OPERATIONS MANAGER'S REPORT

SCULL MURPHY FEATURE

Tonight we have the Scull Murphy Bitches Feature as the main race on the program. The race is being supported by Bob and Deb Isaacson, who have donated a free service to Scull Murphy for the winner. The Scull will have a representative in the race with daughter, Crystal Scull looking for her 12th career victory. We all know what a great racing career Scull Murphy had and the son of Big Daddy Cool has got off to a successful start to his stud career. He stands \$900 for FSI or \$990 for AI.

The race carries \$4,000 in prizemoney plus the service to the winner. Adelaide Cup finalist, Where's Diamond looks well drawn in box 2 for Ken Gill. She has won two in a row since the Cup and will be hard to beat. The remainder of the field looks pretty even, so it should provide a good betting affair, particularly for the exotics. The interesting runner is perhaps Emerley Belle, which is resuming from a break. She is capable of running quick time and will be one to watch.

Scull Murphy will make an appearance on tonight at the scene of so many of his great runs. He will lead the field on to the track for the Feature.

GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH - JANUARY

One run for the month was enough for Tafari Bale the first Greyhound of the Month Award for 2010. That one run however was a victory in the Group 3 West End Draught Distance Championship at Angle Park.

Not only was it a group win, but it was also in a time of 42.79 seconds for the 731m; the fastest time run over the stayers trip for some time. It was also a win over quality opponents such as Satanic Cash and Next Top Model.

The voting panel was strongly behind Tafari Bale, scoring all but one of the first preferences. Strictly Mambo was the other greyhound to score a first vote.

Tafari Bale is by Pure Octane out of Fiona Bale and is trained by Lisa Rasmussen. He has now won 18 of his 44 lifetime starts, along with 17 placings and has career earnings of just under \$47,000. Last year he represented SA in the National Distance Championship and was voted the SA Distance Greyhound of the Year.
