## **RACING MANAGER'S REPORT** by Shaun Mathieson

### **NO KENNEL CAPERS NEXT WEEK**

Due to the Christmas New Year period, there will be no edition of Kennel Capers issued next week. The next edition will be published on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

### **GRSA CHRISTMAS – NEW YEAR HOURS**

The offices of GRSA will close at the normal time of 4.30pm tomorrow (Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> December). Remember there are two sets of fields to be drawn, Angle Park (APK) Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> December and Gawler (GAW) Friday 30<sup>th</sup> December. These fields will be released as soon as possible tomorrow.

Take note that the GRSA office will also be closed on the normal public holidays, ie Monday 26<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> December and Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> January. Apart from those days, the office will be open normal office hours.

### **XMAS SPRINT DRAWS TOGETHER A TOP FIELD**

We are only a couple of weeks away from the Group 3 SA Sprint Championships starting on January 12 with the final on January 19 however if the Final can be similar to tonight's Xmas Sprint then we can be in for some fantastic racing over the next month.

Tonights race see's the return to the track of Troy Murray's star chaser Kalden Mayhem who hasn't raced since finishing down the track at Wentworth Park over the 720m in late November where he suffered a slight injury.



He is back to the 515m tonight and with the benefit of the inside box he should be very hard to beat particularly if he recaptures his form that won him the Group 3 Gawler Gold Cup 4 starts ago. His kennel mate Kalden Aurora is also returning to racing after falling in the Gawler Cup when challenging for a placing in early November. She was in terrific form prior to her let up including a blistering 29.52 victory in the Adelaide Cup Consolation 4 starts ago and anything near her best will put her well and truly into this race.

Goosebumps for Matthew Payne whilst drawn awkwardly in the 5 box has been showing good pace out of the boxes and with her explosive finishing burst if she can land in the first 4 early she will be hard to hold out considering she did run a flying 29.79 last start and let's not forget Crazy Heart for Bruce Lellmann who has won back to back races over the 531m at Gawler and then the 600m at headquarters and remember was the only SA greyhound to qualify for the Group 1 Adelaide Cup back in October.

Throw in Point Two Over for Rob Harnas who represented SA in the National Sprint Final at Albion Park in August, both Emma's Gift and Where's Pancho who have won multiple races recently at Free For All level and the veteran Rawson Reason who has never raced better including comfortable heat and final victories in the recent veterans low grade feature and all 8 greyhounds have claims to win tonight's event.

They are all shooting for a portion of the \$7,000 on offer for the Xmas Sprint and it promises to be one of the great highlights on the track in 2011.

## **GAP PARADES AFTER RACE 4 ON XMAS SPRINT NIGHT**

The Greyhound Adoption Program will be having a Christmas Parade tonight which is always very popular with the oncourse patrons. There will be about 10 greyhounds all in the Christmas spirit parading between races 4 and 5 tonight.

## **MICROCHIPPING CHANGES IN VICTORIA**

Greyhound Racing Victoria have changed their position on Microchipping of greyhounds allowing for Interstate greyhounds to continue racing in Victoria after December 31 regardless whether or not they are microchipped. This change has GRV falling back into line with the National position agreed in 2009.

- All greyhounds whelped from 1 January 2011 are to be microchipped until they retire
- All existing stock will be allowed to race without a microchip until they retire
- From 1 January 2012 all racing greyhounds will be eligible to race if identified by a microchip and one ear brand or two ear brands for existing racing stock until they retire.

## **ELEVEN RACES FOR GAWLER ON FRIDAY**

Gawler tomorrow (Friday) will have a bumper meeting with 11 races programmed due to plenty of numbers. Yesterday at Angle Park also had 11 races to provide extra opportunities as there is no racing on Saturday or Sunday this week due to the Christmas weekend.



## **NEW 400M COVER FOR GAWLER START**

A new cover was installed for the Gawler 400m start on Tuesday providing protection from the sun and rain for our greyhounds and participants. The 388m start at Angle Park will also have a cover early in the new year.

## **ANGLE PARK 388M TRIALLING**

Trialling has begun for the new 388m start at Angle Park with bookings for trials very steady. Generally on Tuesday night at Angle Park the 388m trials will be run after the 515m trials. On Saturdays the staff will do their best to run trials in blocks so they are not continually going backwards and forwards from each start.

Everything is on track for an introduction of the 388m at the Angle Park (APD) meeting on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> January.

Nominations for this meeting close with GRSA at 9.00am on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> December.

## **TRAINERS CAR PARK GATES**

On occasions when arriving at Angle Park you may find the Trainers Car Park gates closed even though there is no race meeting on, this is because we are trying to direct deliveries for the upstairs restaurant through another gate. The new matting put down for the greyhounds to go up the ramp was slightly damaged recently buy a van so to protect this new matting we need deliveries to go to another access point. This would normally be in the early part of the day and may cause some inconvenience to our administration customers however this should only be for a short period until delivery drivers use the other access.

## **NO TRIALS ON TUESDAY 27<sup>th</sup> DECEMBER AT ANGLE PARK**

With the normal Gawler meeting on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> December moved to Tuesday night to accommodate Sky coverage we will have to cancel the normal Angle Park Tuesday night trials for this night. Nothing else should be affected by this change.

**FUTURITY FINAL FIGURES**

The payments for our SA Bred Futurities closed last Friday and we can detail the numbers of greyhounds still eligible.

**Breeders 2012 – Final Payment**

A total of 28 pups were paid for at the final stage. This is added to the 85 that have already been paid up fully, giving us a final total of 113 greyhounds that are eligible for the series that begins in February 2012.

**Classic 2012 – Second Payment**

There were 52 second payments and 12 final payments; this is added to the 63 greyhounds for which the final payment was paid at the previous stage. So we have 127 pups remaining, with 75 of those already having made the Final Payment.

**Breeders 2013 – First Payment**

We started with 48 litters and 315 pups eligible and a total of 175 pups have been paid up at the first payment stage.

**ANGLE PARK FEATURE RACES COMING UP**

The next low grade feature series will be a Grade 4 over the 515m with \$2,650 heats run on Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> December and the \$4,500 final on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> January. Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> December.

The Group 3 SA Sprint Championship will have heats to be on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> January and the Group 3 Final on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January. The race is restricted to SA Trained Greyhounds only “*To be eligible a greyhound must have been domiciled in SA for a period of not less than 90 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the time fixed for the finalising of nominations and drawing of fields*”

The heats will be worth \$3,400 and the final will be \$36,000.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> January.



The John Gray Memorial for Grade 5 greyhounds over the 515m will be run on SA Sprint Final night with heats on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> January and the final worth an outstanding \$9,000 run on Australia Day 26<sup>th</sup> January.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January.

### **KEN BRERETON MEMORIAL SERIES AT GAWLER**

The Ken Brereton Memorial series will be run in late January, early February and with the introduction of the 400m boxes has allowed for the Gawler Club to run an exciting series over a three distance format.

The conditions require greyhounds to compete over the 400m and then the same greyhounds compete over 531m. Trainers can then elect to withdraw from the 643m event on the Sunday however with the Ken Brereton overall winner needing to compete over all 3 distances and \$2,000 on offer for each race over 643m we are hopeful that all greyhounds progress to the final round.

Conditions as follows –

For Open greyhounds over all distances.

Maidens are ineligible.

Same greyhounds must run over the 400m and 531m (random races) however can be withdrawn for 643m prior to box draw.

When nominating must clearly state “Ken Brereton Series”.

Points will be awarded for each event over 400m, 531m and 643m - ie 8,7,6,5,4 etc.

The 643m race/races will be drawn on the current point's basis.

To be declared the winner of the Ken Brereton Series greyhounds must have competed over all 3 distances and will be decided on a point's basis.

There must be at least two races programmed in the first round (400m) and there must be sufficient numbers to run all races in the series.

### **DISTANCE FEATURE AT GAWLER IN FEBRUARY**

Greyhound Racing SA has added an extra feature to the Gawler calendar in February with the running of a \$4,000 Grade 3/4/5 over 643m on 14<sup>th</sup> February. This has been added to the program as a replacement for the Xmas Cup deleted from Tuesdays Gawler meeting.

### **MARCH 17 FOR GREYHOUND OF THE YEAR**

With the changes to the Adelaide Cup series and other feature races the Greyhound of the Year Gala Function has been moved from January to Saturday night March 17 next year to be held in Chasers Restaurant. It's shaping up to be another fantastic night where the great achievements in our Industry for 2011 are dually recognised.



There will be a couple of new awards including the Run of the Year where people will be able to vote on the GRSA website and Sprinting Greyhound of the Year added to the normal awards, all highlighted by the SA Greyhound of the Year. There will be more information to follow in the coming weeks

### THE HOT WEATHER IS ON ITS WAY

We all know how hot Adelaide can get during summer so with the help of the Industry Taskforce and recommendations from GRSA the Hot Weather policy (listed below) has been updated and GRSA will look to implement even more policy's to assist greyhounds and participants with extreme heat.

One of the main additions to the hot weather policy is -

*“Stewards will give consideration to allow Trainers travelling from a considerable distance to scratch greyhounds penalty free. Weather conditions experienced in the area in which they reside will be taken into account. If given permission all greyhounds from that Trainer will be withdrawn”*

Other actions that GRSA have in place –

- \*Review seven day forecasts for indication of extreme heat and potential venue change
- \*No distance races to be programmed in the hottest part of the day
- \*Starting box shelters have been ordered to be constructed over the 400m at Gawler and 388m at Angle Park
- \*New air-conditioning units and reflective paint added to the Gawler Kennel House
- \*Undercover parking to be utilised at Angle Park as required
- \*Synthetic matting has been purchased to be installed between the kennel house and empty out area at Angle Park (thanks to the support of the AGRC)

### HEAT POLICY

30Degrees+ **ALL COURSING MEETINGS** cancelled.

40Degrees+ **NON TAB MEETINGS-** Day and Twilight Meetings cancelled.

40Degrees+ **TAB MEETINGS and NIGHT MEETINGS-**At the discretion of the Stewards and Vet. Consideration will be given to change TAB day meetings to an earlier start or to a night meeting.

### SCRATCHINGS

Stewards will give consideration to allow Trainers travelling from a considerable distance to scratch greyhounds penalty free. Weather conditions experienced in the area in which they reside will be taken into account. If given permission all greyhounds from that Trainer will be withdrawn.

### MEETINGS TO BE CANCELLED

Greyhound Racing SA will announce any cancellation or reprogramming at scratching time. Radio TAB will be advised of any alterations.

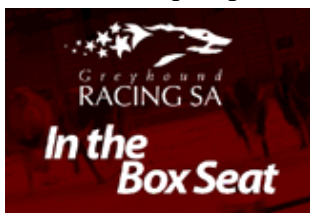
Race 8 tonight the Xmas Stocking Final at Albion Park will carry an extra bonus for punters, it will include a First 4 Jackpot of \$27,495.

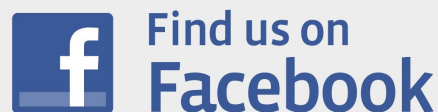
