## OPERATIONS MANAGER'S REPORT

### SA ST LEGER FINAL

We have an excellent meeting tonight to celebrate St Patrick's Day, with two feature races on the program. The St Leger Final sees a strong field, following last weeks 4 Semi-Finals. A special mention must go to trainers Richard Pearce and Shaun Matcott, who have both qualified multiple runners for the Final. Richard has the combination of Where's Cisco and Where's Pancho; the pair have been in top form, with Cisco maybe marginally more impressive in this series. Where's Cisco was the fastest winner in the Semis, running 29.94, his best time to date, while Pancho wasn't far behind at 30.02. Shaun won two Semis with Miss Manakie (30.29) and Loxodrome (30.32), while Allen Yannic ran a strong second behind Where's Pancho. Loxodrome did well to hold out the well performed Saint Nyasaland.

Saint Nyasaland has the best record in the race, with 17 wins and 13 placings from his 42 starts. The Alan Randall trained greyhound has already won over \$22,000 in prizemoney. Aston Rachael qualified behind Wheres' Cisco last week and she won't have lost too many admirers. She has a best time of 29.63 around Angle Park, so we know she can run a big race tonight. The other qualifier is Girl Hardy for Don Foster; she ran second to Miss Manakie and was only narrowly beaten. She has been quite impressive since joining the Foster kennel and is well capable of running a big race. Overall it is an open race, so punters should be able to find some value.

The prizemoney for the Final has been increased by \$2,000 on 2009 and totals \$14,000 in 2010. The race also includes a trophy and rug for the winner, which will be presented on track after the race.

### ST PATRICK'S DAY SPRINT

The other highlight of racing tonight will be the St Patrick's Day Sprint. The Sprint has also had its prizemoney increased from 2009; an extra \$1,000 has been added, to bring the total stake to \$7,000; plus there is a trophy and rug for the winner.

Like the St Leger, we have a strong field on paper, with all of the eight having the form to come into contention. Perhaps the most interesting runner is Tomic, which has now moved to the SA kennels of part-owner Damien Smith. We have seen him zip around Angle Park in 29.72 and he will be having his first start since his heat of the Sky Racing Adelaide Cup. Tomic is eligible for the Breeders 2010 series.

Again this should be a very interesting betting affair for punters.

### MOUNT GAMBIER CUP FINAL

Good luck to Mount Gambier on the weekend, with the running of the 2010 South Aussie Hotel Mt Gambier Cup Final. The club ran 3 heats last week and has a good field for the Final. Drone will be looking to make it two Mt Gambier Cups in a row, after he won the 2009 version, where he defeated Deep Prince. We have a summary of the heats later in Kennel Capers. The \$3,000 Cup Final will be run as race 7 at 2.45pm. Also on the day are the \$1,000 The Produce Store Maiden Final, \$1,000 Gangalla Park Greyhound Rearing & Trackside Meats Distance Feature (732m) and the \$730 Barry's Door Services Super Sprint (277m). Racing kicks off at 12.45pm, with the last of 10 races to jump at 3.45pm.



## TRACK TURNOVER

Trainers please be advised that there will be a track turnover at Angle Park on Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> March weather permitting. As a result there will be no trials on Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> March.

## PERTH CUP SATURDAY NIGHT

Unfortunately our locals didn't fair too well on Saturday night, with none going through to Saturday's big finals. Satanic Cash finished third in his heat of the Galaxy and would have been the first reserve, but Bob Isaacson has elected not to travel back next week and he wasn't drawn in. Once again he gave them a big start and was working home.

Sunny Boy Love ran well to finish second to Regent Diamond in his heat after chasing the winner most of the way. Ken Gill will take him back for the Cup Consolation on Saturday, a race which carries prizemoney of \$33,750. Strictly Mambo for Jan Jones jumped slowly in the same heat and was never really a chance.

The \$210,000 Perth Cup Final sees High Earner likely to start a warm favourite. He won his heat by 7 lengths, running a smart 29.93; the only greyhound to break 30 seconds on the night. With the likes of Dyna Lachlan and Prankster run out in the heats, High Earner gets his best chance to take out a big one in recent months. Leading local trainer, Linda Britton qualified 3 for the Final; Regent Diamond, How I Roll and Wassim Bale.

The \$120,000 Galaxy over the 715m also saw a number of the favoured runners miss out. Apart from Satanic Cash, Mantra Lad and Forty Twenty all miss the Final. The heat winners were, Next Top Model, Drill 'Em and Jarvis Bale.

Tattsbet will be operating a Fixed Odds service on both races. The Galaxy is timed to jump at 10.57pm SA time, while the Perth Cup will jump at 11.42pm SA time.

## BREEDERS 2010 PRELUDE (2) HEATS

Prelude (2) of Breeders 2010 will be run on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> March at Angle Park. The series is for all greyhounds eligible for Breeders 2010. The Final will be run on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> April. Prizemoney will be determined after nominations close, but with 4 heats for Prelude (1), the heats carried \$1,500 and the Final \$4,000.

\* Nominations close next Friday 19<sup>th</sup> March with GRSA at 9.00am.

## ANGLE PARK FEATURE HEATS

A reminder to trainers that next Thursday night (18<sup>th</sup> March) there are heats of a Mixed 4/5 Feature of the 600m trip. The heats carry prizemoney of \$2,250. The Final on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> March will now be worth \$4,000 (up from \$3,500).

Also next Thursday there is a Bitches FFA programmed over the 515m distance. This carries normal open grade prizemoney of \$3,000.

Nominations for next week close on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March, with GRSA at 9.00am.

## GAWLER SOUTH BAKERY HEATS

Next Tuesday (16<sup>th</sup> March) at Gawler we see the heats of the Gawler South Bakery Cup. The race is sponsored by the popular Adelaide Road Bakery and is a FFA over the 531m journey. The heats are worth \$1,400 and the Final (run on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup>) has been increased to \$2,000.

\*Nominations will close today (Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> March) with GRSA at 9.00am.



While mentioning features at Gawler, this series will be followed by the Anniversary Cup at Gawler. The heats will be run on March 30<sup>th</sup> and the \$4,000 Final on the 6<sup>th</sup> April.

## ST LEGER FINAL NIGHT

The 2010 South Australian St Leger Final has turned out eight very promising youngsters. The stand outs of the field appear to be litter mates Where's Cisco and Where's Pancho who both won their respective semi's in quick times and look to be continuing on their winning way. The Where's Pedro/Excuse Me duo have only had 23 starts between them for 12 wins and 7 placings. Trained by Richard Pearce they have both continued to improve and certainly will make their presence felt in tonight's final.

Aston Rachael again found trouble in her semi and couldn't cross from the wide box 8 draw. Another by Where's Pedro she made good ground to run a strong 1 length 2<sup>nd</sup> behind Where's Cisco in the best of night time of 29.94. Trained by Troy Murray, Aston Rachael has won here back in early January in a very slick 29.63 and a repeat of that effort would make her the one to beat in the \$14,000 final. Miss Manakie for trainer Shaun Matcott has drawn the red and does have a lot of early pace, she could definitely upset a couple of the fancied runners early. Box 1 is always a huge benefit in these types of races. The most credentialled runner in the final is the well performed Saint Nyasaland. By Bank Manager/Nyasaland Girl and owned and trained by Alan Randall this smart sprinter has had 42 starts for 17 wins and 13 placings.



With a personal best time of 29.82 beside his name, the draw out in box 7 won't help his chances but he certainly has the field expertise to give this event a big shake. This race has been won in the past by some talented sprinters the likes of Jayell (2006), Dad's Memento (2008) and Dot Com Diva (2009).

### RAY FEWINGS REMEMBERS.....

Much has been written for and against the huge amount of greyhounds racing under the control of super breeder Paul Wheeler.

There's hardly an hour goes by without one of his greyhounds winning somewhere in Australia.

But Wheeler is not the first to saturate the industry with thousands of runners each year.

In the boom period of greyhound racing in the 1970's, Sydneysider Tony Duke played a major role in breeding and racing with his "Moss" dogs.

He dominated racing with Mister Moss, Pearl Moss and Miami Moss and bred hundreds of litters per year.

Where he differed from Wheeler, Duke sold most of his pups off to eager newcomers in the sport. One of his dogs Agogo Moss stood at stud with Tony Welfare in SA.

Duke suddenly quit the sport overnight in the late eighties.

Locally breeder Pam Dodd at Golden Grove was one of SA's bigger breeders and she purchased some outstanding brood bitches for her stud. Names like Gemdelina (Dam of Takiri), Bethsheba and Miss Jag all came to SA.

In Victoria, Ararat's Bill Homburg bred thousands of pups for sale, even on time payment. Most were sired by Holding.

The big difference is that Paul Wheeler relies on his pups to win races, whereas the breeders of yesteryear sold them on.
