SPRING CHASING CARNIVAL



Today is the beginning of the Spring Chasing Carnival at Angle Park. However, the first major race of the 2009 Spring Chasing Carnival climaxes next Thursday night (1st October), with the running of the Coffex Coffee Oaks Final at Angle Park. The race highlights some of the best young bitches from both here and Victoria and carries a total purse of \$32,000. It is a Group Three event on the National Calendar.

The juvenile dogs will also take centre stage over the next couple of week's as the Coca Cola Derby commences next Wednesday (30th September) with the heats. This will be followed by the Semi-Finals on Thursday 8th October and the Group Three Final on the 15th October. Once Again it is worth \$32,000.

Completing the Spring Chasing Carnival later in October will be the third of the Group Three races, the SA Sprint Championship. This is an open grade series for our best sprinters and has total prizemoney of \$27,000. This is usually a very strong series and will be run on the 22nd (Heats) and 29th (Final) of October.

Greyhound Racing SA has launched its Spring Chasing Carnival, which runs for the five week period with the launch of the Hunnies in Bikinis Calendar and the "Win a Trip to Wimbledon" competition, which features the Greyhound Hunnies who are the face of Greyhound Racing in SA.
