BREEDERS 2012 PRELUDE (1)

Yesterday (Wednesday) saw the start of the Breeders 2012 Futurity, with the heats of Prelude (1). We had a total of 23 nominations for the first series, so 3 heats were contested, with the winners being:

Prizemoney for the heats was \$1,750, which included \$200 to the breeder for each heat winner.

The Breeders 2012 Prelude (1) Final will be run next Thursday night 9th February at Angle Park. Total prizemoney for the Final will be \$4,600, which includes \$500 for the breeder of the winner. The breakdown is first: \$3,280 (inc.breed), second: \$820, third: \$410, fourth: \$90.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the SA Breeders Plate run in May.

PORT AUGUSTA NEXT MEETING SATURDAY 11TH FEBRUARY

Next week, Saturday 11th February sees another twilight meeting at Port Augusta with the running of the RadioTAB 447m Free For All with the first race at 5.30 pm.

Nominations close with GRSA at 9.00am on Tuesday, 7th February.

TRACK RECORD AT MOUNT GAMBIER

Yet another track record fell last week with the Mount Gambier 400m record lowered by the Ralph Patzel trained Nashira on Sunday who won in a time of 23.20 bettering the previous record of 23.23 held by Cryer's Tiger.

MAYHEM & PETRONI MAKE GROUP 1 GALAXY FINAL IN WA

All eyes will be on Cannington on Saturday night with the running of the Group 1 Perth Cup over 530m and Group 1 Galaxy over 715m with South Australia having two runners engaged in the Galaxy. The Troy Murray kennel mates Kalden Mayhem and Kalden Petroni both went super last week to qualify for the \$80,000 to the winner final. Kalden Mayhem was at his brilliant best in his heat leading most of the way to win by 11 lengths in a slick 41.75 and has to be one of the favourites after drawing perfectly in box 3. Kalden Petroni ran a gutsy second behind superstar Miata in her heat after she initially led. She was beaten by 12 lengths and would need plenty of luck for her to figure in the finish. Miata ran a sensational 41.58 and will start favourite on Saturday night and could be in line to run yet another track record.

The other big feature is the \$140,000 to the winner Perth Cup where all 8 heat winners qualified for Saturday night's final.

The final features the best in the land including Heston Bale from Victoria, Oaks Road from NSW and Glen Gallon from Queensland with luck to play a big part early in Saturday night's event. There should be some fantastic racing and good luck to the South Aussie's.

AGRA's Neil Brown has previewed the big races on Saturday night which we have included towards the back of this week's Kennel Capers.

NEW OZCHASE COMPUTER SYSTEM

The OzChase computer system is a Racing System developed by Western Australia and New South Wales and will be the new computer system that GRSA will be using in the coming months moving way from the current linked GRV system.

Other States utilising this computer system will be Tasmania and the Northern Territory who have also moved away from GRV. Queensland is considering their options in regard to remaining by themselves or joining a joint venture.

There are two parts to getting the OzChase system up and running in the next few months. The first is providing WA with our data from the linked GRV racing system. Which we are currently doing which allows WA to start populating the OzChase system with South Australian details. We are also extracting the NT and Tasmania data on their behalf.

The second part of OzChase is the development of the system by WA. Our staff at GRSA have been assisting WA in regard to grading, racing, results, breeding etc programs so that they have the basic principles of our requirements.



This is going quite well and I am very positive about the service that we will receive from WA going forward.

Time lines –Data from the GRV system for the three States and populated in the OzChase system.

Phase 1 – current

Phase 2 – February 2012

(SA, NT, and Tasmania go live – February/March 2012 depending on historical data uptake)

Phase 3 – completion – April 2012

(NSW full go live – April/May 2012)

(RWWA go live – May/June 2012)

Phase 4 – State specific modifications – June 2012

I would ask our participants to be patient in regard to the transition from GRV to WA over the next few months and the potential problems that may occur during this process. Our racing administration staff will continue to do their best to provide the best service possible to our participants and industry.

BREEDERS REBATE GOING STRONG

Since the Breeders Rebate was introduced for greyhounds whelped from 1st November 2011 we have had 40 applications for the rebate which have been approved. We have had two applications for the rebate for their new/lapsed licence to assist with their facilities which has been approved.

We have had to refuse two applications for the Rebate who did not meet the necessary criteria. Please be mindful that you are a licensed breeder and that you have lodged your Breeders Rebate application prior to your bitch being served.

GAWLER PRODUCE 2012

The Gawler Produce series for 2012 is looking like being another excellent series. When the first payment closed back in October there were 145 greyhounds nominated with 73 of those making the one off payment. This compared to 108 for the 2011 series and 142 for the 2010 series. The second sustaining payment closed in January with 48 making this payment. The final payment will be required on Friday 13th April 2012 for those who haven't already paid up for the whole series.

The heats are listed to be on Tuesday 19th June with the semi finals scheduled for Tuesday 26th June. The Final is listed for Sunday 1st July and is guaranteed at \$20,000.

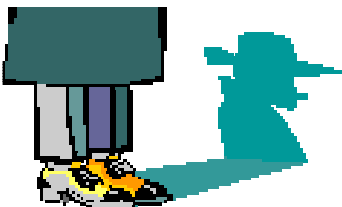
