## RACING MANAGER'S REPORT by Shaun Mathieson

### CHAMPION PUPPY FINAL

Tonight we have the Final of the 2011 Champion Puppy. We saw two strong semi-finals last week however the final tonight does look like one of the more open Champion Puppies in recent history.

The Des Hockley trained Rhythm And Soul was the fastest qualifier last week taking out semi-final 1 in a solid 30.15. The son of Hallucinate having just his third start for the Hockley kennel since coming from Victoria began well from box 5 to lead most of the way and record a good win over Jessenia Bale for Shaun Matcott. He improved his time significantly from his heat win of 30.92 in tough conditions last week to remain undefeated in SA. Shaun Matcott still would have been pleased with the run of Jessenia Bale, after beginning well from a wide box she drifted back to third but still ran home well to grab second spot. Drawn much closer in box 2 she should be able to find the rails quickly and give Shaun a great chance of claiming his second Champion Puppy final after Quinton Bale won in 2008. Prior to the heats last week the Troy Iwanyk trained Pure Instinct was one of the top picks for the series and started a short priced favourite however a poor beginning saw the Interstate visitor back to last early and in doubt of qualifying for the final however his supporters would have seen him run home very nicely to grab third spot behind Rhythm And Soul. Pure Instinct showed that he has the capabilities of taking out tonight's final however a clean beginning is crucial for the son of Bombastic Shiraz.

Semi-Final 2 was taken out by Victa Troy trained by Ron Schadow and with Victa Tina running fourth and Victa Pedro also running fourth in semi-final 1 this gave the Victor Harbor based trainer three runners in tonight's final. All from the same Where's Pedro x Teelah litter bred by the Schadow's it's a fantastic training effort.

Victa Troy does look the top pick for Ron after a comprehensive 30.32 victory claiming tearaway leader Shamira's Son in the shadows of the post. "Troy" has come through the rich Gawler Produce Series nicely and looks on target to keep improving with the Champion Puppy well within his grasp. Shamira's Son wasn't a bad effort last week in running second after claiming a spot from reserve and gave Matcott his second qualifier. He showed good speed from a middle box and for the only Maiden in the final it's a super training feat by Shaun. Third place was Podsiadly for the on fire Kim Johnstone kennel who ran yet another placing. He has been going terrifically well for Kim and with only a touch of luck in running he could be the surprise packet in tonight's final.

The Champion Puppy Final carries prizemoney of \$14,000, with the winner's cheque of \$9,450.

### 2011 MACRO MEATS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS - NOMS CLOSE MONDAY

The 2011 Macro Meats National Championships are only weeks away. The National Finals will be held at Albion Park on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> August. Both the National Sprint and National Distance Finals will carry prizemoney of \$75,000 to the winner.



The local SA State Heats will be conducted on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> August, with the \$7,000 State Finals on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> August.

The most important date for local trainers to remember is the national closing date for entries. **Acceptances for the Macro Meats National Championships will close with GRSA this Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July at 12 noon.** Nominations must be on the prescribed form and the conditions of nomination form must also be signed. The forms are available at GRSA.

A reminder to all trainers of the clause which requires a greyhound to have been domiciled in South Australia for a period of not less than 90 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the National Acceptance Closing date to be eligible to represent SA. If unsure of a greyhound's status, please contact the GRSA staff.

## GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH – JUNE 2011

Greyhound of the month for June was Led Zeppelin for trainer Petar Jovanovic. In a tight month of voting Led Zeppelin was able to get the nod from the judges after having a stunning month where he won three races from just four starts and established himself as a genuine open company performer.

Led Zeppelin was having his first start for the Jovanovic kennel in early June after being transferred from the Victorian kennels of Michelle Grima and made an immediate impression defeating a handy line up of grade 4's but it was his second to sprinting star Dark Duo by ½ a length at his next outing that stamped himself as a real sprinting contender. He led for most of the way until he was just run down in the shadows of the post but the son of Collide and Friendly Aviator lost no admirers and would make amends the following week .

He started one of the favourites in a hot line up including Dark Duo where he led throughout giving nothing else a chance stopping the clock in a blistering 29.83. Led Zeppelin won again in late June defeating a similar line up again breaking 30 seconds for the 515m journey and announced himself as a major player for our feature races in the coming months.

During June Led Zeppelin picked up just under \$6,000 in prizemoney taking his career statistics to date to 56 starts for 15 wins and 19 placings and earnings just under \$40,000.

## RUN OF THE MONTH – JUNE 2011

The Run of the Month for June was a tie for the first time with the Mike Giniotis trained Wandy Prince and the Don Foster trained Hannah McLaren gaining equal points from the panel.

The panel was impressed by the winning performance of Wandy Prince at Angle Park on the 2<sup>nd</sup> June where he flew out of the box 8 recording a sensational lead time of 4.37 in strong open grade company. He led throughout and held on for a strong victory in a slick time of 29.66 over the 515m defeating the odds on favourite Dark Duo in the process. The panel was similarly impressed by the winning performance of Hannah McLaren in a heat of the Gawler Produce at Gawler on June 21. She also led throughout from box 1 over the 531m journey defeating a handy line up by over 8 lengths and recorded a brilliant 30.48 for the trip.



## **CLASSIC 2011 PRELUDE (1)**

A reminder to owners & trainers regarding nominations for Classic 2011 Prelude (1) series. The heats will be run on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> August, with the Final on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> August. Nominations will close on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> August at 9.00am with GRSA.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the Brian Johnstone Memorial in November/December. Prizemoney will be finalised after nominations close, but as a guide, should we run three heats, the Final will be worth \$4,000. Based on the series totalling 19 races, the total prizemoney for Classic 2011 is estimated at \$76,000, which includes \$10,735 in Futurity Payments and \$1,600 in Breeders Registrations.

## **SISTER CITIES CUP IN EARLY SEPTEMBER**

The Sister Cities Cup will be run in September, with the Grand Final to be held in Christchurch NZ on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> September.

Once again, GRSA, Christchurch GRC, Brisbane GRC and Auckland GRC, will each supply two representatives in the Grand Final.

Adelaide and Christchurch are Sister Cities as are Auckland and Brisbane. The Adelaide/Christchurch experience has seen many trainers have an opportunity to travel.

The Grand Final will be run by the Christchurch Greyhound Racing Club over 520m. Prizemoney for this year's Grand Final will be \$NZ40,000.

South Australia will conduct its Heats (up to two) on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September.

If two heats are run, then the two winners will represent SA or if just one heat is run, then the first two placegetters will travel. We have had to run the heats three weeks before the final due to a change of the conditions on greyhounds leaving Australia that they have to have all of their veterinary requirements completed 15 days prior to leaving (this used to be 10 days). Getting back into Australia is much easier and quicker so the opportunity to still compete in the 40<sup>th</sup> Adelaide Cup on October 6<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> is still an option for those greyhounds.

The rotation of venues will be:

**2011 – Christchurch**  
**2012 – Adelaide**  
**2013 – Auckland**  
**2014 – Brisbane**

Each Club will pay an equal share towards the prizemoney component each year to assist the budgeting for the event.

Nominations for the SA heats will close on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> August. A special nomination form with the conditions of entry attached is required to be signed and lodged with GRSA. As greyhounds will be travelling to New Zealand, they will have to be cleared by AQIS and attendants will have to have a current passport. GRSA will cover the transport cost for each greyhound plus one handler.

The timing will affect the greyhounds set for the Oaks or Derby. However for open grade greyhounds, they will be able to compete in New Zealand and should still be back in plenty of time for the Adelaide Cup. If you have any questions, please contact me in the office or at the track.



## **SA TRAINED AND DOMICILED GREYHOUNDS**

In the new season we have a couple of series that carry conditions regarding "SA trained and domiciled" like the SA Sprint Championship and lead up SA Preludes to the Adelaide Cup, Oaks and Derby.

A South Australian greyhound trained and domiciled is defined as one domiciled in SA for a period of not less than 90 days out of the 150 days immediately prior to the close of nominations for the first night of SA Preludes or in the case of SA Sprint close of nominations for the heats.

This criteria is the same as the National Championships criteria.

## **WEDNESDAYS ON SKY 1 FOR SEPTEMBER**

In a boost for the SA Greyhound Racing Industry our Wednesday Day Angle Park meetings in September will be broadcast on Sky 1 providing more exposure of our product. We are hopeful that we can secure a spot in the following months on Sky 1 but this will be dependent upon Interstate programming of their races.

## **WATERLOO CUP – SEPTEMBER 24 & 25**

The GOTBA Coursing Club has advised that the Waterloo Cup will be run on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> September and Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> September. This has been shifted back a week to avoid a clash with the Gawler Sunday meeting.

## **ANGLE PARK FEATURE RACE CALENDAR RELEASED**

The Feature race calendar for Angle Park has now been released for the new season 2011/2012 with the big changes being the Adelaide Cup into October and the increased prizemoney for Group racing.

There has also been substantial prizemoney increases to heats and semi-finals for Thursday nights and also alterations to eligibilities especially for the Coffex Coffee Oaks and Coca Cola SA Derby.

## **AGRA GROUP RACING CALENDAR NOW RELEASED**

The AGRA Group Racing Calendar booklet is now available and can be picked up from Angle Park or Gawler. A reminder that there are a couple of criteria that GRSA need to meet to accommodate Group status. Most importantly is the eligibility criteria for Age Restricted Events.

This will affect our Coffex Coffee SA Oaks and Coca Cola SA Derby's to be run in September. Under the National conditions these races will be restricted to greyhounds no older than 30 months of age on the first day of the month in which heats of the event are scheduled. This will mean that it will be open to more greyhounds than in previous years. Also under the National conditions greyhounds that have not won a maiden race will be ineligible to contest the Oaks and Derby which is a change from previous years and now means that qualifying performances and Maiden dogs are ineligible.

The next is prizemoney levels. Our Group finals need to be \$75,000 to the winner for Group 1 events, \$40,000 for Group 2 and \$25,000 for Group 3. This means that the Group 1 Adelaide Cup Final will be worth \$107,500 which is an increase from January. All of our other features are Group 3 events which means the total prizemoney for the final will be \$36,000 which is also increased from 2010/2011.



## **GAWLER TRIALS**

With the introduction of the new Friday Sky Racing timeslot at Gawler during the day, trialling arrangements have had to be changed to accommodate extra racing at the venue. The Friday morning trials have been shifted to accommodate racing and are now be conducted on Monday mornings. These trials will only be conducted on Mondays after a Gawler Sunday meeting as the track has already been prepared. If the Sunday meeting is conducted elsewhere then there will be no trials on Monday morning. These trials will be run between 7.30am and 9.30am and should hopefully provide that extra opportunity to trial.

Please be mindful however that there will be NO trials regardless on Monday Public Holidays. The next Monday trials will be held on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> July.

The normal Wednesday trials at Gawler will remain as per normal.

GRSA will continue to review all racing and trialling at Gawler for the future.

## **FINANCE MANAGER'S REPORT** by Brian Trumble

### **TRAVEL REBATES**

Travel Rebates of \$20 for Trainers of up to four dogs at a meeting and \$40 for Trainers of five or more dogs at a meeting held at Angle Park, Gawler or Strathalbyn are currently paid in cash at the meeting. This cash payment involves significant manual cash handling by GRSA staff and the carrying and distributing of money by Stewards, neither of which is an efficient use of those resources and adds risks to the operations of GRSA.

From 1 August 2011 Travel Rebates will no longer be paid in cash. The Travel Rebate for any meeting eligible for the payment of the Travel Rebate will be paid by Electronic Funds Transfer at the time of the weekly prizemoney payments.

### **ACCOUNTING SUPPORT FOR COUNTRY CLUBS**

GRSA is in an ongoing review of the administrative structure and their functions undertaken. GRSA has provided accounting support to some member clubs that have undertaken racing at their track. With the ongoing change that is being experienced the efficiency and efficacy of GRSA administration undertaking these functions has been reviewed.

There is an inherent conflict with GRSA as the Greyhound Racing Authority also being responsible for the accounts of Greyhound Clubs.



Clubs have a legal and fiduciary responsibility for the accounts and governance of their organisations. GRSA's involvement in the preparation of accounts for clubs is an impediment to clubs fulfilling their statutory obligations.

GRSA will still provide support to clubs that are conducting race meetings by providing a grant to clubs to engage external bookkeeping services that GRSA administration has previously provided.

As a result of these changes, the position of Industry Accountant is surplus to GRSA requirements and as a consequence Mr Laurence Plush has been made redundant. We thank Laurence for his service to GRSA and member clubs for the past 6½ years.
