Submission form for SA Bred Greyhound purchase

Greyhound Racing SA will be running a radio media campaign on a Nova 919 to promote Syndication to its listeners to promote syndication to the general public. This will run from July to December 2010. The campaign will kick off in July with a competition, the prize being a share in the syndication of an SA Bred Greyhound.

We had success with this type of competition last year with Financial Crisis in conjunction with SAFM – but we plan to step up the media profile this year on Nova. Syndication seminars will follow the campaign, but we will be taking these into the market place to major workplaces in their lunch breaks, eg: companies like Coopers Brewery, Holden etc.

This promotion therefore needs to source a racing greyhound prior to this date, so GRSA are requesting submissions from SA Breeders, Trainers and Public Trainers that have a racing Greyhound available for purchase. The Greyhound will be purchased by an independent party to assist GRSA & Nova.

Because the greyhound will be going into Gap at the end of the 6 month period, the greyhound is more than likely to be approximately 2.5 to 3 years of age.

Please find a submission form attached which must be submitted to Greyhound Racing SA no later than 4.30pm on Thursday 17th of June 2010. Submissions must be marked to the attention of Vaun Gray and Craig Cook, who have been engaged by the independent party to review all submissions and make a recommendation on the final Greyhound. Please note: only applications submitted in writing will be considered.

The Greyhound will need to be able to either race or trial no later than the 8th July 2010.

In addition, the selected public trainer will enter into a training/kenneling agreement that will be paid to the trainer on a monthly basis (or otherwise negotiated); a tax invoice must be generated for this. This is likely to be in the vicinity of \$100 per week plus feed or otherwise negotiated. Therefore the nominated asking price needs to reflect this.

The selected public trainer, trainer or breeder must make themselves available for an interview by the selected radio station announcers.
