KEN BRERETON MEMORIAL SERIES STARTS ON FRIDAY

The first heats of the Ken Brereton Memorial series will be run on Friday with two heats worth \$1,000 graded over the 400m. Whilst there were only 14 final acceptors each heat has plenty of chances and there should be some exciting racing over the three distances in the next week.

Heat 1 on Friday features the Troy Murray trained Aston Thomas who should be nearing peak fitness after two unplaced runs back from a two month let up. He did run second in the Group 3 Gawler Cup back in November to his kennel mate Kalden Mayhem so he loves the Gawler circuit. Leica Drill for the Hurley's has found some terrific form in recent times with three consecutive wins and then a placing last start on Monday night at Angle Park over the 731m. She will be much better suited over the 531m and 643m later in the series. Don't forget the likes of Black Satanic, Senni Josh and Tigre Bale all with good form to their name and will improve as the series steps up in distance.

Heat 2 see's Shaun Matcott's handy chaser Jessinia Bale returning to the track after two months off however she has drawn perfectly out of the red box and over the 400m could prove too nippy for her rivals first up. Bandanna Lad continues to race in career best form for the Murray camp and produced another super effort to run second in last week's SA Sprint Championship Final. He looks one of the best hopes for the overall series as he is so consistent and rarely runs a bad race. Throw in the likes of Airbag, Macalea Bale and Only Jess and this is another exciting and even heat.

The next round will be run next Tuesday with the same greyhounds competing over the 531m with two heats worth \$1,500 each. The same greyhounds will be in the same heats however the box draw will be done randomly.

Once both 400m and 531m heats have been run then next Wednesday the final race/races in the series will be drawn over 643m worth \$2,000. The 643m will be drawn on the current point's basis. Trainers have the option to withdraw their greyhounds prior to box draw however a greyhound cannot be declared the overall winner of the Ken Brereton unless it competes in over all three distances.

PERTH CUP AND GALAXY HAVE SA FLAVOUR

At Cannington on Saturday night the Group racing attention will focus on the Heats of the \$140,000 to the winner Group 1 Sky Racing Perth Cup and Heats of the \$80,000 to the winner Group 1 Sky Racing Galaxy. There are eight outstanding heats of the Perth Cup with local speedster Kalden Aurora for Troy Murray engaged in Heat 4 (Race 4) and will do battle with group racing heavyweight Heston Bale from the powerful Daily camp. The Cup is run over the 530m and the series also includes stars Dyna Tron, Glen Gallon, Oaks Road and Mystic Apple.

The Murray kennel will also have two chargers in the Heats of the Galaxy to be run over the 715m journey. There are four terrific Heats with SA star Kalden Mayhem engaged in Heat 1 (Race 6) taking on Echelon from Victoria and Kalden Petroni in Heat 2 (Race 7) challenged by WA superstar Miata.

It should be a great nights racing in the West on Saturday night.

MAYHEM NOMINATED FOR THE ROOKIE REBEL AND ZOOM TOP

The first round of invitations have been released for the Macro Meats Temlee, Rookie Rebel and Zoom Top to be run at the Meadows on Saturday 18th February.

South Australia's top chaser Kalden Mayhem is one of 21 greyhounds invited to nominate for the Group 2 Rookie Rebel over 600m and was also one of 19 greyhounds invited to nominate for the Group 2 Zoom Top over 725m. Stack 'Em Flat was also invited to the Rookie Rebel owned in SA by Bruce Lellmann and it's great to see some SA flavour in these feature nominations. 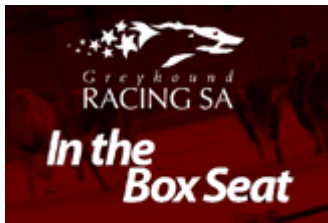

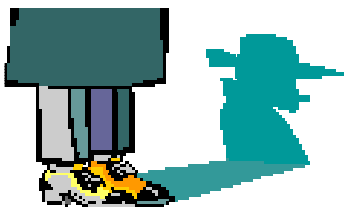

On 22nd December 2011 Stewards informed Mrs. Elizabeth Chegia by hand delivered letter that the greyhound MAN OF HONOUR had shown the presence of BOLDENONE from the urine sample taken at the Greyhound Racing SA meeting held at Gawler on Sunday 11th December 2011, and that she would be advised of the date, time and place of an inquiry.

Notification was received from Mrs. Chegia requesting that the Reserve and Control Sample from MAN OF HONOUR be sent to Australian Forensic Laboratory for testing.

The reserve portion of the urine sample was tested by Australian Forensic Laboratory and the presence of BOLDENONE was confirmed.

Mrs. Chegia was advised of the analysts results on 23rd January 2012 by hand delivered mail and is required to attend an inquiry at the offices of Greyhound Racing South Australia Limited, 55 Cardigan Street, Angle Park on Wednesday 8th February 2012 at 10.00am, together with any witnesses that may assist for an inquiry by the Stewards into the circumstances relating to the obtaining of the positive urine sample.
