OPERATION MANAGER'S REPORT

GAWLER PRODUCE STAKE HEATS

The Heats of the 2009 Gawler Produce Stake were conducted on Tuesday. At the close of nominations, 51 greyhounds remained from those that had made the required payments and there were seven heats conducted. From those heats, three semi-finals will be run next Tuesday (21st). The Final will be run on Sunday 26th July as a twilight meeting, covered by Sky Channel. This will be the second time that the Final will have been run as a Sunday twilight.

The Heat winners and their times were:

Heat 1 - Long Gully Jack (31.25)

Heat 2 - Crystal Scull (31.49)

Heat 3 - Sandhog (30.82)

Heat 4 - Emerley Houston (31.06)

Heat 5 - Gold (30.80)

Heat 6 - Where's Chucky (31.01)

Heat 7 - Bella Calabresa (31.52)

The Produce Stake is a series for greyhounds whelped in 2007 and is a "Futurity" event requiring payments which began in October last year. GRSA agreed to support the Club by taking over the administration of the payments for this series. A total of 172 greyhounds were paid up for originally, which was reduced to 100 at the final payment stage in April. This has resulted in a pool of \$14,285 from the futurity payments. GRSA adds to this pool, both from its normal prizemoney pool and an agreed budget with the Gawler Greyhound Racing Club each year, and the result is a record total pool of \$36,225. Prizemoney for the final was originally guaranteed at \$15,000 and this has been added to as a result of the increased pool. The prizemoney breakdown for the series is:
Tuesday 14th July 7 heats @ \$1,400

Tuesday 21st July 3 Semi-finals @ \$2,250

Sunday 26th July Final @ \$17,425 (incl. \$500 breeders bonus) & Consolation @ \$2,250

Trainers are reminded regarding the conditions for the Consolation: "Consolation runners will be determined by finishing positions in the Semi-Finals, then the Heats as per Heat and Final conditions. Any greyhound which competed in the Heats is eligible for the consolation". Greyhounds need to re-nominate for the Consolation.

Nominations for the consolation only close at 9.00am on Wednesday 22nd July.

The winner of the Final is also eligible for a \$5,000 bonus if it can win the 2009 Gawler Gold Cup in November. The first three placegetters from each Heat along with the fastest three fourths will qualify for the Semi-Finals. The box draw for the Final will be conducted at Gawler next Tuesday after the Semi-Finals.

The race was won last year by Uncle Remus trained by Raye Kelly. Raye actually had the double on the night as she also won the Consolation with Brer Fox. Scull Murphy won the race in 2007 and went on to win the SA Greyhound of the Year title. In 2006 it was Ten Tornados, which went on to represent SA in the National Sprint Championship and was a Finalist for the SA Greyhound of the Year. While the 2005 winner, Magic Lee, was also SA Greyhound of the Year for that year

GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH - JUNE

Ella Fair is June's Greyhound of the Month. In what looked like a month with a number of potential winners, the Judges were quite firm in their support of



Ella Fair, as she received 5 of the first preferences. Other greyhounds that came under close consideration were Crusade and Manhattan Angel who received 1 first preference each and also Uncle Remus.

During June, Ella Fair had 5 starts for 4 wins and a second placing. She was successful over three different distances, from 515m to 731m. Her best win was in the Steinborner Holden Winter Cup at Gawler, while her only defeat was a narrow one in the Inductomag Stayers Cup Final. She is establishing herself as one of our top stayers and will no doubt be one of our National hopes next month.

Handled by veteran trainer, Ken McAuley, Ella Fair is a daughter of Pure Octane out of Fiona Bale. At the end of the month her career record stood at 30 starts for 11 wins and 9 placings. She has already won prizemoney of \$14,830.

CLASSIC 2009 FINAL PRIZEMONEY POOL

Following last month's Final Payment, we can now confirm the final pool for the Classic 2009 Futurity Series. A total of 89 greyhounds have paid up to the Final Payment. This compares with 66 for Classic 2008, when the starting pool was 339 pups to 336 pups for Classic 2009. This means that the Final prizemoney pool will be:

GRSA Industry Prize -	\$30,000
Futurity Payments -	\$17,330
Breeders Registration Share -	\$1,125
Total -	\$48,555

Added to this will be the normal race prizemonies of approx. \$24,100 (Tuesday \$1,000 Wednesday \$700 or Thursday \$2000). This will be determined by the number of races run, but we are estimating a total of 23 races.

Final prizemoney levels will be determined for each series once nominations close. The estimates are that we will have the Preludes and Gawler Classic at \$1,400 for Heats and \$3,700 for the Finals; while the Brian Johnstone Memorial is estimated at \$1,500 Heats, \$3,800 Semis and \$29,500 Final.

The first of the Classic 2009 Preludes will be run on Wednesday September 2nd (Heats) and Thursday 10th September (Final).

OTHER FUTURITY NUMBERS

Both Breeders 2010 and Classic 2010 payments were also due last month and we can update these numbers. Between the Classic 2009 and Breeders 2010 estimates, we are expecting the total SA Bred Futurity pools for 09/10 to be around \$150,000. Added to the SA Bred Incentives and Maiden Bonuses, the total direct SA Bred returns should top \$340,000.

Breeders 2010

We started with a total of 464 pups for this series and after the December 08 First Payment, a total of 220 pups remained. Following last month's second sustaining payment, there are now 163 greyhounds that remain eligible. Interestingly, 84 have already paid the Final Payment, we are estimating as a result that the final number should be around 110, once the December payment is made. Based on these numbers we are predicting the final total pool to be close to \$80,000.



Classic 2010

The First Payments for Classic 2010 saw a total of 147 pups paid up for, from a starting pool of 253 pups (40 litters). The interesting trend though is that more owners are paying the Final Payment up front, rather than having to make two more payments. For Classic 2010, we already have 71 greyhounds for which the Final Payment has been made. Early estimates still have this series on track for a total of around \$70,000.

INCREASE TO MAIDEN BREEDERS BONUS

Breeders should note that we are going to increase the SA Bred Maiden Breeders Bonus to \$125. Last year we changed the bonus to \$100 for a win at any track in SA. Previous to that it had been \$50 for a country track and \$100 for an Angle Park or Gawler win. Based on the numbers from last year, we are now in a position to increase the payment to the breeder for an SA Bred greyhound's Maiden win. We will backdate it from the start of the month.

SKY CHANNEL PORT PIRIE SUNDAY

We have a Sunday twilight meeting at Port Pirie this week with Sky Channel/TAB coverage. Racing commences at 4.35pm, with the last of nine races scheduled to jump at 7.19pm.

ANGLE PARK TUESDAY MEETING

A reminder to owners and trainers that we will have an Angle Park afternoon meeting coming up on Tuesday 28th July. This is due to the Produce Stake meeting at Gawler on the Sunday prior. The meeting will be graded as an APD fixture, with prizemoney paid at the normal Gawler levels. It will include a 600m Free For All.

2009 SCHWEPPE'S NATIONAL NOMINATIONS

The SA heats of the Nationals are to be conducted on Thursday 13th August, with the \$6,250 State Finals on Thursday 20th August. The National Finals will both be run at Cannington in Perth on Saturday 5th September.

The most important date for local trainers to remember at this stage though is the national closing date for entries. Acceptances for the Schweppes National Championships will close with GRSA on Friday 31st July at noon. Nominations must be on the prescribed form and the conditions of nomination form must also be signed. The forms are now available.

VETERANS STAKES

After the discussion, it was agreed to continue programming them until our next meeting. However we would suggest that if we get no support, that we will look at ceasing the programming of these races.

We remind everyone of the current programming of the Veterans events. We are listing one each month on a Monday and one on a Thursday, effectively meaning there is a race nearly every fortnight. Currently both the Monday and Thursday races are listed as non-penalty events, with prizemoney of \$1,000 (Monday) and \$1,100 (Thursday).



The next on Thursday 30th July. Then in August it will be Monday 17th August and Thursday 27th August. It is up to everyone that has an eligible greyhound to support the events if you want them.

FROM THE STEWARDS

PAUL BURGESS APPEAL

On Monday 9 February 2009 stewards opened and completed an inquiry following an incident that occurred in the kennel house at Angle Park on Monday 26th January 2009 which involved the greyhound ATOMIC CLOCK trained by Mrs. S Gray and was being handled by Mr. Burgess resulting in a portion of the greyhound's tail being removed.

After taking evidence Mr. Burgess was subsequently charged with a breach of GRSA Rules Of Greyhound Racing R86 which reads:

R86 A person (including an official) shall be guilty of an offence if the person- (q) commits or omits to do any act or engages in conduct which is any way detrimental or prejudicial to the interest, welfare, image, control or promotion of greyhound racing.

Mr. Burgess pleaded guilty to the charge and as a result was disqualified by the stewards for a period of 10 years. Mr. Burgess lodged an appeal with the Racing Appeals Tribunal against the severity of the penalty. Greyhound Racing SA were advised on Friday 10 July 2009 that the Judges decision was as follows:

In the end, I consider that the period of the appellant's disqualification should be reduced to two years, and that the second of those years should be suspended on condition that the

appellant does not commit another animal welfare offence within a period of three years. To be more specific, the twelve month period of actual disqualification should continue until 9 February 2010, and the period of twelve month disqualification that has been suspended should be activated by the Stewards if they find that the appellant has committed within three years from 9 February 2009 another animal welfare offence in breach of the Rules. The formal orders are that the appeal be allowed, that a penalty be substituted in the terms that I have described, and that the bond be refunded to the appellant.

As a result of this decision stewards have received many queries in regards to the reduction in penalty. Should you have any comment please direct them in writing to the Chief Executive Officer Mr. Peter Ali.

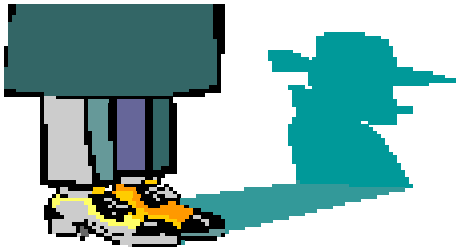

TOP PUPPY

Last weeks Metro Holden Champion Puppy final turned out to be a very open affair after several of the favourites missed the cut in semi finals a week earlier.

Ex South Australian trainer Steve Collins held all the aces with two handy runners in the final, litter mates by Primo Uno/Rosemary Bale, Joshua Allen and Chloe Allen are both owned by Paul Wheeler. Joshua Allen had won at both South Australian starts in 30.19 and 30.48 whereas Chloe Allen had improved in her last start in the semi and carved out a more than handy run in 30.25. Steve and wife Heather along with their family had a very successful training and rearing property at Murray Bridge in country SA and are quite accustomed to being on the dais at Angle Park as Steve was leading TAB trainer in SA for many years prior to his move interstate.

Chloe Allen began well from box 6 in the final and cruised past early leader in Cool In Blue to claim the final in the smart time of 30.22. Having pocketed the winners cheque of \$8475, taking the youngsters prize money to a tick over \$12000 in just 12 starts, she is sure to be back to take on more feature events. The early leader in Cool In Blue battled on well for a 2nd with race favourite and Steve's other runner Joshua Allen 3rd.

After the race I spoke with both Heather and daughter Tammy who travelled over on the day of the race. They said that both dogs had improved immensely with each look at the Angle Park track over the series but the biggest improvement seen in both performers was their box manners. Another kennel mate, Blitzem Bale that the Collins' brought with them would definitely have started favourite in the final. The Surf Lorian/Minkara Bale chaser had won at the Meadows in 30.36 prior to the Puppy series and did carve out a BOD 29.87 in the heats. He fronted up in a grade 5 event after missing the final and was overlooked by the bookmakers when opened up at the luxurious odds of 4/1, punters soon gathered as he was well supported and backed off the map and went on to win by over 4L in best of night 29.80.

Heather and Tammy said that if all goes well they will be returning for both the Oaks and Derby series with both these performers.

TO SALUTE

As mentioned last week Crusade has continued to be the most improved chaser in Adelaide. Again last Thursday night he led throughout to beat a quality field by over 5L. The Carnage/Queen Two sprinter continues to stamp his authority on these races and now has a career record of 15 wins and 7 placings from just 33 starts.

TRIAL PROCEDURES - DISCOUNTS

We have a procedure in place at Angle Park trials currently, where any SA Club members get a \$1.00 discount on trials. We are happy to continue this, however we have some concerns of some people getting through and not being current financial members of a Club. We will be tightening up on this as of next month.

You may suggest that this is just another revenue raising exercise for GRSA. Well that is not why we are becoming stricter. The reason is that because everytime someone gets away with a discount,

when not a member, it is the club members that are being disadvantaged. Those people that do the right thing and support our racing clubs are the people that have the right to receive the discount.

So from the 1st August, owners or trainers, wishing to get a discount at Angle Park trials, will need to be financial members of one of GRSA's Member Racing Clubs. They will need to show a Membership Card or other proof of their current membership. If not, then staff will be told not to offer the discount.

The comment has been made to staff that the "owner is a member", not the trainer. There will be no problems with the discount being paid in this case, as long as the owner's member's card is sighted.

This process is already in place at Gawler, where only Gawler Members receive this discount. This will be further re-enforced there also
