RACING MANAGER'S REPORT by Shaun Mathieson

2011 MACRO MEATS NATIONALS HEATS

Tonight will see the running of the SA State Heats of the Macro Meats Nationals. We have two Sprint heats and a one off Distance heat on tonight's program. Eighteen greyhounds remained at box draw time for the Sprint and eight for the Distance.

In the Sprint heats there looks to be plenty of chances to gain the SA spot, with Rob Harnas dominating the acceptors with two runners in each heat. His star chaser Dark Duo looks hard to beat in heat one but will be strongly challenged by his kennel mate Point Two Over and Black Wolf for Troy Murray. In heat two Rob's main chance will be Random Test after the son of Collision drew the red however Aston Elite for Troy Murray and Sargent Trigga for Lesley Sermon are both in career best form. With two heats, it will mean the first four from each heat will qualify for the final with the fifth placegetters being declared reserves.

With only eight final acceptors for the Distance heat then all greyhounds tonight will progress through to next week's final and that will be a bonus for oncourse and off course spectators as tonight's race is full of quality. Bob Isaacson's star chaser will no doubt start as the punters elect tonight however the challengers will come thick and fast with proven stayers Kalden Mayhem for Troy Murray and Forty Twenty for Lesley Sermon looking hard to beat along with in form up and coming stayers Wot Price Pete for Mike Giniotis and Samantha McLaren for Don Foster.

Next week's SA State Finals will both carry prizemoney of \$7,000. The winners share will be \$4,760, plus there is a travel support payment. The box draws for the finals will take place on track tonight. The Sprint Final after race eight and the Distance Final after race nine.

The Macro Meats National Finals will both be run at Albion Park in Queensland on Thursday 25th August. Each of the Group 1 Finals has a winner's cheque of \$75,000.

GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH – JULY 2011

Greyhound of the month for July was Hannah McLaren for trainer Don Foster.



July's award for Hannah McLaren made her the first greyhound in 2011 to take out multiple Greyhound of the Month awards after she was awarded the winner in May.

Her month was highlighted by a scintillating performance in winning the rich Gawler Produce Final in early July. After being undefeated through the heat and semi final some thought that maybe box 5 in the final may bring the daughter of Bit Chilli and Nimuay Lass undone as she started an easing favourite however all doubts were cast aside shortly after the start when she pounced on the lead. She ran blistering times when out in front winning the feature final by 8½ lengths and stopping the clock at 30.34 only .11 outside Regional Image's track record set in July of 2003.

The Foster's then headed to Angle Park with "Hannah" and easily won a Grade 6 event in a sizzling 29.72 however disappointed at her next start surprisingly finishing out of the placings in late July as an odds on favourite.

In July Hannah McLaren only had the three starts for two wins with stakemoney of \$14,360 bringing her career to 20 starts for 12 wins and 3 placings and over \$47,000 in stakemoney.

CLASSIC 2011 PRELUDE (1) NOMINATIONS CLOSE TOMORROW

A reminder to owners & trainers regarding nominations for Classic 2011 Prelude (1) series. The heats will be run on Wednesday 10th August, with the Final on Thursday 18th August. Nominations will close tomorrow (Friday 5th August) at 9.00am with GRSA.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the Brian Johnstone Memorial in November/December.

Prizemoney will be finalised after nominations close, but as a guide, should we run three heats, the Final will be worth \$4,000.

GAWLER FEATURE DATES RELEASED

We have now finalised the feature races for Gawler for the new 2011/2012 season. With the help of the Club there have been some nice increases of prizemoney and a rescheduling of feature dates.

Highlighted on the calendar is the Group 3 Gawler Cup with heats on Sunday 30th October and the \$38,500 final on Sunday 6th November.

The Ken Brereton Super Challenge has moved into January/February and will be run over 3 distances (400m, 531m & 643m) with the winner declared on a points basis. There will be a Gawler Member bonus during the series.

The Pet's Tucker Queens Cup has also moved and will be run as a heat and final series on 21st February and 28th February.

We have attached a copy to this week's kennel capers and the full listing will also be available on the GRSA website.

ADELAIDE CUP CONDITIONS RELEASED

The 40th Adelaide Cup conditions have been released clarifying eligibility, criteria and automatic qualifiers for the Group 1 series which will be run on Thursday 6th and 13th October with lead up SA Preludes on the 22nd and 29th September.



A copy is available on the website and the nomination forms with conditions will be released shortly.

ANGLE PARK TRACK TURNOVER

There will be a track turnover at Angle Park on Friday 12th August. This means that there will be no Saturday morning trials on the 13th August. As always the turnover will be dependent on suitable weather conditions.

GAWLER SHOW DATES

August means that it is coming up to Gawler Show time, so this means a couple of weeks racing at Gawler being transferred to Angle Park. The Annual Gawler Show will be held on the weekend of Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th August. Racing on Tuesday 23rd August, Friday 26th August and Tuesday 30th August will be at Angle Park. These will be Angle Park Provincial (APD) fixtures with normal Tuesday and Friday prizemoney.

Trials will be cancelled at Gawler on Wednesday 24th August. We will hopefully have the track ready to trial again on Wednesday 31st August, but this will be dependent on the weather over the show weekend. There will be no Qualifying Trials at Gawler on Wednesday 17th August, as the following Tuesday is at Angle Park.

There will be trials as per normal at Angle Park on Tuesday 23rd August and Saturday 27th August even though we have raced at the track for 5 consecutive days.

COFFEX COFFEE OAKS & COCA COLA DERBY

Owners and trainers are reminded that the Oaks & Derby at Angle Park are fast approaching. There is a change to the eligibility and conditions of both these series so trainers must be mindful when preparing your greyhounds.

The whelping date of both the Oaks and Derby has been opened up to now allow greyhounds whelped 30 months prior to the heats to be eligible so for both series your greyhound will have to be whelped on or after 1st March 2009. Another requirement is that Maidens are ineligible so you have to have won a race to be eligible.

We have also changed the conditions for both series now being a two week series with Open Heats and a Final however we have provided an opportunity two weeks prior to each series for locally trained and domiciled greyhounds to gain automatic entry into the heats. The SA Preludes of both the Oaks and Derby will be run on Wednesdays with a maximum of 8 Preludes with the first 3 from each prelude gaining automatic entry into the heats.

If your greyhound does not compete in the preludes or doesn't run in the first three then this does not preclude your greyhound from the series and all you need to do is nominate for the heats as per normal for your greyhound to be considered.

A reminder about the increase to stakemoney for both the Oaks and Derby with the Finals increased to \$36,000 from \$32,000 to accommodate the AGRA Group 3 criteria and also due to the increased stakemoney on Thursday nights the heats will be \$2,600 which is an increase of \$400 from last year's semi finals.

SISTER CITIES CUP IN EARLY SEPTEMBER

The Sister Cities Cup will be run
September, with the Grand Final to be held
in Christchurch NZ on Thursday 22nd
September.

Once again, GRSA, Christchurch GRC,
Brisbane GRC and Auckland GRC, will each
supply two representatives in the Grand
Final.

Adelaide and Christchurch are Sister Cities
as are Auckland and Brisbane. The
Adelaide/Christchurch experience has seen
many trainers have an opportunity to travel.

The Grand Final will be run by the
Christchurch Greyhound Racing Club over
520m. Prizemoney for this year's Grand
Final will be \$NZ40,000.

South Australia will conduct its Heats (up
to two) on Thursday 1st September. If two
heats are run, then the two winners will
represent SA or if just one heat is run, then
the first two placegetters will travel.

We have had to run the heats three
weeks before the final due to a change of
the conditions on greyhounds leaving
Australia that they have to have all of
their veterinary requirements completed
15 days prior to leaving (this used to be
10 days). Getting back into Australia is
much easier and quicker so the
opportunity to still compete in the 40th
Adelaide Cup on October 6th and 13th is
still an option for those greyhounds.

The rotation of venues will be:

2011 – Christchurch
2012 – Adelaide
2013 – Auckland
2014 – Brisbane

Each Club will pay an equal share
towards the prizemoney component each
year to assist the budgeting for the event.

Nominations for the SA heats will close
on Monday 29th August. A special
nomination form with the conditions of
entry attached is required to be signed
and lodged with GRSA. As greyhounds
will be travelling to New Zealand, they
will have to be cleared by AQIS and
attendants will have to have a current
passport. GRSA will cover the transport
cost for each greyhound plus one
handler.

The timing will affect the greyhounds set
for the Oaks or Derby. However for open
grade greyhounds, they will be able to
compete in New Zealand and should still
be back in plenty of time for the Adelaide
Cup. If you have any questions, please

The initial move back one week was to accommodate staffing issues however the clash with the Strathalbyn Cup Final on the 25th September was unsatisfactory for both Club Features and opportunities for participants. I apologise for any confusion this has caused and look forward to a successful Waterloo Cup on September 17th & 18th.

In a boost for the SA Greyhound Racing Industry our Wednesday Day Angle Park meetings in September will be broadcast on Sky 1 providing more exposure of our product. We are hopeful that we can secure a spot in the following months on Sky 1 but this will be dependent upon Interstate programming of their races.

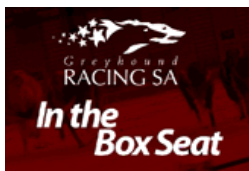

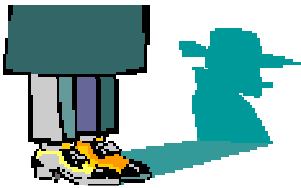

STEWARDS' NEWS

THANKYOU MAL

Greyhound Racing SA recently through retirement lost one of its valued and popular Stewards Malcolm John Westley (Mal).

Mal was a member of the Stewards Department for over twenty five years and in that time has gained the respect of all other Stewards, Staff, Clubs and Industry participants.

He was able to provide assistance to GRSA wherever needed.

We wish Mal and his family all the best for the future.

On a personal level I would like to thank Mal for his support to me as Chairman of Stewards after I was appointed at a young age.

BREACH OF RULE

Following recent queries in regard to persons associating with a disqualified person we wish to make all licenced persons aware of the following Rule. Rule 86 A person (including an official) shall be guilty of an offence if the person - (ah) being a registered person or person associated with greyhound racing, associates with a disqualified person for the purpose of greyhound racing.

Therefore any licenced person having greyhounds examined or treated by a disqualified person would be in breach of the rule.

GREYHOUNDS AUSTRALASIA THUMPS STUDY

Dr. Steve Karamatic will be visiting South Australia to observe >450 individual greyhounds up to 10 minutes post race.

This will involve watching races from the catching pen and then greyhounds returning to the wash bays and recording visual observations. It may involve filming some greyhounds post race. Furthermore he may be allowed to view those greyhounds who are kennelled too quickly with a torch through the cage doors for evidence of 'thumps' (excluding greyhounds to be swabbed) and this may be necessary if he does not get to view most dogs greater than 6 minutes.

He will be attending the following meetings - Strathalbyn Sunday 28 August, Angle Park Monday 29, Tuesday 30, Wednesday 31, Thursday 1 and Gawler Friday 2 September.

RESULT of APPEAL

Mr. Petar Jovanovic

Stewards completed an inquiry on 9 May 2011 into the circumstances relating to the obtaining of the positive urine sample from the greyhound CASCADA STAR at the Greyhound Racing SA meeting held at Angle Park on Thursday 3rd February 2011.

Mr. Petar Jovanovic was charged with a breach of the GRSA Rules Of Greyhound Racing R83

Mr. Jovanovic pleaded not guilty to the charge, Stewards found Mr. Jovanovic guilty of the charge and he was disqualified for a period of 4 months effective from Midnight Monday 16th May 2011.

Stewards acting under rule R83(4) disqualified CASCADA STAR from Race 5 conducted at the meeting held at Angle Park on 3rd February 2011 and amended the placings accordingly.

On Tuesday 19th July 2011 the Racing Appeals Tribunal heard an appeal lodged by Mr. Jovanovic against the Stewards decision.

On Thursday 28th July GRSA Stewards were advised that the Tribunals decision was that the Stewards penalty imposed remain unchanged.

This penalty commences from midnight Monday 1st August 2011.

HENDRA VIRUS

The Australian Animal Health Laboratory (AAHL) confirmed that a dog has been exposed to Hendra Virus. The property was already under quarantine due to 3 horses on the property being affected by Hendra Virus.

It is thought that the dog was exposed to the virus through contact with a sick horse on the property.

This is the first time a species other than fruit bats, horses or humans has been known to have become exposed to Hendra Virus outside of a laboratory situation.

The dog has not shown any signs of illness and no live virus has been detected from the dog. Further samples will be collected from the dog and forwarded to AAHL for testing.

While this isolated case should not give rise to any immediate concern for greyhound stakeholders, as a precautionary measure we advise all owners and trainers to keep their greyhounds away from sick horses. More information will be provided when it becomes available.
