OPERATIONS MANAGER'S REPORT

AUSTRALIAN CUP SATURDAY NIGHT

Saturday night sees the running of the MTD Australian Cup Final at the Meadows. The \$213,000 Group One feature is one of the top events on the Australian calendar. The famous race was first run in 1958, when won by Rookie Rebel and has been raced at the Meadows since 1999. Since moving to the Meadows, both Brett Lee (2001) and Miss Spicy (2006) have completed the Adelaide Cup - Australian Cup Double. This year, Dyna Lachlan has a chance to complete the double after drawing ideally in box 1.

Andrea Dailly has qualified three finalists, with Dyna Lachlan joined by Dyna Obelia and Manuel Bale; she also has first reserve, Allen Shaul. Looking at the heats, Birthday Boy was perhaps the most impressive, as he came from mid-field before railing and winning in the fastest time of 29.71. Both Prankster (29.91) and High Earner (29.92) continued to promote the strength of the Adelaide Cup field, with strong qualifying wins.

Locally owned, Springvale Dash missed an opportunity to qualify, when he led his heat but ran wide on the home turn. This allowed Dyna Lachlan to rail through for victory. Springvale Dash managed to hold on to second spot and he has drawn box 1 in a Grade 5 heat again this Saturday night.

The Australian Cup Final is race 8 on the program on Saturday and it is timed to jump at 9.15pm SA time. The SA TAB will have full coverage of the meeting as will Sky Racing.

Tattsbet will also provide a fixed odds service on both the Cup and the Macro Meats Super Stayers Final. We have included, Neil Browns previews at the end of today's Kennel Capers.

SET TO TAKE THE CASH

Bob Isaacson's up and coming stayer, Satanic Cash will start as one of the favourites for the Macro Meats Super Stayers Final on Saturday night at The Meadows. Following on from his great second in the Zoom Top the previous Saturday, Satanic Cash landed second early in the heats last week and then proceeded in chasing down National Sprint Champion, Dashing Corsair over the 725m. He caught him leaving the back straight and ran away to win easily in 41.43 seconds, a time close to half a second quicker than heat 2 won by Next Top Model. Satanic Cash will compete in his third Group Race final on Saturday; to date he has a second in the West End Draught Distance Championship and the second in the Zoom Top. The race is timed to jump at 8.15pm SA time.

SA ST LEGER HEATS

Yesterday (Wednesday) saw the running of 9 Heats of the 2010 SA St Leger. The St Leger usually brings together a strong line-up and this is again the case for 2010, with a number of our up and coming stars engaged. The race is for 'Derby' aged greyhounds.

PORT PIRIE SUNDAY

We have Sunday twilight racing this weekend, with Port Pirie conducting a strong 10 event program. This meeting is a Sky Racing and SA TAB covered fixture. Racing is timed to start at 5.22pm, with the last at 8.25pm.

The feature event on the program, is the \$1,500 Murray Pridham Memorial. This is a Grade 5 event for SA Owned greyhounds which qualified in heats at the last meeting.

MOUNT GAMBIER CUP HEATS

A reminder to all owners and trainers that nominations for the 2010 South Aussie Hotel Mt Gambier Cup Heats close this Monday 1st March at 9.00am with GRSA. The race is over 512m and for greyhounds to be eligible, they must have had 2 runs at the track over the preceding 12 months.

The Heats will be run on Saturday 6th March. There are also Maiden Heats (512m) at this meeting. The \$3,000 Cup Final will be run the following Saturday 13th March. Also on Final day will be the \$1,000 Maiden Final, \$1,000 Gangalla Park Greyhound Rearing & Trackside Meats Distance Feature (732m) and the \$730 Barry's Door Services Super Sprint (277m).

MONDAY NIGHTS BACK TO APM

Next Monday night, 1st March sees racing revert back to Angle Park (APM). Tuesday afternoon meetings will go back to the normal Gawler fixtures.

LOCALS INTERSTATE

As mentioned last week, Strictly Mambo and Sunny Boy Love both trialled at Cannington in Perth on Saturday last. I can report that both greyhounds trialled well, with Strictly Mambo running 30.46 seconds for the 530m and Sunny Boy Love running 30.34 seconds. Locals suggested that any run under 30.60 would be a good effort for a first look at the track.

The main mission for the pair will be the rich Perth Cup series, which kicks off on Saturday week March 6th. The Final is to be run on March 13th.

GAWLER 400M TRIALS

Stewards have reported that the new starting position at Gawler has provided safe racing to date. They have reported that interference has appeared to be fairly minimal in the first two weeks.

Therefore we will now begin qualifying trials as an option for trainers at Wednesday night trials. This will begin immediately. **All grades can trial, but at this stage we are running Graduation and Graded races at race meetings.**

Maiden trials will be introduced shortly and these will be 'closed' Maidens. That means there will be no open Maidens, but greyhounds will need to run in qualifying heats at the trials. I will advise of the starting date for this in the next couple of weeks.

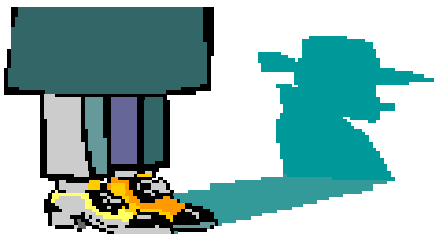

Stewards wish to remind all trainers of their responsibility in supplying "Notification of Retired Greyhound Forms". With recent cross checking it has become quiet noticeable that some trainers have failed to lodge these forms as required. Therefore trainers are advised that they have until the 28th February to ensure their records are brought up to date, failure to do so will result in disciplinary action being taken.

Over a period of time stewards have received forms which have been incorrectly completed, with details missing, incorrect spelling, and indecipherable handwriting, when submitting forms ensure all details are completed, and in a decipherable manner as this will save trainers having forms returned and avoid the possibility of being fined.
