OPERATIONS MANAGER'S REPORT

SA ST LEGER SEMI-FINALS

Angle Park tonight sees 4 Semi-Finals of the 2010 SA St Leger. We saw 9 heats run last Wednesday and we can look forward to some close racing tonight. Saint Nyasaland (30.02) was the fastest heat winner for Alan Randall; he is already a winner of 17 races and will be looking to show the same early pace he showed in the heat. The Richard Pearce trained pair of Where's Cisco (30.11) and Where's Pancho (30.17) were also quick heat winners and the pair are still improving with more racing. Bubba's Octane went 30.15 to win his heat in a "personal best"; the Lisa Rasmussen trained greyhound has built up a strong record of 6 wins and 2 seconds from 8 starts.

The first 2 in each Semi-Final will qualify for the Final, with the two fastest thirds declared as the reserves. The \$14,000 SA St Leger Final will be run next Thursday 11th March. The box draw for the Final will be conducted on track this evening, following race 9.

SA PATRICK'S DAY SPRINT MEETING NOMINATIONS CLOSE EARLY

Next Thursday night's race meeting will also include the St Patrick's Day Sprint on a top program of racing. The prizemoney for the Sprint has been increased to \$7,000 and the race is a Best Eight of the 515m.

Owners and trainers are reminded that nominations will close on Friday 5th March (tomorrow) at 9.00am. The early closing is due to the Adelaide Cup Holiday on Monday.

MOUNT GAMBIER CUP HEATS

The Mount Gambier Club has drawn together 5 heats of the South Aussie Hotel Mt Gambier Cup this Saturday. They also have 3 heats of the Produce Store Maiden. The 10 event program commences at 12.45pm.

The \$3,000 Cup Final will be run next Saturday 13th March. Also on Final day will be the \$1,000 Maiden Final, \$1,000 Gangalla Park Greyhound Rearing & Trackside Meats Distance Feature (732m) and the \$730 Barry's Door Services Super Sprint (277m).

NATHAN LAUNCHES

Former South Australian, Heather Collins picked up her first Group win at Sandown last Thursday through the unbeaten Arsonist. Having only her fourth start, she won the Launching Pad a Group 2 event. She is owned in South Australia by Nathan Rooney and remains unbeaten in those four starts. She defeated Silver Chief winner Enry Walt in 29.88. Arsonist is by Elite State out of Flickering Lady, making her an SA Bred half sister to Jean Jeannie (Surf Lorian). Both bitches were bred by Jim Johnston.

LOCALS INTERSTATE

Satanic Cash ran 5th in the Macro Meats Super Stayers Final at The Meadows on Saturday night. He got a long way back in the run and was working home nicely behind Drill 'Em, but he never looked a winning chance.

He will head to Perth on Saturday for the heats of the Galaxy, which is run over 715m. He will again clash with Next Top Model and Dashing Corsair in his heat and will box from eight. The other two heats include Mantra Lad, Drill 'Em and Forty Twenty in a very strong series. The Galaxy is a Group 1 event.

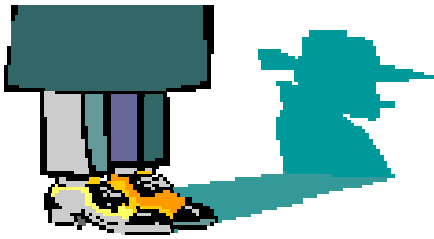

ST LEGER SEMI'S

At the headquarters tonight we will see four semi's of the SA St Leger series run.

Semi 1 - and it's hard to go past Saint Nyasaland. The Alan Randall owned and trained youngster carved out a best of day 30.02 win here last Wednesday and has the credentials to lead throughout and win the first semi in good fashion. Loxodrome for Shaun Matcott is nicely drawn down in box 1 and should be the likely improver. Sizzler for Petar Jovanovic put in his best run since crossing the border when he was a nice 2nd behind Where's Cisco. The Surf Lorian/By Request chaser will be running on but will need an ounce of luck early in the run.

Semi 2 - Aston Rachael has struggled in her past two starts. Owned by the prominent greyhound owner Ray Borda the Where's Pedro sprinter is by far the fastest greyhound in the race. If she can reproduce her best she looks far too smart for the others in this field. Richard Pearce trained Where's Cisco has kept on improving with every run and carved out a 30.11 run last week. He looks to be the main danger with Lara Allen and Stone Step Hill for trifecta punters.

Semi 3 - and its hard to go past Girl Hardy here. She has been racing mixed 2/3/4 races since transferring to the Don Foster kennel.

By Black Enforcer/Sidemoney she has 12 wins and 10 placings from just 30 starts next to her name. Bubba's Octane has drawn perfectly down in box 1 and has now won 3 of past 4 at Angle Park. Add in South Central along with Razamataz Shiraz and we shouldn't miss.

Final Semi 4 - and we see a very smart youngster in Where's Pancho. This dog has 6 wins and 2 placings from 10 starts and has broken the 30 sec barrier in his short career. He also has a win at the Meadows in the low 30's. By Where's Pedro/Excuse Me he will start a short priced favourite in race 8. Emerley Belle and Dyna Kalia for the minors in this event.

RAY FEWINGS REMEMBERS.....

Considering the best greyhounds are normally where the biggest money is, South Australia has produced three major influences on the Australian Breed. "Token Prince", bred by Don and Helen Foster, but sold to Queensland at an



early age, has been outstanding. His stock has put real strength into the breed and a number of Token Prince's sons are fighting to take his place.

The Riverland's pride and joy "Ginger", raced by Sam Condo was one of Australia's best ever Sires. A great race dog who left South Australia too soon, Ginger left hundreds of quality greyhounds including Eaglehawk Star, a Group 1 winner who made it at stud. One rarely given credit because most of his winners raced in Sydney was "Casino Tom". A brindle dog with an abundance of early pace, Casino Tom dominated in Adelaide before the McAvaney family sent him to Sydney. Casino Tom developed into one of the Harbor City's best sprinters.

Put to stud, Casino Tom left plenty of winners on tracks throughout NSW. South Australia has had a number of champions over the years but the money earned by progeny bred down from these sires would amount to tens of millions.
