for Kim Johnstone in this heat.

Heat two looks a tough heat, with all of the seven runners appearing to have winning hopes. Very Cool and White Admiral are drawn the best, while Bone Breaker is an interesting runner. He is up in grade, but is an up and comer and one to watch. Look for improvement from Romrod, while Fitzzy Bale and Maffioso have sound interstate form.

Flash Of Light impressed with its trial last week and has won 10 of 16 starts, including a Wentworth Park win last start. She looks the measuring stick in Heat 3. Regatta Bale and Flame McBain are both drawn to be prominent, while Union Girl looks to make it four straight wins. Elegant Vintage is getting closer to a win and will be finishing on. The final heat also looks a tough one, with Manhattan Angel drawn a little awkwardly in four. Capable of a quick first section, he will look to jump to the early lead and he could well get a good run early despite the draw. Daddy Rocks, from WA is a last start Cannington winner, while Red Demon has shown good form of late. Bad Boy Latino has been an improver in this company of late and Motor City Cobra was a Sandown winner four starts back.

All in all it looks an intriguing series and we can look forward to a strong final next Thursday. With five heats, it means that the five winners will go through, with the fastest three seconds. The other two second placegetters will be declared as

reserves. The West End Draught Anniversary Cup Final is a Group Three Event and will carry a total pool of \$25,000, up \$3,500 on last year. The winners cheque will be \$17,500. The box draw for the Final will be conducted on track tonight, following race eight.

### **MACRO MEATS FINAL**

The other highlight of racing tonight is the \$5,000 Macro Meats Final. Last week we saw six excellent heats and the result tonight will be a strong final. Big Momma Choda looks the one to beat after drawing the red box once again. She has continued her great form since joining the Ken Gill kennel and looks to make it four wins on the trot at Angle Park. Her record at headquarters stands at 15 starts for 8 wins and 4 placings and she has shown good early pace to lead at her last three. There wasn't a lot between five of the heats, so the box draw will be an important part of the chances in the Final.

The other qualifiers were Avid Willow (30.26), which ran second to Double Edition and Nervous Waters (30.32), which was second to Awesome Dare.

### **GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH - MARCH**

The March SA Greyhound of the Month seemed to be a fairly simple one for the judging panel, with a unanimous win to Drink Driver. It came on the back of just two starts, both at Cannington in Perth. In those starts, he was a strong winner in his heat of the Perth Cup and was a gallant third in the Final behind Miss Slick. Those efforts were more than enough for the judges.

In the Group One Perth Cup Final he looked unlucky as he nearly headed them off going to

the first turn, but was checked. He did a great job to run the placing and showed that he was right up to the company. It was a fitting reward for the talented greyhound, which appears to be racing in the best form of an already strong career.

Trained at Lewiston by Rob Harnas, Drink Driver is by Collide out of Camden Shiraz. At the end of March his career record stood at 39 starts for 16 wins and 8 placings, with total earnings of just off \$57,000. He will start one of the favourites in the Anniversary Cup series starting tonight.

The win was also his second monthly win in a row, after his February win and he is certainly an early favourite for the GOTY title. Overall he has now won three monthly awards, as he also was GOTM in August 2008.

Last Thursday night saw the second Prelude Final for Breeders 2009. Manhattan Angel was again successful, following a win in Prelude (1). This now paves the way for the 2009 Breeders Plate series to be run at Angle Park, beginning this month and finishing in May. The race is open to all SA Bred greyhounds still eligible for Breeders 2009. Eligible greyhounds do not have to have competed in the Prelude series' to run in the Breeders Plate series.

Heats - Wednesday 29th April 2009  
Semi-Finals – Thursday 7th May 2009  
Final – Thursday 14th May 2009

**\*Nominations for the heats will close on Friday 24th April at 9.00am with GRSA.**

Prizemoney for each of the races will be finalised once the number of heats are known, but if four heats are run, the Final will be worth \$29,000. The SA Breeders Plate is a Group Three Event.

### APPEAL FOR HELP

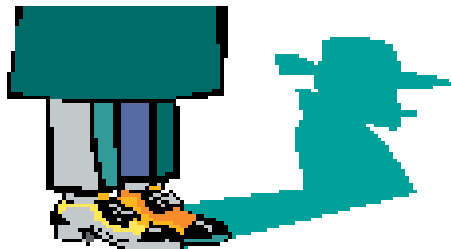
As the industry would be aware GAP is run on a volunteer basis, with all money raised being channeled back into the program.

### ANNIVERSARY CUP

Tonight we see five strong heats of this years West End Anniversary Cup over the 515m. Several Interstaters have made their way to Angle Park including ex-leading SA trainer of the year Steve Collins, who now resides in Victoria.

Race 3 kicks off the heats and we see the Perth Cup placegetter in Drink Driver well drawn out in box 8. Trainer Rob Harnas certainly has this fellow in fine form and on recent efforts shouldn't have any problems in making his way to next weeks final. An interesting runner is the Mark Delbridge contender, Gioves Thunder with recent wins at Horsham and Ballarat. The Bombastic Shiraz sprinter has drawn the red and is the one to watch in this event.

Second heat which is race 4 on the programme is a more open affair with several chances. Tony Fergusson has Very Cool in excellent form at present and this particular dog is very strong over the final stages. In my opinion he should prove the one to beat. Ex South Australian trainer Steve Collins has the Paul Wheeler owned Fitzzy Bale engaged and he definitely wouldn't be crossing the border for a sight seeing tour. The Collision/Sorrento Bale chaser has been placed in recent runs in the city and on country circuits as well.

Looks well placed to bother the locals here. Kody Charles has travelled the furthest of all participants crossing the Nullabor with his charges and he has Maffioso in box 8. This performer trialled here last week in a moderate time and would need to improve to have a chance of making the final.



Flash Of Light is the stand out runner of heat 3 and did trial the house down here last Thursday. With a tremendous strike rate of 10 win and 2 placings from just 16 starts. The Premier Fantasy/Trendy LaMaze sprinter carved out a slick 29.89 at her first look at the circuit and only bad luck would see her get beaten here. She won at Wentworth Park in 29.96 and will start very short in this event.

The battle of two very smart types takes place in heat 4, race 6. Local champ Scull Murphy has returned to form at the right time with 3 wins in his last 4 including two BON performances on the trot. Owner/trainer Bob Isaacson has him firing on all cylinders although he prefers to get off the track he should prove too classy from box 1. Finlandia is no slouch and has drawn out wide in box 8, she has been racing against some quality competition in Melbourne of late and is more than capable with a clear run.

The final heat, Race 7 and the youngster of the field in Manhattan Angel for Laurie Cahalan has the form on the board. He is only a January 2007 whelping and already has 13 wins to his credit from just 23 starts. Rob Harnas has the well travelled Red Demon engaged and can't be dismissed out in box 7.

All heat winners and the fastest seconds will make their way through to next weeks final. And the \$17,500 winner's prize money is definitely not to be sneezed at.
