## CEO'S REPORT

### NEWS RELEASE

#### FINISH ON LURE TO CONTINUE AT ANGLE PARK AND GAWLER

Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) announced today that the Finish on Lure (FOL) system will continue at Angle Park and Gawler for all scheduled races in an ongoing bid to keep injury and suspension rates to a minimum at both tracks.

The GRSA Board decision follows an extensive review, which included an analysis of injury and suspension rates at Angle Park under the FOL and Catching Pen systems, new FOL injury prevention measures, local industry consultation and evidence gathered from other racing authorities in Australia.

A comparative two-year study of the FOL and Catching Pen systems by GRSA between July 2008 and June 2010 found that injury rates decreased by 18.1% and suspension rates by 67.3% under the FOL system.

The Board resolved to introduce a combination of 'grab' and Catching Pen trials at Angle Park to provide South Australian industry participants with further choice in relation to the training of their greyhounds. The structure and timing of those trial changes will be identified in the coming weeks and industry participants informed through the relevant channels.

GRSA CEO Matt Corby said the decision to continue with the Finish on Lure (FOL) system is based upon the opinion that it provides the best option for protecting the welfare of racing greyhounds.

"We believe the FOL system is the best practice approach based on available evidence and that this decision will reinforce the integrity of our local racing product.

"A redesign of the lure cover to reduce tail injuries and the availability of stronger muzzles has served to mitigate the injury risks normally associated with FOL.

"In making this decision we carefully reviewed the results of industry survey and submissions by participants. We acknowledge that industry opinion is divided on this issue but are of the firm view that FOL system is the best way forward for the industry."

The GRSA Board and Management welcome continued feedback from industry participants on the FOL and Catching Pen systems. This feedback will be considered within the context of ongoing monitoring of this matter.

## ACTING OPERATIONS MANAGER'S REPORT

### BRIAN JOHNSTONE MEMORIAL FINAL

Tonight sees the running of the Group 3 Brian Johnstone Memorial Final. This race is the feature event of the Classic 2010 series for greyhounds that were whelped between May 08 and October 08.



This will be the third running of the Brian Johnstone Memorial named in Brian's honour after the former Chairman of the Adelaide Greyhound Racing Club passed away almost three years ago. Previous winners of this event have been Uncle Remus for Todd Kelly in 2008 and Jean Jeannie for Lester Harris last year.

Two terrific semi finals of the Group 3 feature were conducted last week with tight racing and quick times the order of the night.

Handsome Shiraz for trainer Lauren Harris took out semi final 1 after running home hard to claim the Rob Harnas trained Archer Street in the final stride in a slick 29.93. There was only 2¾ lengths from first to fourth in a keenly contested event.

Stack 'Em Flat for Bruce Lellmann then came out in semi final 2 and showed his dominance after beginning well from the red, he claimed the lead off the back straight and hit the line well in a sizzling 29.85. Delightful Bond for trainer Michael Delorenzo yet to break her maiden status fought on extremely well to secure second spot only 4¾ lengths away with Ultimate Passion for Heather Collins grabbing third spot a further 9 lengths back. Bruce also won a Classic 2010 prelude early in the year with Stack 'Em Flat and is the only trainer to qualify two greyhounds for the final with Honky Tonk Girl running fourth in her heat.

The Final tonight carries total prizemoney of \$31,300 (compared to \$29,600 in 2009), with the winner receiving \$21,280, which includes \$1,000 to breeder.

The runner-up picks up \$5,680, while third receives \$2,840. The unplaced runners pick-up \$300 each.

## BRISBANE CUP FINAL TONIGHT

South Australia had good representation in the heats last week but was unable to qualify a runner for the final with Random Test running a solid third in his heat and both Boozeroo which looked slightly disappointing after leading running fifth and Point Two Over finishing sixth in their heat.

Queensland sprinting star Red Rocket will be one of the favourites for the Group 1 event along with the Tony Brett trained Octane Show to be run tonight with the winner collecting the \$55,000 first prize. We have included a preview from AGRA Publicity Officer, Neil Brown at the end of Kennel Capers.

## SA BRED FUTURITY PAYMENTS

The next batch of futurity payments are due on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> December and there are three series for which payments need to be made.

The payments due are:

**Breeders 2011 – Final Payment - Pups Born Nov 08 To Apr 09**

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first two Sustaining Payments have been made. **The Final Payment is \$110 per greyhound.**

**Classic 2011 – Second Payment - Pups Born May 09 To Oct 10**

This payment is for greyhounds for which the first Sustaining Payments or a Final payment was made last June.



**The Second Sustaining Payment is \$44 per pup or a Final Payment of \$110 can be made at this stage.**

***Breeders 2012 – First Payment - Pups Born Nov 09 To May 10***

Finally the First Payment is due for Breeders 2012. All SA Bred greyhounds born in the above period are eligible to make this payment. **The First Payment is \$27.50 per pup or a "one-off" Final payment of \$121 can be made at this stage.**

**STEWARDS' NEWS**

**IMPORTANT NOTICE TO TRAINERS**

Recently stewards have been forced to deal with an alarming increase in the number of positive swabs compared to previous years.

These swabs have returned positive to a wide range of prohibited substances which has had a negative effect on the industry, not to mention the hardship, embarrassment and financial impact on the trainer concerned, and the owners of the greyhounds involved.

What has come out of these inquiries is the fact that the majority (*an extremely high percentage*) of them were totally avoidable, and were the result of negligence and, or ignorance to the rules of greyhound racing.

Trainers should be fully aware; it is their responsibility to present their greyhounds free of any prohibited substances.

In the past stewards have taken what they believe to be a hard line in relation to penalties imposed for drug related offences, despite this we have seen an alarming increase in the number of positive swabs.

As on all occasions, each case before the stewards will be judged on its merits but trainers should be fully aware, stewards now reserve the right to increase the range of

penalties previously imposed in such cases if the person is found guilty of an offence in relation to any drug related matter.
