2010 WEST END SUMMER CHASING CARNIVAL

The Summer Chasing Carnival is over for another year and we can report another successful year, despite a hot forecast on Cup night. The 40 degrees saw the crowd down a little on 2009, however there were plenty of punters amongst them and we set a new on-course record for the tote, beating the mark set in 2009. The off-course figure was again very strong being nearly on par with last year's record.

Congratulations to Paul Wheeler and the Dailly camp on the win of Dyna Lachlan in the Sky Racing Adelaide Cup Final. He took out both the Final and the Advertiser Interstate Challenge to be clearly the best performed greyhound in the 2010 carnival. He jumped very well and when the clear leader at the first turn the race was in his keeping. He stamped his authority with a very strong 12.75 second run home to give nothing else a look in, finally stopping the clock at 29.48. He has been one of the nation's best over the recent times, without knocking off a Group One event. That record has been put straight and Dyna Lachlan will sit comfortably amongst the list of top grade winners of South Australia's major race. The winner's cheque took Dyna Lachlan's career earnings close to \$275,000 from his 22 wins.

Jan Jones, trainer of Strictly Mambo looked very pleased after the race, when she saw who her charge flash home late to grab second. It was a great run by the local after he was last at one point of the event.

He already has a great record, but based on the run, the best may still be ahead of him. Mr. Metz showed that he will be a greyhound to watch in the coming big races. While not able to get across like he did in the semis, he nevertheless fought on well for third. Having only his 16th race start, he is definitely a greyhound on the up, particularly with his early pace.

The quality of the race meeting was highlighted by the performance of Aston Rachael in the John Gray Memorial Final. The Troy Murray trained bitch was only having her 10th race start when she stopped the clock at 29.63 seconds. This followed her heat win in 29.80 and is only second to Explosive Flash's winning time (29.41) in the 2004 Gray Memorial. Both Satanic Cash (42.88) and Dentax Bale (29.57) were also top performances on the card.

BREEDERS 2010 PRELUDE (1)

A reminder to owners & trainers regarding nominations for Breeders 2010 Prelude (1) series. The heats will be run on Wednesday 3rd February, with the Final on Thursday 11th February. Nominations will close this Friday 29th January at 9.00am with GRSA.

Greyhounds don't have to run in the Preludes to remain eligible for the Breeders Plate in May. Prizemoney will be finalised after nominations close, but as a guide, should we run five heats, the Final will be worth \$3,900. Based on the series totalling 28 races, the total prizemoney for Breeders 2009 is estimated at \$80,000, which includes \$19,560 in Futurity Payments and \$1,125 in Breeders Registrations.



GAWLER 400M BOXES

Trials were conducted from the new 400m boxes at Gawler on Monday. Stewards reported the trials were a success and have approved the new starting position.

The result is that regular trialling from these boxes has started this week, so trainers are able to nominate for 400m trials on Wednesday nights and they will be available on Friday mornings.

The first races will be programmed for the race meeting on Monday night 15th February. As per our discussions at the Grading Review Panel, the intention is to run 2 races at Gawler race meetings. The initial races will be run for Graduation and Grade 5's; we will look at Maidens in the coming weeks and at this stage, there will be no qualifying trials for this distance.

ADDITIONAL RACE PROGRAMMED AT ANGLE PARK

Coming up on Thursday 11th February will be the big Hunnie of the Year race meeting at Angle Park. To help add to the program of racing for the night, we have added an additional race to the card. The race will be called the Hunnie of the Year Feature and it will carry prizemoney of \$3,500. The event will be run over 515m and be open to the "Best 8" greyhounds nominated. The winner, in addition to the prizemoney, will receive a trophy and rug.

***Nominations will close on Monday 8th February with GRSA at 9.00am.**

ANGLE PARK GRADE FOUR HEATS

Tonight we have two very interesting heats of a Grade 4 series at Angle Park. The heats look very strong with John Gray winner, Aston Rachael in one and Adelaide Cup runner-up contesting the other.

They are supported by a strong cast, so we can look forward to a strong final next Thursday 4th February, which carries prizemoney of \$3,500.

NEXT FEATURE AT GAWLER

The next feature event at Gawler is a Grade 5 series, with heats to be run on Monday 8th February. The series will be run over the 531m distance, with the \$1,600 Final to be run on Monday 15th February.

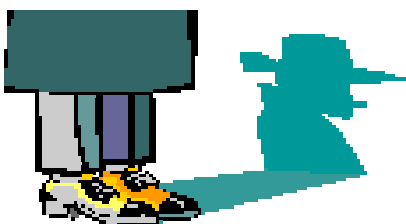

SKY RACING CUP FINALE

The Dailly kennel is no stranger in winning Group 1 events and last Thursday the combination of Wheeler and Dailly took out the 2010 Sky Racing Adelaide Cup final with their well credentialed sprinter Dyna Lachlan.

By Go Wild Teddy/Benden Flex, Dyna Lachlan has certainly paid his way in recent weeks here in South Australia. Winning the Advertiser Interstate Challenge in 29.50 and now South Australia's premier event.

The kennel scratched him from the heats of the Cranbourne Cup which were held on the Monday prior and he showed his liking to the Angle Park circuit when leading throughout to score by 5.75L in BON 29.48 and claimed the winner's cheque of \$63,250. Race favourite, High Earner blew his chances when he went up with the lids on box rise and always had the job ahead of him after that. The run of the race, besides the winner of course, had to go to locally owned and trained Strictly Mambo. The Surf Lorian chaser missed the kick as usual and was last past the 731m boxes but his track sense and big heart carved their way through the field to claim 2nd prize on the line and earn connections a handy \$12,825 for runner up. Mr. Metz filled the placings and certainly has many big race finals in his future.

The carnival has certainly lived up to the hype and now sets the stage for the nationals which will be held here later this coming year.

RETIRED GREYHOUNDS

Stewards wish to remind all trainers of their responsibility in supplying "Notification of Retired Greyhound Forms". With recent cross checking it has become quiet noticeable that some trainers have failed to lodge these forms as required.

Therefore trainers are advised that they have until the 28th February to ensure their records are brought up to date, failure to do so will result in disciplinary action being taken.

Over a period of time stewards have received forms which have been incorrectly completed, with details missing, incorrect spelling, and indecipherable handwriting, when submitting forms ensure all details are completed, and in a decipherable manner as this will save trainers having forms returned and avoid the possibility of being fined.

VET'S REPORT by Dr. Chris Doyle

HOT WEATHER RECOMMENDATION

Recently in metropolitan and regional areas the temperature has been on the rise, and as more hot weather will prevail. Trainers are generally aware of preventative action that may be applied to reduce the risk of heat related stresses on their greyhound. However, the following may be of assistance to new participants in our industry.



"It is essential that adequate electrolyte therapy be given prior to the advent of hot weather and continues throughout the summer months. This will reduce the risk of dehydration, cramping and /or acidosis. Early signs of dehydration include the slowness of the greyhound's skin to return to its normal position after the pinch test, fading towards the end of the race, cramping, and/or a longer than normal post-race recovery time. An electrolyte levelblood test is the best way to know where your greyhound stands.

On Race Day - If it is hot, it may be necessary to give electrolytes and fluids prior to taking the greyhound to the track to prevent dehydrating and subsequent weight loss. Put the greyhound into a cool car. Park the car in the shade and turn the air-conditioning on prior to loading the greyhound. Get to the track as soon as possible. At the track, kennel as quickly as possible.

Post Race - Hose the greyhound down for 2-3 minutes paying particular attention to the feet, chest and inside the hind legs. Wipe excess water off the fur, as water trapped between the fur and skin acts similarly to a wet suit, keeping the heat in. Return the greyhound to the kennels as soon as possible. After race meetings, again put the greyhound into a cool car and get home as quickly as possible. At home, give fluids and electrolytes to replace those used in travelling and racing. Ensure access to plenty of water.

Cooling Vests

These Vests may be used for the transportation of greyhounds to and from tracks and fitted after their race. However they must be removed before the greyhounds are placed in their race Kennel as constant monitoring is required.

Other Tips include

1. Wet trailer rugs for travel.
2. If trainers have a cool room -cool rugs before travel.
3. Large ice blocks in trailer if travel is for long distance.
