RACING MANAGER'S REPORT by Shaun Mathieson

CHAMPION PUPPY HEATS NOMINATIONS CLOSE TOMORROW

Owners & Trainers of up and coming youngsters should note that the Champion Puppy Nominations close tomorrow.

The Champion Puppy Series is for greyhounds whelped on or after 1st July 2009.

The Heats will be worth \$800 and will be run on this Wednesday 6th July, Semi-Finals are worth \$2,600 and will be run on Thursday 14th July and the Final on Thursday 21st July. Prizemoney for the 2011 Final will be \$14,000.

Remember unraced greyhounds are ineligible which means you have had a qualifying trial or race start to be eligible by nomination closing time.

*** Nominations close tomorrow (Friday 1st July) with GRSA at 9.00am.**

FRIDAY RACING STARTS THIS WEEK

The 1st of July is not only the start of the new financial year but also the start of Friday racing back at Gawler. As advised it would be GRSA's intention to run mainly 400m events on this day and we received good nominations with 9 of the 10 events over the short course. The first on the card however is a 531m event due to kick off at 12.26pm. The last will be at 3.16pm and reminding you there will be full on course SA TAB facilities, as well as Sky Racing coverage on Sky Racing 2.

We will be running every Friday in the new season and looking forward to some great racing strong support.

2011 GAWLER PRODUCE FINAL

Sunday sees the running of one of our major feature events for the year, with the Final of the 2011 Gawler Produce. We saw 2 Semi-Finals on Tuesday, with the winners being:

It looks like a two dog war on paper with both semi winners Hannah McLaren and Crazy Heart dominating the market with probably the Bruce Lellmann trained Crazy Heart starting favourite however there are plenty of chances in the field with all an eachway show. Traditionally the Produce Stake has produced a high quality race and deserving winner and this year is no exception. Good luck to all connections.

Sunday's 2011 Gawler Produce Stake Final, carries total prizemoney of \$20,000, with the winner to receive \$13,500 (inc. \$500 for the breeder). The winner of the Final is also eligible for a \$7,000 bonus if it can win the 2011 Gawler Gold Cup in November.



The Bonus was not won in 2010, so it has jackpotted by \$1,000 for 2011. If the winner of the Produce is SA Bred, there is also a \$1,000 SA Bred Bonus.

Angle Park Features Increased

There have been plenty of increases to the Feature Races which include Group 3 events needing to go to \$36,000 to retain Group status and the Adelaide Cup being worth over \$100,000, the winner receiving \$75,000. With the increases to the normal Thursday night prizemoney this also means that most of the Heats, Preludes and Semi Finals of Feature races have also been increased.

Gawler

There is an increase to the Gawler Sundays which will now race 25 meetings this season effectively every second Sunday. Last season Gawler took the Port Pirie meetings due to their temporary suspension however this has now become a regular fixture. Sundays at Gawler will be \$800 per race.

With the new Friday timeslot there will be 53 Fridays during 2011/2012 however we will not race on Good Friday so there will be 52 Fridays with each race being worth \$700 per race.



There will be 51 at Gawler and 1 at Angle Park due to the Gawler Show weekend. There will be \$364,000 paid out in stakemoney.

There will be no increase to normal Tuesday Gawler meetings and a couple of increases to Feature races. Details are:

There are no plans at present to run the Country Cup this year.

Country Prizemoney

Mount Gambier prizemoney has remained similar to last season however all races over each distance will now be \$600. Mount Gambier previously funded two races on their program which will now be paid for by GRSA.

Strathalbyn prizemoney has been reduced by \$26,000 to \$189,300 however this has been offset by the introduction of Travel Rebates to participants.

SA Bred Racing

SA Bred Bonuses will be increased by \$135,000 to a total of \$405,000. This figure includes the Maiden Breeders Bonus, which has been increased by \$50 to \$175.

The monthly pool will now be \$30,000 with the additional \$10,000 added to be paid out to the breeder in the same way the monthly owners bonus has been paid. This is for all Sky Racing covered meetings.

Travel Rebates

An additional \$91,520 is to be paid in travel rebates, giving a total of \$275,740 for 11/12.

The rate has remained the same however the Travel rebates are now extended to cover all TAB meetings at Angle Park, Gawler (including Gawler Fridays & Sundays) and now Strathalbyn meetings.

AGRA GROUP RACING CALENDAR

As mentioned last week the AGRA Group Racing Calendar should be available within the next week but there are a couple of criteria that GRSA need to meet to accommodate Group status. Most importantly is the eligibility criteria for Age Restricted Events. This will affect our Coffex Coffee SA Oaks and Coca Cola SA Derby's to be run in September. Under the National conditions these races will be restricted to greyhounds no older than 30 months of age on the first day of the month in which heats of the event are scheduled.

This will mean that it will be open to more greyhounds than in previous years. Also under the National conditions greyhounds that have not won a maiden race will be ineligible to contest the Oaks and Derby which is a change from previous years and now means that qualifying performances and Maiden dogs are ineligible.

The next is prizemoney levels.

Our Group finals need to be \$75,000 to the winner for Group 1 events, \$40,000 for Group 2 and \$25,000 for Group 3. This means that the Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final will be worth \$107,500 which is an increase from January. All of our other features are Group 3 events which means the total prizemoney for the final will be \$36,000 which is also increased from 2010/2011.

LOWER GRADE FEATURE CALENDAR

The first of the lower Grade Feature Heats for this season will be run next Thursday night (7th July), with Grade Five Heats for SA Bred greyhounds. The prizemoney for these events have been increased for the new season from \$4,000 to \$4,500.

Nominations are always strong for these features and provide a terrific final each month.

GAWLER TRIALS

With the introduction of the new Friday Sky Racing timeslot at Gawler during the day, trialling arrangements have had to be changed to accommodate extra racing at the venue. The Friday morning trials have had to be shifted to accommodate racing and will now be conducted on Monday mornings from July onwards. These trials will only be conducted on Mondays after a Gawler Sunday meeting as the track has already been prepared. If the Sunday meeting is conducted elsewhere then there will be no trials on Monday morning. These trials will be run between 7.30am and 9.30am and should hopefully provide that extra opportunity to trial.

Please be mindful however that there will be NO trials regardless on Monday Public Holidays. The first date should be Monday 4th July.

The normal Wednesday trials at Gawler will remain as per normal.

GRSA will review all racing and trialling at Gawler once the Friday meetings have been implemented.

NATIONALS COUNT DOWN CONTINUES

The AGRA Nationals Championships this year will be held at Albion Park in Queensland to be conducted on Thursday 25th August. The State series for SA will be held at Angle Park for the Sprint and Distance on Thursday 4th August for the Heats with the State Finals on the 11th August.

The nomination forms have been released and are available from the offices of GRSA and at Gawler and also on the GRSA website.

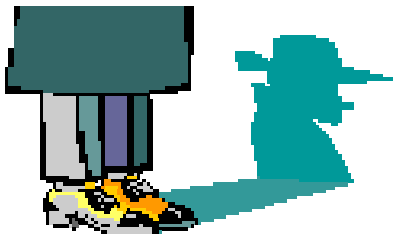
