CEO'S REPORT

GRSA GROWS SKY RACE MEETINGS

Greyhound Racing SA has announced that GRSA's revenue and market share is likely to grow further based on a new deal with Sky Racing for 56 additional race meetings per year. The agreement will see an additional 30 Sunday night meetings which adds to the 22 Sunday meetings that are already operational and a further 26 Sunday matinee meetings. GRSA is currently working with Sky Racing regarding the commencement dates.

The GRSA management team has established a strong working relationship with our strategic partner Sky Racing and we acknowledge Sky's efforts, in particular Chief Operating Officer Mr. Brendan Parnell and Head - Media Operations Mr. Gerard Patane, for their support of the South Australian greyhound racing product. Our discussions with Sky Racing are ongoing as we will continue to ensure that greyhound racing in this state has a high media profile for all our racing patrons nationally.

The GRSA Board of Directors and the management team are currently involved in a strategic planning process to determine the organisations focus for the coming years and until the outcomes are formulated the additional race meetings will be conducted at GRSA's existing TAB racing tracks for the interim. It is expected that the decisions from the strategic planning process will be known following the Board's meeting in April this year.

GRSA will be releasing more information to its member clubs once more details are available.

OPERATIONS MANAGER'S REPORT

GREYHOUND OF THE MONTH - FEBRUARY

2010 has started with a distance theme as far as the Greyhound of the Month is concerned. January was won by Tafari Bale and now the February award has gone to Satanic Cash. The win came after his performances at the Meadows during the month. He had 3 starts there for a win and a second, while the other start was an unplaced run in the Group 2 Zoom Top. That was his first look at The Meadows and he followed it with a brilliant win in the Macro Meats Super Stayers Heat. In that race he recorded a smart 42.43, the quickest of the two heats. He defeated Drill 'Em in the heat, but had the tables turned in the Final when he ran second. While beaten he was far from disgraced, running home from well back in the middle stages.

Satanic Cash is trained by Bob Issacson and is out of his top bitch, Satanic Miss, by Big Daddy Cool. The sire has been good to Bob as Scull Murphy is also by Big Daddy Cool. Satanic Cash has now won 12 of his 27 starts, with 9 placings and has already won prizemoney in excess of \$45,000.

The judges were strongly in favour of Satanic Cash, as he received 6 of the 7 first preference votes. Strictly Mambo received the other first preference. With his recent efforts in the top company, Satanic Cash showed he is capable of mixing it with the best.



In a year when the National Finals are in Adelaide both Satanic Cash and Tafari Bale will be looking forward to August.

EASTER EGG STARTS ON SATURDAY NIGHT

Local followers and punters should turn their sights to the Macro Meats Golden Easter Egg series, which begins on Saturday night at Wentworth Park in Sydney. This year's Final carries total prizemoney of \$356,250, with the winner's share being \$1/4 million. Saturday night sees ten outstanding heats, with all of the current topline in town.

Recent Group 1 winner's engaged are Fedex, Dyna Lachlan, Prankster, Cindeen Shelby, High Earner, Enry Walt. Plus last year's winner, Dana Beatrice will be looking to make it back to back victories. Good to see the locally owned Arsonist engaged for Heather Collins in Heat 8..

The first race is timed to jump at 6.57pm and we can enjoy a full coverage on Sky Racing and through the SA TAB. With four Semi-Finals next week, it will mean that all placegetters and the fastest 2 fourths will go through; should be a top night's racing. Tattsbett will be offering fixed odds markets on all the heats.

RAY FEWINGS REMEMBERS.....

In greyhound racing there is always something flying home but in the very early days there were some notable dogs flying to the track.

Opening night at Whyalla greyhounds saw Terry Cahalan pilot his light aircraft Narth, fully loaded with punters and one greyhound "Sawle" in the baggage area.

Sawle had been a top grade runner at the unofficial meetings at Bolivar (next to Globe Derby Trotting Track) and was eligible to run in a maiden at Whyalla.

The Whyalla bookies found it easy to lay all runners in those days with the result Sawle was at 3/1. In reality he should have been 1/3. Needless to say, Sawle quickly disposed of the Whyalla locals and won by a space. Cahalan's plane was rocking all the way home with the winning punters in high spirits.

Another greyhound to fly to meetings in the early days was the Victorian Champion "Gerard The Gent".

His owner had a pilot's licence and flew "The Gent" to Angle Park for the main race on opening night.

Everyone was eager to see what this brilliant dog could do on night one but unfortunately the boxes opened prematurely. All dogs were vetted for a re-run but Gerard The Gent was withdrawn with a minor injury.

Not even this mishap could sour what was an historic night.
