### NO KENNEL CAPERS NEXT WEEK

Due to the Christmas New Year period, there will be no edition of Kennel Capers issued next week.

The next edition will be published on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> January 2010.

On behalf of all staff at GRSA, we take the opportunity to wish all greyhound followers a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

### GRSA CHRISTMAS - NEW YEAR HOURS

Take note that the GRSA office will be closed on the normal public holidays, ie Monday 28<sup>th</sup> December and Friday 1<sup>st</sup> January. Apart from those days, the office will be open normal office hours.

As we are racing tonight (Christmas Eve), we will close at normal times.

### WEST END DRAUGHT DISTANCE CHAMPIONSHIP

The West End Summer Chasing carnival will kick-off next Thursday night (31<sup>st</sup> December) with the running of the heats of the West End Draught Distance Championship. The Group Three event carries total Final prizemoney of \$27,000, with the winners cheque being \$18,800. The nominations close today (Thursday), with fields also drawn today.

The meeting also features the New Year Sprint, which is an important lead-up event for the Sky Racing Adelaide Cup.

Carrying prizemoney of \$3,750, the winner of the event gains automatic

entry to the TOP 16 and the Interstate Challenge, if nominated for the Adelaide Cup. Again that field will be drawn today.

All in all New Years Eve is shaping up to be a very big night of racing at Angle Park. A reminder that racing will start at the normal time. The box draw for the Final will take place next week on course after the heats have been conducted.

### SKY RACING ADELAIDE CUP NOMINATIONS

Nominations for the 2010 Sky Racing Adelaide Cup will close next Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> December with GRSA at 9.00am.

Following the close of nominations, the Adelaide Cup Selection Panel will meet to determine the TOP 16 and from them the invitations to the Advertiser Interstate Challenge. These will be announced following the running of the New Year Sprint that night. This is because the final make-up of the TOP 16 does include the Sprint winner.

Trainers will then have until Monday 4<sup>th</sup> January at 9.00am if they wish to scratch from the Cup.

This year the members of the Selection Panel will be the Grader, Greg Barber (Chairman), Operations Manager, Racing Officer, Shaun Mathieson, Craig Cook from the Advertiser and Vaun Gray of the RPH Hot Dogs for Breakfast show.

### SILVER CHIEF SUCCESS FOR SOUTH AUSSIES

Great to see the runs of the Richard Pearce trained pair of Where's Pancho and Where's Cisco in the Macro Meats Silver Chief Heats at The Meadows last Saturday.

Where's Pancho was successful in Heat 4, running the 525 metres in a competitive



time of 30.09. Where's Cisco ran second behind Iso Octane in Heat 7.

There will be four Semi-Finals run on Saturday night, with the first two going through to the \$50,000 to the winner Final on January 2<sup>nd</sup>. Where's Pancho has drawn box 8 in Race 4 on the program at 7.50pm SA time. He is drawn against the well performed Dyna Lachlan in that Semi. Where's Cisco has drawn box 3 in race six at 8.38pm SA time; he has drawn against Dyna Forte and Silent Guardian.

Both greyhounds are SA Bred and paid up for Breeders 2010.

### **TRACTOR SUPPORT**

Unfortunately the Angle Park tractor suffered a breakdown a couple of weeks ago and needed major repairs. The result has been that parts have had to come from Japan, meaning that it would be unavailable for some time.

In recent times we have had the old Strathalbyn tractor as a standby unit at Angle Park and we have been using that for preparation. Then late last week we had some problems with that unit also.

I have had some people suggest to me that we should have just hired another tractor; however it isn't that simple. The replacements we were offered have standard tractor tyres, not the 'turf tyres' that we have on the Kubota. Normal tyres mark the track too much.

So on Friday we approached Strathalbyn to borrow the new unit that they have to help Angle Park in the short term, particularly considering the number of meetings being run this week. GRSA would like to thank Trevor Moule and his committee for the support shown in allowing us to borrow it.

The good news is that the parts have arrived and all things going to plan both tractors should be back in their rightful homes for Christmas!

### **SUNDAY'S ELECTRICAL PROBLEM**

Sunday's Christmas meeting at Gawler was abandoned after race 7 due to an electrical failure at the course. The problem was identified as one of the 'phases' having dropped out and was an ETSA supply problem. ETSA advised that getting a crew out to fix the issue would have taken at least an hour, which would have been after 9.00pm, so it was decided to abandon the remaining races.

ETSA staff attended the track on Monday morning to replace the faulty equipment. Prizemoney for the abandoned races will be shared amongst the runners as per the GRSA Rules of Racing.

### **GAWLER 400M BOXES**

Those that have been to Gawler over the last couple of weeks may have noted that work on the new 400 starting point has been progressing. Some of the new fencing has been erected as well as the concrete slab and earthworks. This week the Steriline boxes have been transported from Angle Park and were installed by Steriline technicians and our electrician. Work still to be finished includes the removal of gates and fencing and the erection of the remaining new fencing, which will stretch around to the 326m boxes. We haven't set a start date yet, but we hope to be trialling next month. Racing should follow shortly after.

**2010 ADVERTISER INTERSTATE CHALLENGE CONDITIONS**

A copy of the Advertiser Interstate Challenge Conditions was published in last week's Kennel Capers. The main points to note are that the invitations will come from the TOP 16 of the Adelaide Cup Nominations; to be considered a South Australian, a greyhound must have been trained in SA for 90 days out of the previous 180 days as of January 7<sup>th</sup> 2010. The winner on the New Year Sprint on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> December gains automatic entry into the TOP 16 and the Interstate Challenge.

**FUTURITY FINAL FIGURES**

The payments for our SA Bred Futurities closed last Friday and we can detail the numbers of greyhounds still eligible.

**Breeders 2010 - Final Payment**



A total of 25 pups were paid for at the final stage. This is added to the 84 that have already been paid up fully, giving us a final total of 109 greyhounds that are eligible for the series that begins in February.

We are estimating a total of 28 races during the Breeders 2010, with prizemoney of just over \$80,000 and the Breeders Plate worth \$30,000.

#### **Classic 2010 - Second Payment**

There were 36 second payments and 17 final payments; this is added to the 71 greyhounds for which the final payment was paid at the previous stage. So we have 124 pups remaining, with 88 of those already having made the Final Payment. That series is on track to match figures for Classic 2009.

#### **Breeders 2011 - First Payment**

We started with 63 litters and 431 pups eligible and a total of 262 pups have been paid up at the first payment. This is a record at this stage; 199 made the first payment and 63 elected to make the final payment. Early estimates point towards a series worth \$85,000 plus.

#### **2010 GAWLER PRODUCE STAKE - SECOND PAYMENT**

A note to those people that have pups still eligible for the 2010 Gawler Produce Stake that the Second Sustaining Payment is due on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2010. After the first payment there are 142 greyhounds eligible and we are estimating a final pool of around \$35,000. The Final is guaranteed at \$17,000 minimum.

The second payment of \$49.50 (or \$44 if five or more are registered in the same name) is due on the 15<sup>th</sup>; except for those that elected to make the 'one-off' payment originally.

The Final is listed for Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> July, depending on Sky racing confirmation.

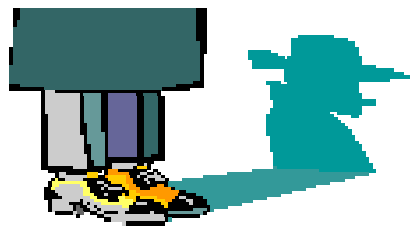
